HEAD COACH TIM LANDIS

After helping the Bison achieve one of the best turnaround seasons in the country in 2006, Tim Landis returns for his fifth year as the Bob Odell Head Coach of Bucknell Football.



Relying heavily on first and second-year players, Landis guided the Bison to a 6-5 record last season (3-3 Patriot League), a five-win improvement over a trying 2005 campaign that was flagged by injuries. Actually, injuries hampered the Bison again last season, particularly at quarterback and running back, but with a much deeper squad, Bucknell was able to overcome the ailments.

Having already resurrected programs at Davidson and St. Mary's, Landis arrived at Bucknell in December 2002 to take over a football program that was undergoing a trying period.

As Landis' first spring practice approached, the Bison were still coping with the death of legendary head coach Tom Gadd, and they were still tasting the bitterness of a 2-9 record that ended a school-record run of seven straight winning seasons.

But under Landis' leadership, pride was quickly restored in the program, and the Bison turned in two very good seasons, first going 6-6 in 2003 then improving to 7-4 in 2004. Bucknell placed third in the competitive Patriot League standings both seasons.

Landis has coached both an All-American (DL Sean Conover) and an Academic All-American (OL Justin Gibson, DB David Frisbey) during his tenure at Bucknell.

Upon his hiring, Landis, 43, brought to the Bison football program an impressive cache of head coaching experience. He became Bucknell's 25th head football coach since the program's inception in 1883.

Following a seven-year tenure as head coach at Davidson, Landis spent the three seasons prior to coming to Bucknell building a solid program at St. Mary's (Calif.). In both positions, he garnered national accolades for turning modestly successful programs into winners.

BISON NOTES & NOTABLES

WITH A VICTORY OVER FORDHAM, BUCKNELL WOULD ...

- ▶ ... snap a five-game losing streak and finish 3-8 on the season.
- ▶ ... snap the Rams' six-game winning streak.
- ▶ ... win in The Bronx for the first time since 2003.
- ▶ ... win its season finale for the second straight year and fourth time in five years under **Tim Landis**.

ABOUT THE GAME

Bucknell's 2007 season comes to a conclusion Saturday afternoon at Jack Coffey Field, as the Bison take on Patriot League champion Fordham. It's been a tough season for Bucknell, which has dropped five games in a row and has experienced an offensive brownout in recent weeks. The Bison would like to wrap things up with a victory to avoid a winless conference ledger, but in order to do so they will have to defeat a Fordham team that has been one of the biggest surprises in FCS football this season. Picked to finish sixth in the Patriot League preseason poll, the Rams have already clinched at least a share of the league title and the automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, and they are one win away from running the table in conference play. Led by QB John Skelton and the RB tandem of Jonte Coven and Xavier Martin, Fordham has a balanced offense that averages 192.0 yards on the ground and 204.1 through the air. Punter Ben Dato and the Rams lead the nation in net punting (40.9). Defensively, Fordham ranks last in the Patriot League in passing defense, allowing 244.6 yards per game, and the Rams are fifth in overall yards allowed at 404.6 per game.

BUCKNELL VS. FORDHAM SERIES NOTES

- ▶ This will be the 23rd all-time meeting between Bucknell and Fordham. The Bison lead the series 14-8.
- ▶ **Tim Landis** is 3-1 against Fordham, including a 31-10 victory in 2003 when the Rams were ranked 15th nationally.
- ▶ The two teams met each year from 1929-32, but not again until Fordham joined the Patriot League in 1989. As league rivals, Bucknell has a 13-5 series lead.
- ▶ Bucknell has won 8 of 13 previous meetings in The Bronx, although Fordham won there two years ago, 28-21.

BUCKNELL VS. FORDHAM LAST SEASON

Last Oct. 28 in Lewisburg, **Josh DeStefano** rushed for 180 yards, **Will Carney** kicked two field goals and Bucknell's defense kept Fordham out of the end zone in a 13-3 win. Bucknell rushed for 272 yards, but its biggest play of the day came on a pass. Leading 6-3 with 2:56 to play, **QB Marcello Trigg** found **RB A.J. Kizekai** out of the backfield for a 44-yard touchdown pass to put the game away. Trigg had completed only 1 of 12 passes prior to the home run toss to Kizekai. Jonte Coven led Fordham with 83 rushing yards on 13 carries, while John Skelton completed 10 of 22 passes for 89 yards.

