PLAYER OF THE WEEK

GLORIA BROWN, UTEP

6-2, SR., F / PHILADELPHIA, PA / TRINITY VALLEY CC

Brown averaged 12.5 points, 11 rebounds, 5.0 blocks and 2.5 steals in 23.5 minutes as UTEP opened the 2012 C-USA schedule with wins over SMU and Memphis. She also shot 50.0 percent from the field (9-of-18) and hit all seven attempted free throws. Brown opened up the week with her third-straight double-double of 17 points and 11 rebounds while also blocking four shots and pocketing four steals in 20 minutes of action against the Mustangs. She hit 7-of-11 from the floor and made all three of her free throws. She followed that up with a strong defensive performance against Memphis, grabbing 11 boards while swatting six shots. Brown also chipped in eight points on offense, which was aided by a perfect 4-of-4 showing at the charity stripe. This is Brown's first Player of the Week honor this season and third for her career.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

DANIELLE BLAGG, TULANE

5-11, F / SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS / SMITHSON VALLEY HS

Blagg averaged 13.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals, 1.0 assist and 1.0 block per game in 23.5 minutes per contest off the bench during the Green Wave's 1-1 week. She connected on 40.9 percent of her shots from the field (9-of-22), including a 33.3 showing from beyond the 3-point arc (4-of-12). In Tulane's hard-fought 61-59 loss at Preseason C-USA favorite Memphis on Thursday, Blagg had a team-leading 19 points on 7-of-15 shooting (.467), including a 4-of-9 showing from 3-point land. Blagg also added five rebounds, two assists, a pair of steals and a block in 28 minutes of work against the Tigers. She added seven points, a block and a steal in the Green Wave's 64-52 win over the Knights on Sunday. Blagg has been named Freshman of the Week three times this season and Tulane has collected six Freshman of the Week accolades this year.

OTHER WOMEN'S BASKETBALL STANDOUT PERFORMANCES

✦ Senior G **AISHA PATRICK** averaged a double-double for the week with 18 points and 10.5 rebounds. She posted the best single-game scoring performance of any Knight this year, tallying a career-high 28 points in UCF's win over East Carolina. She also grabbed 11 rebounds for her fifth double-double of the year and 13th of her career. Patrick sank a season-best 12 free throws, which ranks second among all C-USA players this season. Against Tulane, she fell two points shy of a double-double with a game-high 10 rebounds.

✦ Senior G **LATEIDRA ELLIOTT** was the leading scorer in the two opening Conference USA games for Marshall. She averaged 12.5 ppg off the bench after scoring 11 points against Houston and 14 against Tulsa last week. She showcased why she's the top 3-point shooter in C-USA, finishing the week with a combined 4-for-6 (.667) from behind the arc. She also tops the league with an overall 3-point accuracy of .484 (15-of-31).

✦ Junior G **TYRIA SNOW** averaged 12.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 0.5 blocks and 0.5 steals per game during the Green Wave's 1-1 week. She posted a then-career high 11 points in Thursday's narrow 61-59 loss at preseason C-USA favorite Memphis. She scored 13 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the field (.625) while hitting 3-of-4 free throws (.750) against UCF Sunday.

✦ Sophomore F **KARISMA CHAPMAN** was the high scorer in both UAB wins last week. She scored 20 against Rice and tallied 11 points at East Carolina. Chapman averaged 15.5 ppg over the two contests. The Calumet City, Ill., product hit 44 percent of her shots for the week.

✦ Senior G **ROXANA BUTTON** averaged 19.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals while shooting 50 percent (6-of-12) from 3-point range as Houston opened C-USA action 1-1. Button has scored in double figures in all 14 games this season and has averaged 19.4 points with eight 20-point performances after entering the season with only one game of 20-points-or-more.

✦ UCF freshman **ANDREA HINES** averaged 5.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game and continued to command the starting point guard position for UCF. In UCF's win over ECU, Hines grabbed a career-high eight rebounds. Since Hines has been

inserted into the starting lineup on Dec. 18, she ranks third on the team in scoring (7.4 ppg) and fourth for rebounding (5.2 rpg).

✦ Freshman PG **JENZEL NASH** was instrumental in UTEP's 2-0 start to league action. After playing just one minute against SMU and then being on the bench for most of the first half as UTEP fell behind by 19 points to Memphis, she was a difference maker in the rally. Nash scored the first five points and nine total during a 17-0 run to open the second half and get UTEP back in the game. She hit 7-of-11 (.636) from the floor and was 7-of-9 (.778) at the charity stripe.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE PRODUCERS

Rice sophomore F **JESSICA KUSTER** and Tulane senior C **BRETT BENZIO** cracked C-USA's all-time double-doubles chart. Kuster, C-USA's only player averaging a double-double (17.8ppg/12.4rpg), owns 22 career DD to rank 14th on the all-time list, while Benzio sports 20 for 17th.

QUALITY COACHES

Conference USA has five head coaches that sport 250-plus career wins. Headlining the list is Marshall's **ROYCE CHADWICK**. He's in his 27th season as a coach and owns an all-time record of 557-290. Tulane's **LISA STOCKTON** follows with 423 career victories. She's been a head coach 21 seasons along with **RHONDA ROMPOLA** of SMU and Southern Miss' **JOYE LEE-MCNELIS**.

WE ARE C-USA

Conference USA was formed in 1995 and quickly emerged as one of the nation's top conferences. The conference unveiled its name, logo and commissioner on April 24, 1995 in Chicago. The league's charter members included Charlotte, Cincinnati, DePaul, Houston, Louisville, Marquette, Memphis, Saint Louis, Southern Miss, Tulane, UAB and USF. Eleven of the institutions began athletic participation in 1995, while Houston joined competition in the fall of 1996.

The league's headquarters were established in Chicago and after nine years, relocated to the current office in Irving, Texas. Britton Banowsky was named Commissioner in October 2002, succeeding Mike Slive, the league's first commissioner.

C-USA added East Carolina (September, 1996) and the United States Military Academy (March, 1997) as football members. ECU began league competition in 1997; Army in 1998 and UAB began football play in 1999. The league added TCU and ECU (1999) for all sports and they began competition in 2001. USF started C-USA football in 2003.

After celebrating its 10th Anniversary during the 2004-05 season, C-USA began a new chapter in 2005-06 when its current membership came together to form the new look of the league.

Since its formation, C-USA has established a strong foundation, an identity and a history that reflects the league's national presence. Eleven years of remarkable history has reinforced the league's position in collegiate athletics, setting the course for the next decade and beyond.
