### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**JASMINE LEE, MEMPHIS**

**6-2, RS SR., P / BESSEMER, ALA. / JESS LANIER HS / GEORGIA**

Lee posted her third consecutive double-double and recorded back-to-back 20-point games while helping Memphis pick up its fourth and fifth straight victory. Lee, who shot 65.4 percent from the field in the two C-USA wins, averaged a double-double last week of 20.5 points, 13.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game in wins over Marshall and at East Carolina. Lee has now posted a league-best 10 double-doubles on the season and is averaging 17.6 points and 10.4 rebounds per game in conference play. She now owns four 20-point games in the first seven league matchups. This is Lee's second C-USA Player of the Week honor this season and third for her career. She was also honored by College Sports Madness as its C-USA Player of the Week.



### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

**TERRAN ALFORD, HOUSTON**

**6-1, F / OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLA. / HOME SCHOOLED**

Alford posted 10 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks while going a perfect 5-of-5 from the field in Houston's narrow loss to Rice on Saturday. Alford played a pivotal role in Houston's breakout defensive effort where the Cougars held Rice to just 23 percent shooting from the field. The Oklahoma City, Okla., native held Rice's Jessica Kuster to just a 4-of-14 effort from the field and limited the league's second-leading scorer to just four points and three rebounds in the first half. Alford was part of Houston's post presence that outscored the Owls by a 24-8 margin in the paint. This is her first Freshman of the Week accolade.

## OTHER STANDOUT PERFORMANCES

✦ UTEP's **GLORIA BROWN** averaged 16.0 points and 13.0 rebounds per game as the Miners defeated Southern Miss and UCF last week. Brown also shot 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from the field and 89.5 percent (17-of-19) from the charity stripe. At Southern Miss, Brown scored a career-high 27 points, aided by making a school-record 17 free throws, while grabbing the second-most rebounds (19) in program history. She compiled five points, six blocks and seven rebounds in only 17 minutes of action against UCF.

✦ **KARISMA CHAPMAN** ended the weekend with 18.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game averages as UAB defeated Tulsa and rival Southern Miss. The sophomore forward scored a career-high 25 points Sunday to help the Blazers overcome a 19-point first-half deficit for a 65-59 win over the Golden Eagles, completing the comeback with UAB's go-ahead basket at the 3:00 mark to give the Blazers the lead for good. Chapman shot 13-of-28 (.464) from the floor and 10-of-13 (.769) from the free throw line for the week.

✦ Rice sophomore **JESSICA KUSTER** led the Owls in scoring and rebounding in two wins last week by averaging a double-double at 20 ppg and 11.5 rpg... She also had a team-high four blocks and team-high six steals... In the win over East Carolina, Kuster posted a game-high 21 points with seven rebounds and made eight of 13 shots from the field... In a physical game at Houston, Kuster registered her team and C-USA-leading ninth double-double of the season with game-highs of 19 points and 16 rebounds.

✦ **NITESHA PIERCE** finished the week averaging 14.0 points and 4.5 rebounds while connecting on 70.6 (12-17) percent from the field for Southern Miss. She scored eight points against UTEP on 4-of-5 shooting. Pierce followed with a team-high 20 points at UAB on 8-of-12 shooting from the floor including hitting her only three-point attempt as the shot clock expired.

## CARTER NAMED FINALIST FOR LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Senior guard **BRITTANY CARTER** was named one of 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The finalists were chosen by a media committee from the list of candidates announced in November.

The Covington, Ga., native is working on a second bachelor's degree, after receiving her first degree in May of last year in criminal justice. A member of the Tiger 3.0 Club following the fall semester, Carter is a two-time C-USA player of the week already this season.

✦ After a pair of victories Thursday night, **GREG WILLIAMS** of Rice and UTEP's **KEITHA ADAM** are now members of the 300 win club. The Owls defeated East Carolina, 66-44, while the Miners slipped by Southern Miss, 70-63. Williams also collected his 100th victory at his alma mater with a 58-50 win over city rival Houston Sunday.

✦ Junior G **AMBER JONES** surpassed the 1,000-point mark for her career Thursday night as UAB defeated Tulsa, 47-40, at the Reynolds Center. Jones entered the night with 997 career points and scored five of UAB's first seven to become the 25th 1,000-point scorer in program history. She finished the game with 11 points and became just the 13th Blazer to reach 1,000 before her senior season.

✦ Junior G **TALEYA MAYBERRY** is getting closer to joining the 1,000-point career club. She has 983 career points, moving into eight place on the school's all-time scoring chart. The Tulsa native needs just 17 more to become the eighth player in program history to achieve this milestone.

## WE ARE C-USA

Conference USA was formed in 1995 and quickly emerged as one of the nation's top conferences. The conference unveiled its name, logo and commissioner on April 24, 1995 in Chicago. The league's charter members included Charlotte, Cincinnati, DePaul, Houston, Louisville, Marquette, Memphis, Saint Louis, Southern Miss, Tulane, UAB and USF. Eleven of the institutions began athletic participation in 1995, while Houston joined competition in the fall of 1996.

The league's headquarters were established in Chicago and after nine years, relocated to the current office in Irving, Texas. Britton Banowsky was named Commissioner in October 2002, succeeding Mike Slive, the league's first commissioner.

C-USA added East Carolina (September, 1996) and the United States Military Academy (March, 1997) as football members. ECU began league competition in 1997; Army in 1998 and UAB began football play in 1999. The league added TCU and ECU (1999) for all sports and they began competition in 2001. USF started C-USA football in 2003.

After celebrating its 10th Anniversary during the 2004-05 season, C-USA began a new chapter in 2005-06 when its current membership came together to form the new look of the league.

Since its formation, C-USA has established a strong foundation, an identity and a history that reflects the league's national presence. Eleven years of remarkable history has reinforced the league's position in collegiate athletics, setting the course for the next decade and beyond.
