Postgame Notes | Wednesday, March 10, 2010



(6) Southern Miss 57, (11) Tulane 47

General Notes

- Southern Miss improved to 9-7 in the Conference USA Tournament.
- Tulane dropped to 7-15 in the C-USA Tournament.
- This was the 71st meeting between the two teams and Tulane holds a 40-31 advantage. However, this was the first time the two charter members of C-USA have met in the 15-year history of the C-USA Tournament.

Southern Miss Notes

- Southern Miss bumped its record to 19-12 and will square-off with UAB tomorrow at 2:30 p.m., on CBS C.
- This is the fifth-consecutive year the Golden Eagles have opened the C-USA Tournament with a win.
- Southern Miss outrebounded the Tulane 50-38. The 50 boards are the most rebounds a USM team has grabbed in the C-USA Tournament (45 vs. Houston – March 8, 2007).
- **Gary Flowers** threw in 17 points and pulled down 14 rebounds for his ninth double-double of the season. His 14 boards mark a career high for the junior.
- Southern Miss did not allow a Tulane player to score in double figures.
- This is the first time this season USM went without making a three-point field goal (0-7).

Tulane Notes

- Tulane finished the season 2009-10 season with an 8-22 record.
- This is the first time in five years that Tulane did not win its first game in the C-USA Tournament under head coach **Dave Dickerson**.
- The Green Wave held Southern Miss to 32.8 percent shooting (19-for-58) and 0-7 from behind the three-point line.
- **Asim McQueen** matched his season high for blocked shots with three.
