**HEAD COACH TIM LANDIS**

Tim Landis is in his seventh year as the Bob Odell Head Coach of Bucknell Football in 2009, and he will tie Tom Gadd for fourth place on the program's career games coached list at 76 this afternoon.



Landis' teams achieved .500 or better records in three of his first six seasons at Bucknell, including a 7-4 campaign in 2004.

Having already resurrected programs at Davidson and St. Mary's, Landis arrived at Bucknell in December 2002 to take over a football program that was undergoing a trying period.

As Landis' first spring practice approached, the Bison were still coping with the death of legendary head coach Tom Gadd, and they were still tasting the bitterness of a 2-9 record that ended a school-record run of seven straight winning seasons.

But under Landis' leadership, pride was quickly restored in the program, and the Bison turned in two very good seasons, first going 6-6 in 2003 then improving to 7-4 in 2004. Bucknell placed third in the competitive Patriot League standings both seasons.

Landis has coached both an All-American (DL Sean Conover) and a pair of Academic All-Americans (OL Justin Gibson, DB David Frisbey) during his tenure at Bucknell.

Upon his hiring, Landis, 45, brought to the Bison football program an impressive cache of head coaching experience. He became Bucknell's 25<sup>th</sup> head football coach since the program's inception in 1883.

Following a seven-year tenure as head coach at Davidson, Landis spent the three seasons prior to coming to Bucknell building a solid program at St. Mary's (Calif.). In both positions, he garnered national accolades for turning modestly successful programs into winners.

**BISON NOTES & NOTABLES**

**WITH A VICTORY OVER FORDHAM, BUCKNELL WOULD ...**

- ▶ ... snap a six-game road losing streak.
- ▶ ... defeat the Rams for a fourth consecutive season.
- ▶ ... avoid its first four-game losing streak since 2008.
- ▶ ... even its Patriot League record at 2-2.
- ▶ ... guarantee at least a fifth-place finish in the final Patriot League standings.

**ABOUT THE GAME**

For the third consecutive season Bucknell (3-5, 1-2 PL) will play Fordham (3-5, 0-3 PL) while it is in the midst of a long losing streak. The last two years the Bison were able to halt their streaks with wins over the Rams. For Bucknell, which will be playing the middle contest of a three-game road trip, the key will be stopping Fordham's high-powered offense that ranks second nationally in both total offense (483.4 yards per game) and passing offense (326.5). Fordham's John Skelton ranks third nationally in total offense, while three of his wide receivers are among the top 75 in the nation in receiving yards per game. The Bison defense was yielding just over 20 points per game this season prior to the last two contests that have featured 35 points from both Lehigh and Lafayette. Still, the defense is the strength of Bucknell with **LB Greg Jones** and his 76 tackles leading the way. The Bison will try to get their offense on track as they have not scored 20 points since week two and are ranked in the bottom 15 nationally in passing offense, total offense and scoring offense. Bucknell has averaged 31 points per game against Fordham over their last two meetings.

**BUCKNELL VS. FORDHAM SERIES NOTES**

- ▶ Bucknell leads 16-8.
- ▶ Bucknell has won three straight and five of the last six.
- ▶ Bucknell has defeated Fordham in the season finale each of the last two years.
- ▶ Bucknell is 9-5 against Fordham in Bronx, N.Y.
- ▶ Bucknell and Fordham have met every year since 1989 after not playing for a span of more than 55 years.
- ▶ Bucknell stopped a losing streak of at least four games against Fordham in both 2007 and 2008.

**LAST TIME VS. FORDHAM**

**Bucknell 24, Fordham 21 (OT) (Nov. 22, 2008 - Lewisburg, Pa.)**

- ▶ Bucknell won its final game for the third consecutive year.
- ▶ Bucknell scored the final 17 points and did not allow Fordham to put a point on the board over the final 39:38 of play.
- ▶ **Shaun Pasternak's** 156 receiving yards rank eighth in program history. He broke the program's single-season receiving yards mark (1,083) and tied Tom Mitchell's record with his fifth 100-yard outing of the season.
- ▶ **Greg Jones** collected a team-best 17 tackles, which also represented a new career high.