GAME 10 RECAP

Last Saturday at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium, Bucknell wrapped up its home schedule with a 38-10 loss to Lehigh. After falling behind 14-0, the Bison scored 10 points in the second quarter on a 4-yard run by **QB Terrance Wilson** and a 37-yard field goal by **K Will Carney**, and they went to the locker room trailing only 14-10. But Lehigh drove the length of the field to start the second half, scoring on the second of Sedale Threatt's three touchdowns on the day. The Mountain Hawks scored on their first four possessions of the second half while completely shutting down Bucknell's offense. The Bison finished with -3 total yards in the third quarter and eight total yards in the second half.

INSIDE THE LEHIGH BOXSCORE

- ▶ Lehigh outgained Bucknell 382-182, including 259-8 in the second half.
- ▶ One week after committing five turnovers at Lafayette, the Bison had three more last week, all coming on fumbles.
- ▶ Freshman fullback **Ryan Smith** led the team in rushing with 32 yards.
- ▶ **Terrance Wilson** earned the starting quarterback assignment on Senior Day and scored his fourth rushing touchdown of the season.

KIZEKAI BREAKS RECORD

A.J. Kizekai needed only seven games to break the school record for kickoff return yards in a single season. Troy White's previous record had held up for 13 years. Now Kizekai has become the first player in school history to top 1,000 return yards in a season. Kizekai also recently broke White's record for kickoff return attempts in a season (he now has 40), and he is nearing the Patriot League mark of 41, set by Georgetown's Kenny Mitchell last season.

HAVE A DAY, A.J.

Sophomore **RB A.J. Kizekai** had a game for the record books against Colgate on Oct. 6. He became the first player in Bucknell history to score rushing, receiving and kickoff return touchdowns in the same game. In fact, it had been 22 years since a Bucknell player had scored in each of those ways in the same season. Kizekai had a 5-yard touchdown run and a 92-yard kickoff return touchdown in the first quarter, and just before halftime he grabbed a 19-yard TD reception. The 92-yarder was the seventh-longest kickoff return and the eighth-longest touchdown of any kind in Bucknell annals. It was the first kickoff return touchdown of his career, and it was also the first three-touchdown day of his career. All three of his scores came with Bucknell trailing by seven points and tied the game. The last Bucknell player to score via run, catch and kickoff return in one year was Earl Beecham in 1985.

KIZEKAI TAKES DRIVE ON I-80

Sophomore **RB A.J. Kizekai** has been enjoying an all-star season for the Bison, and he further padded his resume with an electrifying 80-yard run in the second half against Holy Cross. Kizekai's burst was the seventh-longest touchdown run from scrimmage in school history, and it was the first rushing touchdown of at least 80 yards since Rich Lemon's 83-yard run against Cornell in 1994.

HEARTBREAK HOTEL

Bucknell had gone two years without losing a game by a touchdown or less, but the Bison recently dropped two straight games in heartbreaking fashion. On Oct. 6 at Colgate, Bucknell led 24-21 until the Raiders came out of a late weather delay and drove the field for the winning touchdown with only 31 seconds remaining. Then a week later against Georgetown, the Hoyas kicked the game-winning field goal with 10 seconds left to turn back the Bison 20-17.

PASTERNAK HONORED

Freshman **WR Shaun Pasternak** entered the Georgetown game with just one career catch for four yards, but he exploded for six catches for 83 yards and two touchdowns against the Hoyas, and he earned Patriot League Rookie of the Week honors for the first time. Pasternak caught a tipped ball in the end zone with only five seconds left in the first half, then he had the dramatic touchdown catch on a similar fade pattern with 43 seconds to play in the game. He became the first Bucknell receiver to catch two TD passes in one game since Ian Nutt and Nisan Trotter each did on Sept. 25, 2004 against Columbia. Pasternak was rewarded with his first collegiate start last week against Holy Cross.

