BISON NOTES & NOTABLES

WITH A VICTORY OVER COLGATE, BUCKNELL WOULD ...

- ... reach seven wins for the first time since 2004.
- ... finish a school-record +6 in the win category from 2010.
- ... post its first winning Patriot League record since 2004.
- ... win four road games in a season for the first time since going 6-1 on the road in 1997.
- ... record its first in-season three-game winning streak since 2004.
- ... win its season finale for the fifth time in the last six years.
- ... defeat the Raiders in Hamilton for the first time since 1999.
- ... sweep a three-game road trip for the first time since 1997 (happened just once since 1952, a span of 22 three-game road trips).
- ... end a season on a three-game winning streak for the first time since winning final four contests in 2004.

ABOUT THE GAME

Bucknell and Colgate will close out their 2011 campaigns Saturday at Andy Kerr Stadium. The Bison were picked last in the Patriot League preseason poll, while the Raiders were predicted to finish second. The two teams have almost flipped those preseason guesses as Bucknell will finish in a tie for second with a victory and Colgate would finish without a league win. The Bison enter the game on a two-game winning streak, while the Raiders have lost three in a row and are coming off a bye week. Bucknell and Colgate will pit their strengths against each other as the Raiders rank 15th nationally in rushing (218.4 yards per game), while the Bison are third nationally against the run (65.8 yards per game). Bucknell's defense, which has forced a FCS-most 38 turnovers this year, has been especially stingy of late, yielding just 29 points over the last three outings.

BUCKNELL VS. COLGATE SERIES NOTES

- Colgate leads 43-16.
- Colgate has won four in a row.
- The home team is 7-3 in the last 10 meetings.
- Bucknell has lost five in a row in Hamilton.
- First meeting was in 1894.
- The winning team has scored at least 28 points in seven of the last eight meetings. The average winning score has been nearly 35 points over that span.

LAST TIME VS. COLGATE

Colgate 31, Bucknell 7 (Nov. 13, 2010 - Lewisburg, Pa.)

- Bucknell's **Josh Eden** blocked three Colgate extra points, tying the NCAA single-game record. The Raiders missed four extra points in all.
- Three of Colgate's touchdowns were scored on plays of at least 30 yards.
- Bucknell's defense held Colgate to 328 yards of total offense, nearly 76 below its average.
- The Bison avoided their first shutout since 2006 when Rob Gerlach returned a fumble 58 yards for Bucknell's only score with 2:32 left in fourth quarter.

INSIDE THE FORDHAM BOX SCORE

- Bucknell posted its first shutout since defeating Georgetown 34-0 on Oct. 20, 2001.
- Bucknell forced five turnovers and did not turn the ball over even once, extending its nation's-best turnover margin to +28 for the season. Four of Fordham's five miscues came in the first half when the Bison built a 14-0 lead.
- Bucknell **RB Tyler Smith** ran 28 times for 204 yards, his second straight 200-yard outing. He broke the program record for most rushing yards (416) in back-to-back games.
- Bucknell **RB Tyler Smith** became just the fourth Bison, following Rich Lemon, Jabu Powell and Daris Wilson, to record at least two career 200-yard rushing games.

• Bison **DB Bryce Robertson** posted his third consecutive multi-interception game with two picks. He broke the Bucknell single-season record for interceptions that had stood for 41 years.

• Junior **RB Jeremiah Young** returned to the Bison lineup for the first time since Oct. 8 and rushed 12 times for 63 yards and a touchdown.

• Freshman **WR Jake Hartman**, playing in just his second career game, hauled in his first career reception.

• Bucknell clinched its first winning record since 2006 and guaranteed at least a .500 finish on the road for the first time since 2008.

• Bucknell equaled the program record for the largest win improvement from one season to the next (+5).

• Fordham was shut out for the second time in three games.

QUITE THE IMPROVEMENT

Bucknell is 6-4 overall this year, one season after finishing with a 1-10 mark. The Bison have the second-largest win improvement in the country, behind only Towson's +7. Bucknell has equaled the best one-year turnaround in program history (+5), which was accomplished by the 1891, 1949, 1954 and 2006 teams.

TYLER SMITH RUSHING FACTS

• Junior **RB Tyler Smith** rushed for 370 yards on 102 carries the first eight games of the season. The last two contests he has piled up 416 yards on 70 carries.

• Smith's two-game rushing total of 416 yards is the most by a Bison in back-to-back games in program history, eclipsing Rich Lemon's 403 yards vs. Holy Cross (196) and Colgate (207) in 1995.

• Smith leads the Bison with a Patriot League-best 786 yards this year. It is the most yards by a Bison running back since Blamah Sarnor rushed for 928 yards in 2003.

• Smith has scored four touchdowns the last two games, and eight overall this year. No Bison has rushed for that many touchdowns since Daris Wilson crossed the goal line 17 times in 2004.