**INSIDE THE LAFAYETTE BOX SCORE**

- ▶ **Marcello Trigg** moved into sole possession of second place on Bucknell's career touchdown pass list with 31. He also moved from seventh to third on the career passing yards list and crossed 4,000 for his career (4,022).
- ▶ Lafayette scored touchdowns on its first four possessions of the second half.
- ▶ Lafayette won the time of possession battle 38:40-21:20, including 22:56-7:04 in the second half.
- ▶ **A.J. Kizekai** hauled in a 70-yard reception in the second half, helping him record a career-high 140 receiving yards on a career-high seven catches. It was the sixth play of Kizekai's career that went for at least 70 yards and it was his first career 100-yard receiving game (previous high was 99).
- ▶ **Marcello Trigg** attempted a career-high 36 passes, the most pass attempts by a Bison quarterback since 2002 when Cole Ciesnolewicz was 23-for-36 against Georgetown.
- ▶ Lafayette's 475 yards of total offense were the most by a Bison opponent in 2009.

### 100-YARD GAME FOR KIZEKAI

Bucknell has had a 100-yard receiver each of the last two games with **Shaun Pasternak** registering 127 yards against Lehigh and **A.J. Kizekai** recording 140 receiving yards against Lafayette. It is the first time that has been accomplished since last year when Pasternak posted 100-yard outings against Cornell and Marist. Kizekai's 140-yard performance ranks tied for 20th on Bucknell's single-game list.

### LEADING TEAM IN RUSHING AND RECEIVING

Thanks to his 140-yard receiving game, **A.J. Kizekai** now leads the Bison in receiving yards (257). The senior also ranks second in rushing yards with 253. Two years ago he became the first Bucknell player to lead the team in both categories since Ken Jenkins in 1980. No Bison in the last 50 years has accomplished that feat twice.

### LAFAYETTE SHUTS DOWN PASTERNAK

In just his second start of the year, **Shaun Pasternak** was held to three catches for 24 yards against Lafayette. The three catches equaled Pasternak's lowest figure in a start since his freshman year, while the 24 yards were his fewest in a start over the same span.

### THREE-GAME ROAD TRIP

Bucknell began a three-game road trip last Saturday at Lafayette. The Bison last played three in a row on the road in 2005 and went 0-3, facing the same teams they will this year (Lafayette, Fordham, Colgate). Since the Patriot League era began in 1986, Bucknell has had 10 road trips of at least three games.

**TEAM INTERCEPTIONS**

Bucknell has 13 interceptions this year, ranking it first in the Patriot League and nearly doubling its total from all of 2008. Bucknell is tied for 11th nationally in interceptions despite registering just one over the last two games.

**FIRST-QUARTER STRUGGLES**

Bucknell has struggled offensively in the first quarter this year, scoring just 17 of its 118 points during the first 15 minutes of play. In fact, over the last five games the Bison have not scored in the first quarter and are being outscored 30-0 over that span. Bucknell has gone 77:07 without registering a first-quarter point. The Bison have been outscored 56-17 in the opening period this year.

**DOUBLE-FIGURE TACKLES FOR JONES**

Senior **LB Greg Jones** recorded 12 tackles last week at Lafayette, marking his career-best third consecutive game with double-figure stops. He now has had at least 10 tackles in 10 of his last 14 games, dating back to last year's Georgetown contest. Jones has a total of 145 tackles over that 14-game span and now has 232 career tackles. The last Bison to have more tackles in a career was Dorian Petersen, who piled up 304 stops in his four-year career from 2003-06. Additionally, Jones is in position to become the first Bucknell player to lead the team in tackles in back-to-back years since Stephane Pluiose in 2001 and 2002.

**RED ZONE SUCCESS**

Bucknell and its last four opponents have combined to score on all 21 attempts inside the Red Zone. The Bison are 7-for-7 over that four-game span, while their opponents are 14-for-14. Opponents have scored 13 touchdowns in 13 opportunities in the Red Zone over the last three games (Penn, Lehigh, Lafayette).

**LESS RUNNING**

Bucknell has been held under 100 yards rushing each of the last two games, marking the third time in the last two years the Bison have failed to reach the century mark in back-to-back contests. Bucknell, which changed its offense from a run-based option to a spread option last year, has not been held under 100 yards rushing for three consecutive games since the 2002 campaign, the year before seventh-year head coach **Tim Landis** arrived on campus.

