2007-08: Co-captain ... earned an automatic bid to the NCAA Championships with a second-place finish in the 133-pound bracket at the EIWA Tournament as the No. 3 seed ... spent most of the season in the top-20 nationally, according to the *InterMat/NWMA/NWCA Individual Rankings*, peaking at No. 14 ... notched wins over Stephen Sabreen of Franklin & Marshall, Bryan Ortenzio of Penn and Seth Ciasulli of Lehigh in the EIWA Championships before falling by one point, a 5-4 decision, to Joe Baker of Navy in the championship bout ... win over Ciasulli was his 50th of his career ... tied for a team-best record of 16-5 in duals with seven bonus point victories ... posted a 6-2 record in EIWA duals ... has totaled three pins, three technical falls and five major decisions on the year ... opened the season with a runner-up showing at the Binghamton Open and followed up by winning his weight at the Navy Classic ... upset then-ranked No. 9 Tyler McCormick in a dual meet at Missouri ... was named the Damon's Bison Athlete of the Week following that performance ... also earned the award for his runner-up showing at the EIWA Championships.

2006-07: Went 1-2 at the NCAA Championships, posting a 14-7 win over Tyler Dillashaw of Fullerton ... earned a spot in the NCAA Championships as a wild card selection after taking sixth at 133 lbs. at the EIWA Championships ... went 16-6 in duals overall and 6-1 in EIWA dual-meet competition during his freshman campaign, earning a No. 4 seed at the EIWA Tournament ... went 24-13 overall ... posted seven duals victories for bonus points ... placed fifth at the Navy Classic and first at the Shorty Hitchcock Open ... notched 10 straight duals wins after beginning the season with a 6-6 duals record ... named Damon's Bison Athlete of the Week on Feb. 12 after posting an 8-6 come-from-behind victory over nationally-ranked No. 10 Joe Baker in Bucknell's dual-meet at Navy ... in the EIWA Tournament, he defeated fifth-seeded Baker once more, 7-5 in overtime, to advance to the semifinals.

Before Bucknell: Lettered in wrestling, cross country, track and baseball at Harpursville Central High School ... won state championship ... served as team captain under head coach Josh Quick ... earned team MVP honors four times ... received scholar athlete recognition ... was a cross country captain and a three-time all-division honoree.

2006-07: Went 1-2 at the NCAA Championships, notching a 12-4 major decision over Brian Perry of Stanford ... took third at 165 lbs. as the No. 4 seed at the EIWA Championships to automatically qualify for the NCAA Championships ... claimed a spot in the *InterMat/NWCA/NWMA* Division I Individual Rankings every week during the season, peaking at No. 15 in the pre-NCAA poll (Mar. 7) ... set program record for dual-meet victories in a season after going 19-2 in duals (6-1 EIWA) during his freshman campaign ... led the squad with an overall record of 27-6 ... totaled seven dual-meet wins for bonus points ... placed first at the Navy Classic and was third at the Shorty Hitchcock Open ... was named Damon's Bison Athlete of the Week following his first-place showing at the Navy Classic ... upset nationally-ranked fifth-year senior Jason Kiessling of Maryland in his first match as a Bison ... broke Bucknell's dual-meet wins record of 16 with 7-3 overtime victory over Justin Jacobs at Navy on Feb. 10 ... posted 14 straight duals wins before suffering a setback at Harvard in his final bout of the regular season.

High School: Four-year letterwinner in wrestling under coach Rich Esposito at Brockway Area High School ... four-time district champion, four-time regional finalist and two-time state qualifier ... qualified for state tournament all four years and placed at states three times, winning PIAA state championships twice ... represented Pennsylvania in the prestigious Dapper Dan Classic.

2007-08: Earned his first trip to the NCAA Championships as a wild card after placing fifth at the EIWA Tournament as the No. 6 seed ... upset No. 3-seed Justin Herbert of Franklin & Marshall, 8-4 to advance to the semifinals ... dropped his next two bouts by a combined total of just four points (2-0 versus No. 2-seed Matt Stolpinski of Navy and 3-1 versus No. 4 Alex Caruso of Lehigh) before posting another win over Herbert, 7-2, to take fifth ... is currently 25-9 overall with four of his nine losses coming in the first two weekends of the season at the Binghamton Open and at the Navy Classic where he finished fourth ... also posted a place-winning performance at the Cleveland State Open, taking third ... went 15-2 in duals, with his only two losses coming against then-ranked No. 4 Steve Luke of Michigan and No. 10 Steve Anceravage of Cornell ... setback against Anceravage snapped a 14-match dual meet winning streak ... was named the Damon's Bison Athlete of the Week after picking up his 14th victory in that stretch, clinching the squad's dual meet win over American by pinning Jonathon Powell in 1:47 ... held opponents scoreless in nine of his victories and went 11 straight bouts without surrendering a takedown.

2006-07: Started for the Bison at 174 ... went 12-7 in duals (4-3 EIWA) and 17-11 overall ... totaled three pins and three major decisions ... took fifth at the Navy Classic and third at the exhibition Shorty Hitchcock Open ... after starting the season 1-4 in duals, went 11-3 the rest of the way, including a key 8-4 win over Fred Rowsey in Bucknell's 21-21 tie with Harvard ... won two matches at the EIWA Championships, upsetting No. 8 seed Mike Whalen of Rutgers, 8-1, and defeating Bran Crudden of Brown, 6-1.

Before Bucknell: Lettered in wrestling at Watchung Hills High School ... served as team captain ... placed eighth at Senior Nationals and was named a Senior National All-American.