• Smith is just the fourth Bison to post two career 200-yard rushing games, joining Rich Lemon (3), Jabu Powell (2) and Daris Wilson (2). Smith now ranks ninth and 15th on Bucknell's single-game rushing list thanks to his last two outings.

• Smith has the first three 100-yard rushing outings of his career this season. He is the 28th player in program history with at least three career 100-yard rushing performances.

• Smith needs 180 yards vs. Colgate to join the program's single-season top-10 rushing list and he needs 307 yards to break into the career top-10 list.

BRYCE ROBERTSON INTERCEPTION FACTS

• Senior **DB Bryce Robertson** leads the nation in interceptions this season with 12. He has at least one interception in eight of the Bison's 10 games and has posted three straight multi-interception outings.

• Robertson owns both the Patriot League and Bucknell single-season interception records. He broke Dave Murphy's (Holy Cross) Patriot League mark of nine that had stood since 1987 and he surpassed Gene Luccarelli's Bison standard of 10 that had stood since 1970.

• Robertson is currently tied with former Princeton defensive back Dean Cain for the most interceptions per game in FCS history. Cain, who became famous as an actor in the 1990s television show *Lois & Clark: The New Adventures of Superman*, finished the 1987 campaign with 12 interceptions in 10 games for an average of 1.2 per contest. Robertson will need two picks vs. Colgate to surpass that record.

• North Carolina State's David Amerson is the only other player in all of college football (FBS & FCS) to have at least 10 interceptions this year, and only five players outside of Robertson have more than six picks this season.

• Robertson needs two interceptions vs. Colgate to tie the NCAA FCS record of 14 interceptions held by Bethune-Cookman's Rashean Mathis (2002). He is currently tied for second on the NCAA FCS single-season ledger with Cain.

• Robertson has piled up 184 interception return yards this year, 34 more than Kevin Eiben's previous Bucknell single-season record.

• Robertson's 12 interceptions are two more than the number of times Bucknell has turned the ball over this year.

THREE-GAME WINNING STREAK?

Bucknell, which has posted three separate winning streaks in the same season for the first time since 1949, will be aiming for its first in-season three-game winning streak since 2004 on Saturday at Colgate. The Bison have had just two same-season winning streaks of at least three games since the beginning of the 2002 campaign, and both came in 2004.

PUNTING RECORD FOR GUTOWSKI

It might be a record he doesn't necessarily want, but junior **P Ryan Gutowski** broke the Bucknell record for punts in a season last week at Fordham. John Toman (72 in 1991) previously held the record. Gutowski has punted 74 times this season and is averaging 37.0 yards per boot. He is tied with Northern Colorado's Cameron Kaman and Delaware State's Marco Kane for the most punts in the nation this year. Interestingly, those two teams are a combined 2-19, while Bucknell is 6-4.

Bucknell is in the midst of its third winning streak this season. The Bison last posted three winning streaks in the same campaign in 1949. It also occurred in 1899, 1901, 1913, 1922, 1933 and 1935.

SEASON FINALES

Bucknell has had outstanding success in its final game of the season in recent years. The Bison have won their finale four of the last five seasons, and six of the last eight. The only losses during that stretch came as part of 1-10 campaigns in 2005 and 2010. Twice in the last four years Bucknell has defeated a ranked opponent to close the season.

.500 RECORD

With its win over Fordham last week Bucknell clinched its first .500 record since 2006. The Bison finished with at least a .500 record 10 times in a 12-year span from 1995 to 2006.

+28 TURNOVERS

Bucknell ranks first in the nation in turnover margin at +2.80 per game. The Bison have forced 38 turnovers (21 INT, 17 FUM), while they have committed just 10 miscues (6 INT, 4 FUM). Bucknell has forced at least five turnovers in a game four times this season, and those turnovers alone would rank the Bison tied for 23rd nationally in turnovers gained.

BISON AMONG NATION'S LEADERS IN INTERCEPTIONS

Thanks to **DB Bryce Robertson's** FCS-leading 12 interceptions, Bucknell is tied for first in the nation in interceptions with 21. The Bison are tied with Alabama State and Florida A&M. Bucknell's record for interceptions in a season is 31 by the 1944 team, while the undefeated 1951 squad had 30.

ANOTHER BLOCK FOR EDEN

Senior **DE Josh Eden** added another block to his tally last Saturday at Fordham when he got his hand on a 30-yard field goal attempt by Michael Marando. It was Eden's third career blocked field goal, and his 11th career blocked kick overall. He now ranks tied for fifth on the NCAA FCS all-time list. Eden, this year, has three blocks (2 PAT, 1 FG) after registering eight blocks (6 PAT, 2 FG) in 2010.

