## CAMP DIRECTOR



Patrick J. Flannery, head basketball coach at Bucknell University, utilizes his experiences as a basketball coach and educator, to teach young people the fundamentals of basketball. The mission of this camp is to help young people understand the values of working hard as individuals and develop habits of good sportsmanship. Coach Flannery on the two instructional sessions: "Our camps are designed to bring campers into a teaching environment where they work closely with our Bucknell student-athletes. Our players serve as excellent role models for young people today because they succeed academically, athletically and as people. I want young men to learn how they can develop themselves year-round as good players and good people. Campers will truly enjoy their week of camp here at Bucknell."

The Bison have begun their eighth season under Flannery and once again figure into the Patriot League's title hunt. Flannery has been named Patriot League Coach-of-the-Year twice, being recognized in the 1994-95 and 1996-97 seasons. Bucknell's play in recent seasons has made a name for the Blue and Orange nationally. Bucknell has claimed victories over Alabama, Princeton, Air Force, San Francisco, Iona, Maine, Manhattan, Hofstra and George Mason. Prior to arriving at Bucknell, Flannery coached Lebanon Valley College to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship. The National Association of Basketball Coaches named him the National Division III Coach-of-the-Year for the 1993-94 season.

Flannery served as captain of the Bucknell squads during the 1978-80 seasons, some of the best in Bucknell history. While at Pottsville High School, Flannery was selected as an All-State player. Flannery holds an undergraduate degree in economics and a Master's degree in education.
