# ABOUT THE CAMP DIRECTOR



Gene Depew has revitalized Bucknell Baseball. When he began his head coaching career in 1982, he inherited a team that was 6-20 the year before and 3-17 in 1980. Entering the 2008 season, the Bison are now perennial Patriot League contenders.

Since 1996, Bucknell has won an average of 25 games per year, captured three Patriot league crowns (1996, 2001 & 2003), and finished as the conference runner-up in four other seasons. In 1998, Depew's squad set a school record with 31 victories and tied that in 2001 with another 31-win season. In addition, Bucknell has made three NCAA Tournament appearances (1996, 2001 & 2003) in the past 12 years.

A 1971 Bucknell graduate, Depew enters his 27th season as the Bison's head coach and is just the fourth coach since World War II. He has directed his teams to over 465 victories, the most by any skipper in school history. Depew has three times been recognized by his peers, receiving Patriot League Coach of the Year honors in 1992, 1996 & 2003. Gene and his wife, Debbie, reside in Mifflinburg and are the parents of a daughter, Erin, Bucknell '06, and a son, William, Bucknell '10.