- ▶Through 10 games **A.J. Kizekai** leads Bucknell in six statistical categories: touchdowns (6), rushing yards (375), receptions (16), receiving yards (281), all-purpose yards (1,705) and kickoff return yards (1,049).
- ▶Kizekai is bidding to become the first Bucknell player to lead the team in rushing yards and receptions in the same season since Ken Jenkins in 1980.
- ▶Bucknell is averaging a solid 11.5 yards per punt return, second-best in the Patriot League and 22nd-best in the nation. **Nolan Applegate's** 28-yard return against Georgetown was the team's longest of the season.
- ▶With Kizekai handling the bulk of the load, Bucknell ranks 14th nationally in kickoff return average (23.7). Last season, the Bison ranked 92nd at 17.5 yards per return.
- ▶Nine different Bison have combined for 12 interceptions this season. **LB Todd Manjuck**, **DB Jason Davis** and **DB Ahkiel White** lead the team with two each.
- ▶**LB Todd Manjuck**, who took over as a starter midway through this season, now leads the team in tackles with 69. He had a career-high 14 against Marist and added 13 more at Lafayette.
- ▶Nine different Bison have at least one sack and 24 players have a tackle for loss this season. **DL Josh Eden** leads the way in both categories with 3.5 sacks and 10 TFLs.

MOZAL A DRADDY TROPHY SEMIFINALIST

Bucknell senior **TE Nick Mozal** has been selected by the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame as one of 153 semifinalists across all divisions of college football for the Draddy Trophy, presented by HealthSouth, which is often referred to as the "Academic Heisman." Mozal has played in every game this season, primarily as the team's No. 1 tight end, and he has also played some at offensive tackle. Primarily used as a run-blocker in Bucknell's ground-oriented spread-option offense, Mozal is expected to earn his third varsity letter this year. He has played in all but one game since the start of his sophomore year and has three career catches to his credit. Off the field, Mozal's cumulative grade-point average of 3.77 is one of the highest on the team. A political science and economics double major, he has made the Bucknell Dean's List (3.5 or better) in every semester, and he is on track to graduate in 3 1/2 years. Mozal is one of 40 semifinalists from the Division I Football Championship Subdivision, and one of only two from the Patriot League, joining Georgetown's Kyle Van Fleet.

WALSH NAMED TO ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT TEAM

Senior **DL Ryan Walsh** was named to the *ESPN the Magazine* Academic All-District Team last week. A history major with a 3.41 cumulative GPA, Walsh is a Patriot League Academic Honor Roll member. On the field, he has started every game since the start of his sophomore season, and in 2007 he has 37 tackles, including five for loss and two sacks.

CARNEY BREAKS PAT STREAK RECORD

Last week junior **K Will Carney** extended his school record for consecutive PATs. Carney has now made 53 in a row, breaking the previous record of 40, set by Al Yuknus in 1983-84 and Ryan Korn in 2003-04.

NO-FLAG ZONE ...

Bucknell has long been one of the least-penalized teams in FCS football, but the Bison have taken their law abidance to another level in 2007. Bucknell did not receive a single penalty on Sept. 22 against Richmond and last week against Lehigh, and they were flagged only once against Colgate on Oct. 6. The Bison continue to lead the nation in fewest penalties and penalty yards per game.

APPEGATE MOVES TO OFFENSE, GETS NOTICED RIGHT AWAY

Junior **Nolan Applegate**, once buried on the depth chart at cornerback, was recruited by the offensive coaches to come over and play slotback just prior to the Richmond game. He made enough of an impact in practice to get on the field for a handful of plays against Richmond, and things certainly happened when he touched the ball. Applegate scored his first career touchdown on his first career carry, a 9-yard run in the second quarter. The former high school running back/quarterback was also asked to make two halfback option passes. The first went for a 44-yard completion to **WR Cale Cadman**, the second was intercepted in the end zone. Against Marist, Applegate started at slotback and caught two long passes while rushing for 14 yards on four carries. He also had a 58-yard reception against Colgate — the team's longest of the year — before leaving with an injury. Applegate, Bucknell's Special Teams MVP last season, also continues in his role as the No. 1 punt returner.

