HEAD COACH TIM LANDIS

Tim Landis is in his seventh year as the Bob Odell Head Coach of Bucknell Football in 2009, and he is in sole possession of fifth place on the program's career games coached list at 72.



Landis' teams achieved .500 or better records in three of his first six seasons at Bucknell, including a 7-4 campaign in 2004.

Having already resurrected programs at Davidson and St. Mary's, Landis arrived at Bucknell in December 2002 to take over a football program that was undergoing a trying period.

As Landis' first spring practice approached, the Bison were still coping with the death of legendary head coach Tom Gadd, and they were still tasting the bitterness of a 2-9 record that ended a school-record run of seven straight winning seasons.

But under Landis' leadership, pride was quickly restored in the program, and the Bison turned in two very good seasons, first going 6-6 in 2003 then improving to 7-4 in 2004. Bucknell placed third in the competitive Patriot League standings both seasons.

Landis has coached both an All-American (DL Sean Conover) and a pair of Academic All-Americans (OL Justin Gibson, DB David Frisbey) during his tenure at Bucknell.

Upon his hiring, Landis, 45, brought to the Bison football program an impressive cache of head coaching experience. He became Bucknell's 25th head football coach since the program's inception in 1883.

Following a seven-year tenure as head coach at Davidson, Landis spent the three seasons prior to coming to Bucknell building a solid program at St. Mary's (Calif.). In both positions, he garnered national accolades for turning modestly successful programs into winners.

BISON NOTES & NOTABLES

WITH A VICTORY OVER PENN, BUCKNELL WOULD ...

- ▶ ... snap a four-game road losing streak.
- ▶ ... post its first three-game winning streak since the final game of 2007 and the first two of 2008.
- ▶ ... post its first in-season three-game winning streak since reeling off four victories in a row in 2004.
- ▶ ... win its game immediately preceding a bye week for the first time since 2003.
- ▶ ... improve to 4-10 against Ivy League foes under head coach **Tim Landis**.
- ▶ ... snap a four-game losing streak against Ivy League competition.
- ▶ ... end a four-game losing streak against the Quakers.
- ▶ ... win its first game after its Patriot League opener for the second time since 2001.

ABOUT THE GAME

Bucknell (3-2, 1-0 PL) will conclude the non-league portion of its schedule Saturday at Penn. The Bison are coming off a 2-0 homestand, but have lost four in a row on the road. Penn (1-2, 1-0 Ivy) defeated Ivy League foe Dartmouth 30-24 last Saturday for its first win. The Quakers opened the season with a loss to nationally ranked Villanova and followed that with an overtime loss to Patriot League opponent Lafayette. Both teams have solid defenses with Bucknell's opponents averaging just over 20 points per game and Penn's averaging just over 19. The Quakers rank 11th nationally in total defense, while the Bison are 56th in the same category. Plenty of sacks will likely be seen Saturday as Bucknell has already eclipsed its sack total from last year and is averaging three per game this year. Penn is also averaging three sacks and nearly eight tackles for loss per outing, ranking in the top 20 nationally in both categories. Saturday's contest is also the final non-conference game for the Quakers as they finish up their season against six consecutive Ivy League opponents.

BUCKNELL VS. PENN SERIES NOTES

- ▶ Penn leads 27-5.
- ▶ Eight of the last nine meetings have been decided by 10 points or less.
- ▶ Penn leads 22-3 in Philadelphia.

LAST TIME VS. PENN

Penn 34, Bucknell 24 (Oct. 7, 2006 - Lewisburg, Pa.)

- ▶ In his second collegiate appearance and first start, **Marcello Trigg** completed 10 of 19 passes for 125 yards and a touchdown.
- ▶ Penn jumped out to a 31-10 advantage.
- ▶ Penn's Robert Irvin completed 23 of 33 passes for 304 yards and three touchdowns.

