**HEAD COACH TIM LANDIS**

Tim Landis is in his seventh year as the Bob Odell Head Coach of Bucknell Football in 2009, and he is in sole possession of fifth place on the program's career games coached list at 70.



Landis' teams achieved .500 or better records in three of his first six seasons at Bucknell, including a 7-4 campaign in 2004.

Having already resurrected programs at Davidson and St. Mary's, Landis arrived at Bucknell in December 2002 to take over a football program that was undergoing a trying period.

As Landis' first spring practice approached, the Bison were still coping with the death of legendary head coach Tom Gadd, and they were still tasting the bitterness of a 2-9 record that ended a school-record run of seven straight winning seasons.

But under Landis' leadership, pride was quickly restored in the program, and the Bison turned in two very good seasons, first going 6-6 in 2003 then improving to 7-4 in 2004. Bucknell placed third in the competitive Patriot League standings both seasons.

Landis has coached both an All-American (DL Sean Conover) and a pair of Academic All-Americans (OL Justin Gibson, DB David Frisbey) during his tenure at Bucknell.

Upon his hiring, Landis, 45, brought to the Bison football program an impressive cache of head coaching experience. He became Bucknell's 25<sup>th</sup> head football coach since the program's inception in 1883.

Following a seven-year tenure as head coach at Davidson, Landis spent the three seasons prior to coming to Bucknell building a solid program at St. Mary's (Calif.). In both positions, he garnered national accolades for turning modestly successful programs into winners.

**WITH A VICTORY OVER MARIST, BUCKNELL WOULD ...**

- ▶ ... keep its record perfect against the Red Foxes (5-0)
- ▶ ... defeat the Red Foxes for the fifth consecutive season
- ▶ ... post its first three-game home winning streak since 2003 to 2004.
- ▶ ... open its home schedule 2-0 for the first time since 2004
- ▶ ... avoid its first losing streak of the season
- ▶ ... help **Tim Landis** claim his 30th win at the helm of the Bison, tying him for seventh on the program's all-time list
- ▶ ... improve to 10-7 in non-league home games under **Tim Landis** (since 2003)

**ABOUT THE GAME**

Bucknell and Marist both played on the road last week, but the Red Foxes had a lot farther to travel than the three-hour jaunt to Ithaca, N.Y., the Bison experienced. Marist lost a tight 17-10 game at San Diego last Saturday, while Bucknell lost at Cornell by a 33-9 margin. Both squads will look to get back on the winning side Saturday as the Bison open a two-game homestand and the Red Foxes wrap up a two-game road trip. Marist, which brings a 1-2 record into Saturday's game, will play three of its first four on the road. Both teams have struggled to score of late. The Red Foxes have managed just 16 points over their last two games, while the Bison offense has tallied just 17 points the last two weeks. Bucknell will look to continue its past success against Marist, an opponent it has averaged better than 33 points against in four all-time meetings.

**BUCKNELL VS. MARIST SERIES NOTES**

- ▶ Bucknell leads 4-0.
- ▶ Bucknell leads in Lewisburg 2-0.
- ▶ Bucknell won the first three meetings by an average score of 38-11. Last year the Bison needed a late comeback to defeat the Red Foxes 21-17.
- ▶ Marist has never scored 20 points vs. Bucknell.
- ▶ The first game in the series was in 2005 and the teams have met every year since.

- ▶ Bucknell was 2-for-8 on third downs, while Marist was 8-for-17.
- ▶ **Robert De La Rosa** tallied a career-high nine tackles and earned Patriot League Rookie of the Week honors.
- ▶ Bucknell had the ball for just over eight minutes in the second half as Marist won the overall time of possession battle, 36:37-23:23.
- ▶ Bucknell managed just 46 yards of offense in the second and third quarters.
- ▶ Bucknell's first lead came with 1:03 to play.
- ▶ **Shaun Pasternak** recorded his third 100-yard receiving game of the season.

**DEFENSIVE POINTS**

While Bucknell has scored a total of 35 points over its last two games, it is not the offense behind the output, but the defense. The Bison defensive unit has accounted for 18 points the last two contests, while the offense has contributed 17. Bucknell's defense had two interception returns for touchdowns and a safety in the second half of a 26-23 win over Robert Morris two weeks ago. This past Saturday at Cornell the Bison recorded another safety.

**A HOMESTAND?**

Saturday's contest against Marist marks the first of two straight home games for Bucknell. The Bison have not played at home consecutive weeks since Oct. 20 and Oct. 27 in 2007.

**GOING FOR THREE IN A ROW**

While Bucknell has lost four straight road games dating back to last year, it is riding a two-game home winning streak. The Bison will be going for their third home win in a row Saturday, a feat they haven't accomplished since the final home game of 2003 and the first two of 2004.