JONES MAKES UNUSUAL TRANSITION

It is doubtful that many teams can claim a starting linebacker that a year earlier was playing quarterback, but Bucknell has one in sophomore **Greg Jones**. The Springfield, Va., native came in as a QB but was moved to linebacker early in his freshman year. He played the position in two junior varsity games and made a team-high 16 tackles, and later he was named the team's defensive Scout Team Player of the Year. This season, Jones won a starting position in preseason camp and has 60 tackles through 10 games, third-most on the squad.

NO. 122

Bucknell is completing its 122nd season of football. Only Princeton (138), Yale (135), Harvard (133), Penn (131), Lafayette (126), Dartmouth (126), Massachusetts (125), Lehigh (124) and Richmond (124) have played longer among FCS teams. Bucknell ranks 17th among all FCS programs with 554 all-time victories.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Bucknell has 25 freshmen and sophomores on this week's offensive and defensive two-deeps, including all eight in the defensive secondary.

IN THE CLASSROOM

Bucknell produced a solid 3.06 combined team grade-point average last semester, and in the fall of 2006 the Bison placed 18 student-athletes on the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll (lettermen with 3.20 GPA or higher). Last year starting cornerback David Frisbey earned national ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America honors and was a semifinalist for the Draddy Trophy, also known as the "Academic Heisman." **Nick Mozal** is up for the same award this season.

PITTSBURGH, Pa. — Marcello Trigg completed 8 of 14 passes for 156 yards and a career-high two touchdowns and the Bison defense held Duquesne scoreless for the final 38:56 of the game in a 28-19 season-opening victory over the Dukes Saturday evening at Art Rooney Field.

After a wild first half that featured a combined 40 points, 414 yards and five lead changes, both defenses took control in the second half as just seven points were scored after intermission. The Bison were especially strong on defense, holding the Dukes to 96 yards in the second half after 276 in the first half. Ryan Walsh made the key defensive play with just under five minutes left when he sacked Duquesne quarterback Scott Knapp on a fourth-and-13 in Bison territory. The Dukes were 0-for-6 on third down and 0-for-1 on fourth in the second half.

Bucknell limited Duquesne standout receiver Bruce Hocker without a catch in the second half after he had four catches for 104 yards and a one touchdown in the first half. Bucknell fullback Corin Erby scored the lone touchdown of the second half when he plunged across the goal line from one yard out midway through the third quarter. It was his second touchdown of the game and completed a 7-play, 37-yard drive.

The high-scoring first half opened with both teams connecting on two long touchdown passes in the first 30 minutes, and Erby's 4-yard scoring run 1:36 before halftime gave the Bison a 21-19 lead.

LEWISBURG, Pa. — Conte Cuttino returned a kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown and ran for a 20-yard score to help Stony Brook erase an early seven-point deficit, and the Seawolves pulled away with three late scores to outlast Bucknell 48-20 at muggy Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. Josh Dudash completed 21 of 30 passes for 233 yards and two touchdowns to lift Stony Brook to 2-0.

A.J. Kizekai had his second straight big game for Bucknell, collecting 251 all-purpose yards. He totaled 167 on six kickoff returns, caught two passes for 40 yards and ran for 44 yards on seven carries. Freshman fullback Ryan Smith ran for a team-high 46 yards and scored his first collegiate touchdown on a 3-yard run just 19 seconds before halftime. That score brought Bucknell within 27-17, and Will Carney's 19-yard field goal on the opening possession of the second half made it a one-possession game at 27-20.

Stony Brook quickly answered with a 6-play, 55-yard drive, capped by a 15-yard pass from Dudash to Dwayne Eley with 6:14 left in the third quarter. Moments later, Donald Lee smothered a Bucknell punt, and Andre Jean-Pierre ran it back 24 yards to put the game out of reach at 41-20. Eley added a second score on a 1-yard run with 9:21 to play.