INSIDE THE GEORGETOWN BOX SCORE

- ▶ **C.J. Hopson** rushed for a game-high 101 yards, his second 100-yard performance of the season.
- ▶ Bucknell's five sacks were a season high and marked the most for the Bison since recording five against Holy Cross in 2004.
- ▶ By holding Georgetown scoreless in the second half, Bucknell shut out and opponent for a half for the first time since last year's season finale against Fordham. It was the 11th time since **Tim Landis** took over as coach in 2003 the Bison have shut out an opponent for a half.
- ▶ Georgetown registered only 58 of its 219 yards in the second half.
- ▶ The home team won a game in the Bucknell-Georgetown series for the first time since 2003.
- ▶ **Ahkiel White** picked off his first pass of the season, giving him five in his career.
- ▶ **Marcello Trigg** went over 4,000 career yards of total offense.
- ▶ **RB Justin Pulgrano** completed his second career pass. He is now 2-for-2 for 66 yards in his career.
- ▶ Bucknell moved into a four-way tie for first place in the Patriot League standings.

HOME SUCCESS

Bucknell is coming off a two-game homestand and has won four in a row overall at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. It is the first four-game home winning streak for the Bison since 2001. Bucknell's last home winning streak of longer than four games came in 2000 when it claimed five in a row on its home field.

IVY LEAGUE STRUGGLES

Bucknell is just 3-10 against Ivy League foes since **Tim Landis** started as head coach in 2003. The Bison, who lost 33-9 to Ivy League opponent Cornell last month, are 1-7 since the beginning of the 2005 campaign vs. Ivy League teams. Bucknell is in the midst of a four-game losing streak to Ivy opponents.

PATRIOT LEAGUE OPENERS

Bucknell improved to 14-10 all-time in Patriot League openers with its 14-6 victory over Georgetown last Saturday. The Bison are 4-3 under seventh-year head coach **Tim Landis** and have won two in a row. Four times in the last six years Bucknell has opened its Patriot League slate against the Hoyas.

LOOKING AHEAD TO WEEK OFF

Bucknell has struggled in recent years in the game preceeding a bye week. In fact, the Bison have not won the game directly before a week off since 2003 and are 1-9 in their last 10 chances. This will be the fifth time in the last six years Bucknell has played on the road immediately prior to its bye week.

FOUR-GAME ROAD LOSING STREAK

Bucknell is 0-2 on the road this season and has lost four in a row overall away from Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. The Bison last had a longer road losing streak from 2005 to 2006 when they lost seven in a row. The 2005 campaign was also the last time Bucknell lost its first two road contests.

FINAL NON-LEAGUE GAME

Saturday's contest at Penn marks the final non-league game for Bucknell. The Bison have had mixed success in their last non-league game recently, going 4-4 over the last eight years.

IMPROVED DEFENSE

Bucknell's defense has been strong this season, yielding just over 20 points per game. The last time opponents scored less than the 20.4 points they are averaging this year was 2004 when they averaged 20.1 points. The Bison defense already has more sacks (15) and interceptions (9) than last year, and is only seven tackles for loss (35) behind last year's final total of 42.

A LOT OF SACKS

Bucknell registered five sacks last Saturday against Georgetown, equaling its highest single-game total in Tim Landis' seven years as head coach. The last time the Bison had five sacks in a game was 2004 against Holy Cross. The last time a Bucknell team had more sacks in a game was in 2002 against St. Mary's when it piled up six sacks. Ten different Bison have recorded a sack this season, led by **John von Paris'** team-high three. Bucknell has posted at least three sacks in four of five games this year.

HOME INTERCEPTIONS

Bucknell has intercepted nine passes this year, two more than its total from all of last year. Interestingly, all nine picks have come at home. The Bison registered five interceptions against Robert Morris and two more against both Marist and Georgetown. Bucknell has posted at least one interception in each of its last four home games, all wins., and ranks third in the nation in interceptions.

FIRST-PLACE BISON

With its win last Saturday against Georgetown, Bucknell moved into a four-way tie for first place in the Patriot League standings. The Bison, Colgate, Lafayette and Holy Cross are all 1-0 through the early part of the league schedule.

