SITE: Bucknell West Fields (**Graham Field**)

PARKING: Bus parking is available near the Hockey Field at West Fields. Additional parking is available at the Football Stadium. Bus parking, during the event, will be available on the access road, on the right, next to the entrance road (Bucknell West Rd.) to the "mods." Parking is **NOT** allowed in the St. Andrew's Episcopal Church parking lot, on the corner of Curtain Avenue and Rt. 15, for any events at West Fields.

LOCKER ROOM: New locker rooms are available to visiting teams. A sports medicine facility on grounds is also available. **Visiting teams are responsible for their own towels.**

TRAINING ROOM: The Training Room and treatment area is located in the gym annex. Treatments will be limited to athletes accompanied by a trainer or with a written prescription from an athletic trainer or team physician. Athletes requesting to be taped must bring sufficient supplies. Please call ahead to make arrangements if an athletic trainer or student trainer is not traveling with your team. Ice and water will be available at the competition site.

UNIFORMS: Bucknell will wear white or light colored uniforms and the visiting team will wear dark uniforms.

PRE-GAME WARM-UP:

Visiting teams may warm-up on the upper half of the game field. Your assigned bench area will be the far bench, past the video tower. Team introductions and the National Anthem will take place 5 minutes before the scheduled starting time to allow the game to start as scheduled.

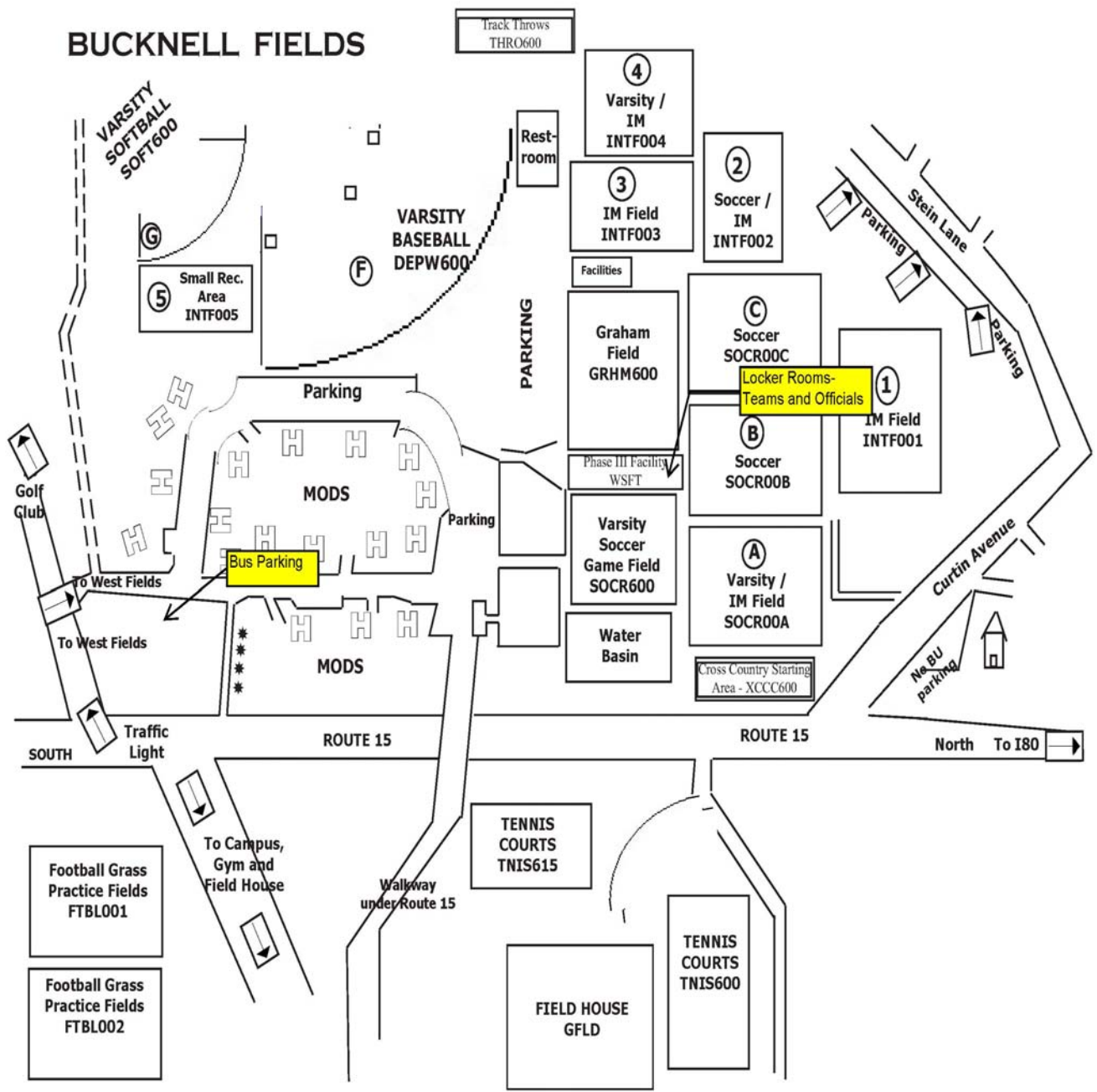
