Jessica Smith scored a game-high 27 points to lead Stony Brook to an 81-72 win over Bucknell in the 2005-06 season-opener for both teams. Lindsey Hollough scored a team-high 14 points to pace Bucknell, which had three players tally double figures. She also grabbed a team-high 11 rebounds to record her fourth career double-double. The game was a close one with the Seawolves' largest lead of the second half (10) coming in the final minutes of the contest, which was played by a combined 52 fouls. The Bison saw two players foul out, and had two others with four fouls, while to Stony Brook players finished the game with four fouls. Bucknell ended the first half with a 10-4 run over the final two minutes. Keshia Champion scored four of her eight points, while Schober and Amanda Brown each hit 3-pointers in the final minute. The Seawolves' lead grew to as many as eight points early in the half, but the Bison drew to within three points on two occasions at 57-54 and 59-56.

Iona used a 29-11 run over the game's final 10 minutes to defeat Bucknell. Keshia Champion, Lindsey Hollough and Lauren Schober led the Bison with 12 points apiece. The game remained close as neither team built a lead larger than seven points in the first 30 minutes of play, but a key 10-0 run, highlighted by nine points in less than a minute from Joanne Smith and Toni Horvath, gave the Gaels a 56-47 advantage and Bucknell never drew closer than seven points after that. The 17-point final margin was the largest of the contest for Iona. In the opening minutes of the second half Bucknell could not stretch its lead out past six despite Hope Foster's first basket of the game and 3-pointers by Hollough and Sprouse. Iona took its first lead since the first half on a 3-pointer from Melissa Yeagley with 15:35 to play to give the Gaels a 42-41 advantage. The Bison would lead just one more time (47-46) after a pair of free throws from Schober, before Iona went on its decisive 10-0 run.

Keshia Champion connected on a pair of free throws with 35 seconds remaining to give Bucknell the lead for good as the Bison picked up their first win of the season, 54-48, over Coppin State. Champion, who scored seven points and was 5 of 5 from the free throw line, also canned a pair of free throws with 4:38 remaining to give Bucknell a 46-44 lead and break the fifth tie of the game. With 1:04 left to play a free throw by Whitney Cunningham knotted the game again at 48-48 but Champion was sent to the line to shoot two and connected on both to give the Bison a 50-48 advantage. Shalamar Oakley couldn't connect on a layup to tie the game but the rebound was dominated by Bucknell's Ashton Sprouse. The resulting traveling violation by Sprouse gave the Eagles the chance to tie on an inbounds play with 18 seconds left. A stingy Bison defense forced a five-second call and Amanda Brown connected on a pair of free throws to secure the game for Bucknell. Lindsey Hollough, who posted a game-high 21 points, added two free throws in the final seconds to give the Bison their final six-point spread.

Hope Foster had a career performance with 24 points, 18 rebounds and seven blocks, helping Bucknell to a 71-60 victory over High Point in the Air Force Classic consolation game. Foster led Bucknell in points, rebounds and blocks. Her seven blocks matched a program single-game record. Foster also set new career highs in points and rebounds, shot 8-15 from the field and was 8-10 at the free throw line. Amanda Brown, Corrine Keller and Jacquie Seawright all reached new career highs in points as well. Brown totaled 13 points and five assists while Seawright tallied nine points, both coming off the bench for the Bison. Keller had 12 points, six rebounds and two steals in her first collegiate start. With 13:05 left in the first half, Keshia Champion netted a free throw to begin a 27-8 Bucknell run that closed out the period and gave the Bison a 40-24 advantage at halftime. Bucknell's defense held High Point to just three field goals in the final 13 minutes of the first half. Champion stretched the Bison lead to 20 to start the second half. However, the Panthers were able to chip away at the deficit and came within two with a layup by Raven Truslow with four minutes remaining in regulation. That would be as close as High Point would come as Bucknell responded by outscoring the Panthers 15-6 in the final four minutes.

Amanda Brown scored a career-high 20 points to lead four Bucknell players in double figures as the Bison held off Maryland Eastern Shore for a thrilling 93-92 triple overtime victory. In the first triple overtime game in the 33-year history of the Bucknell program, the Bison held leads late in regulation and in the closing moments of the first two overtime periods, but the Hawks tied the score each time. The Bison scored the first three points of the final overtime on two free throws by Keshia Champion and one by Latham as DeVaughn Hailey was whistled for a personal foul and a technical foul. However, another 3-pointer by Toni Kennedy and a jumper by Cheatham gave UMES an 84-82 advantage to equal its largest in overtime to that point. The Hawks tied lead 89-85 before two free throws and a jumper by Champion tied the score at 89-89 with just over a minute to play to start an 8-0 run that gave the Bison a 93-89 lead. After a steal of an in-bounds pass by Brown, Jacquie Seawright drove to the basket and a controversial blocking foul was whistled on Tiffany Reid. Bucknell committed 20 turnovers, including 12 in the first half, while Delaware State turned the ball over a season-low seven times, as the Bison had their four-game winning streak snapped with a 60-42 loss to the Hornets. 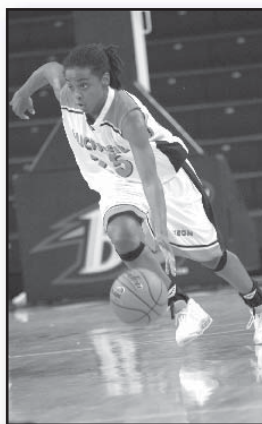

Lindsey Hollobaugh, who passed the 1,000-point mark in her career in the first half, scored 14 of her team-high 16 points in the second half as Bucknell held off Lehigh for its sixth consecutive road victory, 58-45. 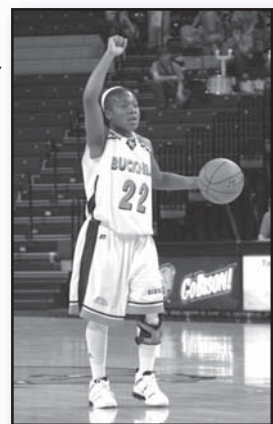

Bucknell forced a season-high 30 turnovers, including 18 in the first half, as it won its program record-tying seventh straight game, 73-38 over American. Five players netted double figures for the Bison, who were led by 13 points each from Hope Foster, Amanda Brown and Jacquie Seawright. American took its second, and final, lead of the game at 8-7 just over five minutes into the first half, but Bucknell ended the half on a 21-5 run and limited the Eagles to just two field goals over the final 14:45 of the first half. Foster scored seven consecutive points at one stretch during the run and tallied nine points and eight rebounds in the first half. The Bison opened up the second half with an 18-6 run capped by Lauren Schober's second 3-pointer in a two-minute span. Bucknell was able to extend the lead out to as many as 36 points following a pair of free throws from Seawright with 2:27 to play. Seawright scored 11 of her points in the second half, while Corrine Keller contributed eight of her 12 in the second half with an array of jump shots. She fell one point shy of her career high. The 38-point Bucknell yielded was the lowest since giving up 37 to Army in the 1992-93 season. It was just the fifth time since the 1980-81 campaign a team failed to score 40 points against the Bison, who held American to an average of just 40.5 points per game in two meetings this year.