100-YARD CLUB

QB C.J. Hopson rushed for a game-high 101 yards in Saturday's win over Georgetown. It marked his second 100-yard rushing performance of the season and he became the 38th Bison in the history of the program to tally two career 100-yard rushing outings. Hopson is the 30th player to record two 100-yard rushing games in the same season, and the first since Josh DeStefano in 2006.

SINGLE-DIGIT POINTS

Bucknell limited Georgetown to two field goals last Saturday. The six points marked the fewest for a Bison opponent since Oct. 28, 2006 when Fordham managed just three points. That was also the last time an opponent did not record a touchdown against Bucknell. Since Tim Landis took over as coach in 2003, the Bison have held opponents to single-digit points on eight occasions. Bucknell's 14 points were its fewest in a win since that 2006 contest against Fordham, which it won 13-3. The Bison have scored at least 13 points in each of their 38 victories since the 2001 season.

LOW YARDS FOR OPPONENT

Bucknell held Georgetown to 219 yards last Saturday, including just 58 in the second half. It marked the third time since the beginning of the 2007 campaign, and the 12th time in the last seven years, a Bison opponent registered less than 300 yards of total offense. Only twice since 2003 have opponents been held to fewer yards.

RED ZONE

Bucknell's defense has been strong this season, but has especially been stout when pushed against its goal line. The Bison have permitted just three touchdowns in 10 opportunities when the opponent reaches the "red zone", the area inside the 20-yard line. By contrast, Bucknell's offense has scored a touchdown 8 of 13 times in the red zone, better than twice as often as the opponents.

WILLIAMS RETURNS

Senior **LB Casey Williams** injured his knee in the opener at Duquesne and missed the next three games. He returned to the field last Saturday against Georgetown and recorded a team-high 10 tackles and one sack. The 10 tackles equaled a career high.

NARROW MARGINS OF VICTORIES

Bucknell has won eight games over the last two seasons and most have been close. The last eight Bison wins have come by a combined 31 points, an average of less than four points per game. The eight-point margin of victory over Georgetown marked Bucknell's largest win since a 14-point triumph in the 2007 season finale at Fordham.

RECENT SUCCESS IN CLOSE GAMES

Bucknell has had success in close games in recent years. In fact, the Bison have posted a 9-4 record in games decided by seven points or less since 2006.

YELLOW FLAGS

Bucknell was the least-penalized team in the nation in 2007 and 2008 and that seems to be continuing this year. The Bison did not commit a penalty against Cornell and are averaging 3.6 penalties per game this season. Four times in the last 24 games Bucknell has not been flagged. The Bison have committed fewer penalties than their opponents in each of their last 10 outings. Over that span Bucknell has been penalized 28 times for 250 yards, while its opponents have piled up 570 penalty yards on 63 penalties.

RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS

C.J. Hopson rushed for two touchdowns last Saturday against Georgetown. It marked the second straight game the Bison had two rushing scores, a stark contrast from their first three outings when they had only one rushing touchdown total. Bucknell had gone seven consecutive games without multiple rushing touchdowns prior to accomplishing the feat in a win over Marist two weeks ago. The Bison are 6-3 in their last nine games when they have at least two rushing touchdowns.

Bucknell's defense has been prone to give up the big play this year, but has been solid otherwise. Opponents have scored 11 touchdowns this season, and eight of those have come on plays of at least 30 yards.

FEW BIG PLAYS FOR BISON

While opponents have registered eight touchdowns of at least 30 yards, and 13 total plays that have gone for at least 30 yards, Bucknell's offense has posted just two plays of at least 30 yards this season, and both came in the season opener at Duquesne. **Marlon Woods** caught a 41-yard touchdown pass from **Marcello Trigg** and **C.J. Hopson** recorded a career-best 52-yard rush against the Dukes, marking the only times the Bison have gone longer than 30 yards on a play.