**SIX STRAIGHT UNDER 20 POINTS**

Bucknell has not exceeded 20 points since its 26-23 victory over Robert Morris in week two. It is the first time the Bison have failed to score 20 points in six consecutive games since 1991. Bucknell went over 20 points just once in 10 games that season and that was against Fordham in its only win.

**TOUCHDOWN TRIGG**

Senior **QB Marcello Trigg** connected with **A.J. Kizekai** on a 19-yard touchdown strike vs. Lafayette. It was the 31st touchdown pass of Trigg's career, moving him into sole possession of second place on the program's all-time list. After tossing 13 touchdowns last year, Trigg has six this year. Trigg has now accounted for 48 career scores (31 passing, 17 rushing).

**CONSECUTIVE QB STARTS**

**Marcello Trigg** has not started consecutive games at quarterback since last year. He is listed first on the depth chart this week. Only **C.J. Hopson**, who started back-to-back weeks against Penn and Lehigh, has been in the starting lineup at quarterback two straight Saturdays this season. Trigg, who has 27 career starts, last started two consecutive games last year against Colgate and Holy Cross.

**QB SACKS**

While Bucknell's pass rush is greatly improved from last year when it recorded 14 sacks, it has been in a little slump of late. The Bison tallied 15 sacks in their first five games, including four multiple-sack outings. However, Bucknell has not had a sack in the last three games, its longest stretch since 2003 when it went four contests in a row without a sack.

**CAREER-HIGH TACKLES**

Both **Travis Nissley** (15 tackles) and **Jamal Briggs** (10) recorded double-figure tackles and recorded new career highs against Lafayette. Nissley now has three games with at least 10 tackles this year and ranks second on the team with a career-high 65 stops. He is averaging 9.6 tackles in his six starts. Briggs, a defensive back who made his second straight start against Lafayette, entered the game with 21 tackles on the season and 26 in his career. his previous career high was five tackles.

**IMPROVED DEFENSE**

Bucknell's defense has been improved this year. The Bison have bettered their numbers in five key categories from 2008.

**STRONG DEFENSIVE OPPONENTS**

For just the second time in its last six games Bucknell will be facing a team not currently ranked in the top third of FCS in total defense. In recent weeks the Bison have played Penn (No. 3 defense), Marist (No. 6 defense), Lehigh (No. 21 defense) and Lafayette (No. 32 defense). Fordham ranks 110th out of 118 teams in total defense.

**CLOSING IN ON TOP 10**

Thanks to his 10 catches this year, **Shaun Pasternak** now has 95 in his three-year career. That figure places him 11th in program history. If he hauls in five more passes he will become the ninth Bison to record at least 100 career receptions. Tom Mitchell holds the program record with 173.

**NARROW MARGINS OF VICTORIES**

Bucknell has won eight games over the last two seasons and most have been close. The last eight Bison wins have come by a combined 31 points, an average of less than four points per game. The eight-point margin of victory over Georgetown earlier this month marked Bucknell's largest win since a 14-point triumph in the 2007 season finale at Fordham.

**RECENT SUCCESS IN CLOSE GAMES**

Bucknell has had success in close games in recent years. In fact, the Bison have posted a 9-4 record in games decided by seven points or less since 2006.

**OFFENSIVE LINE CONSISTENCY**

Bucknell has had the same five players start on the offensive line in each of the season's first seven games. Four members (**Anthony Carter, Ian Dal Bello, Nick McLeod, James Phelan**) of the current Bison line have been part of the starting unit every game (19) since the beginning of last year. The five members of the Bucknell offensive line have started a combined 90 times in their careers.

**YELLOW FLAGS**

Bucknell was the least-penalized team in the nation in 2007 and 2008 and that seems to be continuing this year. The Bison rank first nationally in fewest penalties per game (3.5) and third nationally in fewest penalty yards per game (35.0). Bucknell has committed fewer penalties than its opponents in each of its last 13 outings. Over that span the Bison have been penalized 38 times for 365 yards, while their opponents have piled up 749 penalty yards on 82 penalties.