SHUTOUTS

Bucknell's shutout last week at Fordham was its first since Oct. 20, 2001 against Georgetown. The Bison have had just four shutouts in their last 309 games dating back to the 1983 campaign.

SUSAN CONTINUES SECOND-YEAR TREND

Bucknell head coach **Joe Susan** has guaranteed he will be the fourth consecutive Bison coach to post a record above .500 in his second season at the helm of the program. Lou Maranzana (7-4 in 1990), Tom Gadd (6-5 in 1996) and Tim Landis (7-4 in 2004) were all above .500 in their second years.

AVOIDING SHUTOUTS

Bucknell has not been shut out since Sept. 9, 2006, against Lafayette. The Bison have scored in each of their 63 games since then, equaling the program record for most consecutive games scoring points. Bucknell also went 63 games without being shut out from 1996 to 2002.

DENICK CROSSES 500 YARDS

Senior **WR Frank DeNick** leads the Bison with a career-high 503 receiving yards this year. That figure is the second-most by a Bison since 2003, behind only Shaun Pasternak's 1,083 yards in 2008. DeNick enters Saturday's Colgate contest 74 yards shy of 1,000 in his career.

RUSHING DEFENSE

Bucknell has held eight of its 10 opponents under 100 yards rushing and ranks third nationally in rushing defense, limiting opponents to 65.8 yards per game. Opponents are averaging just 2.2 yards per carry. Bucknell, on the other hand, has rushed for 1,219 yards and is averaging 3.1 yards per rush.

DEFENSE GETTING BEHIND THE LINE

Bucknell's defense has registered at least five tackles for loss in every game and has 72 total. In recent years, only the 2004 (83 TFL) squad has totaled more tackles for loss. The Bison's 25 sacks this year are the most since that 2004 squad that featured future NFL player Sean Conover also posted 25 sacks.

SECOND PLACE IN PATRIOT LEAGUE?

With a win Saturday at Colgate, Bucknell will finish in a three-way tie for second place with Georgetown and Holy Cross in the final Patriot League standings. The Bison, who are attempting to finish above .500 in conference play for the first time since 2004, have not finished as high as second in the league standings since going 5-1 in 1997.

FOUR ROAD WINS?

In addition to being the last Bison team to finish second in the Patriot League standings, the 1997 squad was also the last to win as many as four road games in a season, something the 2011 edition will be aiming for Saturday at Colgate. Bucknell is 3-2 on the road this year and no Bison squad has posted four road victories since the 1997 squad was 6-1.

TIME OF POSSESSION

Bucknell ranks fifth nationally with an average time of possession of 33:22. The Bison have had six games this year where they have had greater than 34 minutes of possession time, including each of the last two contests against Lafayette and Fordham. Bucknell is 5-1 this year when possessing the ball for at least 34 minutes.

DAL BELLO TO START EVERY GAME OF CAREER

Senior **OL Ian Dal Bello** is listed first on the depth chart for a 44th consecutive week this week. The senior, who moved from left guard to center this year, has started every game of his four-year career. Senior **DE Josh Eden** will also be making his 44th career start this week, but he missed the 2008 and 2009 campaigns while on a Mormon mission. Dal Bello is part of an offensive line that features four senior starters and has combined for 128 career starting assignments.

ALL-PURPOSE CHAMPION

A Bucknell or Colgate player has led the Patriot League in all-purpose yards each of the last five years and **Tyler Smith** is trying to make it six in a row. He enters Saturday's game first in the Patriot League, and 11th nationally, in all-purpose yards per game (155.0). Colgate's Jordan Scott led the Patriot League in the category in 2006 and 2007, while Bucknell's A.J. Kizekai topped the conference in 2008 and 2009. Current Raider Nate Eachus led the league last year. Smith has a career-high 1,550 all-purpose yards, which is good for sixth on the program's single-season ledger.

A HEALTHY TEAM IS A SUCCESSFUL TEAM

Bucknell has been relatively healthy this year, which is exhibited by its starting lineups. The Bison have had just 15 different players start games on the offensive side of the ball and only 13 on defense. Bucknell has had the same starter in all 10 games at 16 of the 22 positions on the field. In 2010, the Bison had 18 different offensive starters and 18 different defensive starters.

MILESTONE WATCH

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Bucknell senior **LB Tim Bolte** was recently named to the Capital One Academic All-District II Football Team. It was the second consecutive All-District honor for Bolte, who now advances to the national Academic All-America ballot. At least one Bucknell football player has earned Academic All-District recognition in 11 of the last 12 years and Bolte is the first two-time Bison Academic All-District selection since David Frisbey in 2005 and 2006. A three-time Patriot League Academic Honor Roll member who has earned a 4.0 grade-point average each of the last three semesters, Bolte owns a 3.93 cumulative GPA while majoring in East Asian Studies (Chinese) and political science.
