Bucknell (12-13, 1-3 CWPA Southern) vs. No. 16 Princeton (15-7, 4-0 CWPA Southern) Lewisburg, Pa. • April 13, 2007

After playing just two games since March 17, Bucknell is anxious to get back in the pool as it hosts No. 16 Princeton and George Washington at Kinney Natatorium this weekend. The Bison will try to defeat the Tigers for the first time in program history Friday night in a game that will be broadcast on WVBU 90.5 in Lewisburg and on the internet through SportsJuice.com. Princeton has won all 21 meetings in the series, although the last five meetings have been decided by just nine total points, including a one-point overtime affair at last year's Eastern Championship. Bucknell enters the league contest having snapped a four-game losing streak its last time out two weeks ago at George Washington. With two victories this weekend Bucknell will enter the postseason with a record above .500 as it tries to win more games than it loses for the third consecutive season for the first time in program history. Friday's game with Princeton will mark the 500th in the career of Bison head coach John Zeigler, who is 250-249 as the mentor of both the Bucknell men's and water polo programs. He is 136-114 at the head of the women's program.

With a Win over Princeton, Bucknell Would...

- ...defeat the Tigers for the first time in the nine-year history of the program
- ...even its record at .500 for the first time since March 17
- ...clinch third place in the four-team CWPA Southern Division
- ...improve to 5-0 at Kinney Natatorium this season

Bucknell at Kinney Natatorium

Bucknell has won all four games it has played in Kinney Natatorium this season and is 24-10 (.706) all-time in the five-year-old facility. The Bison are 8-2 over the last two years in Kinney Natatorium and four of their 10 all-time losses at Kinney have come to Princeton.

Bucknell vs. Ranked Teams

As always, Bucknell has played an impressive schedule this season, facing nine ranked opponents. The Bison have gone 0-9 against those ranked foes, but have defeated Redlands, the top-ranked team in Division III, twice. Bucknell has faced at least eight ranked opponents in four of the last five seasons. In fact, Friday's game with Princeton will mark the first time in program history the Bison have battled 10 ranked teams in one season.

Balanced Classes

Bucknell's offensive attack is very balanced with each class represented among the Bison's top-four scorers. Junior Meagan Gins tops the Bucknell scoring list, while senior Elizabeth Jensen is second. Freshman Valentina Rozas and sophomore Aubrey Rowe round out the quartet that has combined for 153 goals and 229 points.

Record-Breaking Gins

For the second consecutive season junior Meagan Gins is Bucknell's leader in goals. Her total of 70 last season broke Meg Blitzer's standard and she is tied with Brooke Rea for 10th on the single-season list with 53 this year. She now has 171 goals in her three-year career, just 27 shy of Blitzer's record. In addition to her goal totals, Gins is fifth on the career points list with 235 and owns the program's single-season record with 103 last spring.

Jensen Continues to Pile up Points

After scoring just 35 goals her first two seasons it would seem to be a longshot for senior Elizabeth Jensen to be among the best point scorers in Bucknell history, but she stands poised to finish her career among the top three in points. She has totaled 87 goals the last two seasons, and has 67 assists, including a team-high 21 this year, over that span to give her 241 points in her career. That figure is fourth in program history, but just 16 shy of second place.

Saves for Bynum

Senior goalkeeper Mandy Bynum made nine saves last month against Cal State Bakersfield to break Bucknell's career saves record of 892 that was held by Lindsay Chesterfield since 2003. Bynum has since pushed her total to 914 and is just 28 stops short of her fourth consecutive 200-save season. Bynum already owns three of the top six single-season save totals in program history. She has five games with double-figure saves this season and is averaging 10 per game over her last three contests.

About Princeton

Princeton, which is ranked 16th in the nation, has won five of its last six games entering this weekend. The Tigers are on top of the league standings with an unblemished 4-0 mark and are led on the offensive end by Elyse Colgan, who has tallied 61 goals.

Up Next

Bucknell will host George Washington Saturday at 5 p.m. to close out the regular season. A win in either game this weekend clinches the third seed at next Saturday's Southern Championship, which will be played at Maryland.
