- Opportunity to showcase ability and get evaluated by college coaching staff

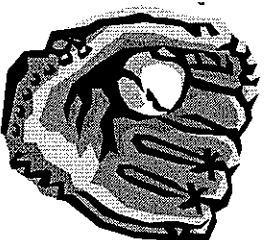