**NARROW MARGINS OF VICTORIES**

Bucknell has won six games over the last two seasons and most have been close. The last six Bison wins have come by a combined 22 points, an average of less than four points per game.

**RECENT SUCCESS IN CLOSE GAMES**

Prior to last week's 24-point loss at Cornell, Bucknell's previous three games dating back to last year's season finale against Fordham had been decided by a total of 11 points. The Bison were 2-1 in those games and are 8-4 in contests decided by less than a touchdown over the last four years. All five of their victories in 2008 were by six points or less.

**PATRIOT LEAGUE VS. IVY LEAGUE**

Last Saturday marked the opening weekend of play for the Ivy League, which like the Patriot League, is a non-scholarship conference. Bucknell's meeting with Cornell was one of five interleague contests and Patriot League squads posted a 2-3 mark. Holy Cross and Colgate earned victories, while Bucknell, Fordham and Georgetown came out on the losing end. Bucknell is 3-10 against Ivy League opponents under **Tim Landis** and is just 1-7 since the beginning of the 2005 season. The Bison will face another Ivy League foe, Penn, next month.

**PUNTS, PUNTS, PUNTS**

In just his second game as Bucknell's regular punter, sophomore **Andrew Bell** punted nine times two weeks ago against Robert Morris. It was the most punts by a Bison punter since Billy Windle had nine in a loss at Towson in 2002. Bell followed his nine-punt day with an eight-punt outing at Cornell. The 17 punts over a two-game stretch is the most since Windle also had 17 in back-to-back losses to Colgate and Towson in 2002. Bucknell has already punted 22 times this year. In all of 2008 the Bison punted 46 times.

**BIG PLAYS HURT BISON**

Bucknell's defense has been prone to give up the big play this year, but has been solid otherwise. Opponents have score nine touchdowns this season, and eight of those have come on plays of at least 30 yards. Overall, opponents have gained 1,101 yards, but 344 of them have come on those eight long touchdown plays.

**SOLID IN THE RED ZONE**

Football teams like to score touchdowns when they reach the "Red Zone", an area inside the opponent's 20-yard line. The Bison defense has yielded just one touchdown in four chances inside the Red Zone this year.

**FEW BIG PLAYS FOR BISON**

While opponents have registered eight touchdowns of at least 30 yards, and 12 total plays that have gone for at least 30 yards, Bucknell's offense has posted just two plays of at least 30 yards this season, and both came in the season opener at Duquesne.

**Marlon Woods** caught a 41-yard touchdown pass from **Marcello Trigg** and **C.J. Hopson** recorded a career-best 52-yard rush against the Dukes, marking the only times the Bison have gone longer than 30 yards on a play.

**RECORD WITH/WITHOUT NANA-SINKAM**

Bucknell played its season opener at Duquesne without senior **LB Sam Nana-Sinkam**. It marked the 17th game he has missed since arriving on campus in 2006. The Bison own a 4-13 record without Nana-Sinkam in the lineup. With him part of the starting unit, which he was the last two weeks, they are 11-8.

**VON PARIS IN THE BACKFIELD**

Junior **DL John von Paris** leads the Bison defense with a career-high six tackles for loss. That figure is higher than any Bucknell player had last year and is the most since Josh Eden (11) and **Will Braaf** (8) in 2007. von Paris also leads the Bison in sacks with three, the most since Eden had 4.5 two years ago. As a team, Bucknell has 22 tackles for loss and seven sacks. Last year the Bison totaled 42 tackles for loss and 14 sacks over the course of the season.

**CAREER DAY FOR CADMAN**

**WR Cale Cadman** had one of the better days of his career last week at Cornell, catching a career-high six passes for a career-high 73 yards.

**YELLOW FLAGS**

Bucknell was the least-penalized team in the nation in 2007 and that seems to be continuing this year. The Bison did not commit a penalty against Cornell and are averaging just three penalties per game this season. Four times in the last 22 games Bucknell has not been flagged. The Bison have committed fewer penalties than their opponents in each of their last eight outings.

**TURNOVER BUG**

Bucknell has caught the turnover bug of late. The Bison have turned the ball over at least twice in six consecutive games dating back to last year. The last time Bucknell did not commit at least two turnovers in a contest was at Holy Cross last November. The Bison have committed 17 turnovers during that six-game stretch. Bucknell had just nine turnovers in its previous six games.

**THIRD DOWN CONVERSIONS**

Bucknell has struggled on third down this season, converting just 13 times in 48 tries (27.1%). The Bison have converted at least 33 percent of their third downs in each of **Tim Landis'** first six years and have not been below 30 percent since 2002 (28 percent).

**NO DOUBLE FIGURES**

Bucknell failed to reach double figures in points against Cornell, marking its first time under 10 since a Nov. 3, 2007 game at Lafayette. The Bison went 15 straight games reaching double figures, their longest streak since 2000-02 when they scored at least 10 points in 20 straight contests.