Kevin Mullen's 1-yard run gave the Bison a 7-0 first-quarter lead, but Cuttino ran the ensuing kickoff back 95 yards to even the game at 7-7. LEWISBURG, Pa. — Tim Hightower set a Richmond record with 295 rushing yards and scored four long touchdowns to lead the visiting Spiders to a 45-14 victory. Terrance Wilson and Nolan Applegate scored touchdowns for the Bison.

For the second straight game the Spiders rolled up more than 400 points and 600 total yards. LEWISBURG, Pa. — The Bucknell quarterback tandem of Marcello Trigg and Terrance Wilson combined for five rushing touchdowns, and Wilson and Justin Pulgrano both went over 100 yards rushing in a convincing 38-7 victory over Marist.

Bucknell showed some outstanding backfield depth in this one, as Trigg and Wilson both moved the ball effectively at quarterback while rotating throughout the game. Trigg rushed nine times for 32 yards and three touchdowns, while Wilson had four carries for 108 yards, including scoring runs of 43 and 56 yards. Trigg became the first Bucknell player to rush for three touchdowns in a game since Dante Ross against Marist here in 2005. Wilson's 100-yard game was the first of his career.

Trailing 21-0 after Gass turned a screen pass into a 47-yard touchdown, the Bison got on the board at the 2:02 mark of the first quarter when Trigg hit Kizekai on a 16-yard pass. Bucknell's defense appeared to have its first stop of the day on the next series, when safety Tyler McFarlane broke up Randolph's third-down pass, but the Bison were flagged for a late hit on the quarterback, giving Holy Cross an automatic first down. Seven plays later, Randolph lobbed a 16-yard TD pass to Thomas Harrison, quelling Bucknell's momentum.

EASTON, Pa. — Lafayette's defense forced five turnovers, had a key punt block and allowed only five first downs in a 34-7 Patriot League victory over Bucknell at Fisher Stadium. Matt Ferber rushed for 102 yards and Brandon Mitchell scored a pair of rushing touchdowns to help the Leopards.

Lafayette came into the game ranked fourth in the nation in total defense and sixth in rushing defense, and they held Bucknell to 66 rushing yards and 156 total yards. Forced away from their normally strong rushing attack, the Bison struggled through the air, as quarterbacks Marcello Trigg and Terrance Wilson combined to complete only 6 of 20 passes for 90 yards. Trigg had thrown only two interceptions all season, but he was intercepted twice in this one. Combined with three lost fumbles, the Bison possessed the ball for only 20 minutes, compared to 40 for Lafayette.

Defensively, the Bison forced four turnovers of their own and scored their lone TD on a 14-yard fumble return by Josh Lee after a botched punt snap.

Bucknell's defense was terrific for most of the first half, but it gave up a big play just two snaps after the special teams touchdown. On one of the Leopards' few down-the-field passes, Rob Curley connected with Shaun Adair on a 49-yard touchdown pass, giving Lafayette a 14-7 lead at the 10:48 mark of the second period.

Later in the half, Curley's 37-yard pass to DeAndre' Morrow set up a 24-yard Davis Rodriguez field goal.

Lafayette extended its lead to 20-7 on a 27-yard Rodriguez field goal with 6:43 left in the third quarter, and after a Corin Erby fumble at his own 41, the Leopards put it away on Mitchell's second 1-yard dive with 3:21 left in the third.

LEWISBURG, Pa. — Lehigh's Jaren Walker rushed for 94 yards and Sedale Threatt added 78 and three touchdowns to lift the Mountain Hawks to a 38-10 win over Bucknell on Senior Day. The Bison trailed just 14-10 at halftime but were forced to punt three times and fumbled once on their four second-half possessions, while the Mountain Hawks scored on all four of theirs.

Bucknell overcame three first-half turnovers to trail by just four points at halftime. The Bison fell behind 14-0 in the first quarter as Lehigh capitalized on the turnovers with a pair of touchdowns. Bucknell managed only eight total yards in the second half and 182 total, compared to 382 for Lehigh. The Bison rushed for 117 yards, led by Smith's 32, as eight different Bucknell players received carries in the contest.
