Faulkner led Southern Miss to a 74-67 road victory over SMU in the team's only game of the week. She scored a career-high 28 points on 10-of-12 shooting from the field (.833), including 2-of-3 from the behind the arc. The nation's third best distributor of the ball also dished out six assists and came up with six steals. Faulkner converted 6-of-8 from the free throw line, including a one-and-one that ended a 6-0 run by the Mustangs. She scored 19 first half points, including 12 of the final 17 before the half. The sophomore point guard picks up her first career Player of the Week honor after being named C-USA Freshman of the Week three times last season.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK NAKACHI MADUKA, RICE 5-11, F / ARLINGTON, TEXAS / MARTIN HS

Maduka registered her first career double-double with career highs of 13 points and 10 rebounds in the team's 55-48 win over Tulsa. She was 5-9 from the field, which included a 3-pointer, and had a team-high four steals. This is Maduka's first Freshman of the Week honor.

OTHER STANDOUT PERFORMANCES

✦ Senior P **JASMINE LEE** averaged a double-double of 11.5 points and 14.5 rebounds in a pair of wins this week for Memphis, including a come-from-behind road victory at SMU. In the next game, she grabbed a career-high 17 rebounds in limited minutes against Houston. Lee also added three assists, three blocks and three steals in the two wins.

✦ Junior G **OLIVIA GRAYSON** averaged 13.5 points, 6.0 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game during Tulane's 1-1 week in road play. She also hit 34.3 percent (12-of-35) of her shot for from the field. Grayson scored 10 points, handed out six assists, pulled down four rebounds and posted a pair of steals at Houston in just 23 minutes of play. In Sunday's game against league-leading UTEP, she netted 17 points, handed out six assists, pulled down four rebounds and posted three steals in a coast-to-coast, 40-minute effort against the Miners.

✦ Junior G **AMBER JONES** led UAB offensively last week with an average of 15.5 points over the team's two games. Jones connected on 10-of-24 (.417) shots from the floor and had six rebounds and three assists over the two games. She scored 16 against East Carolina, followed by 15 points at UCF.

✦ Senior G **AISHA PATRICK** recorded a double-double and committed zero turnovers while playing all 40 minutes to lead UCF to a 41-39 victory over UAB. Patrick paced the Knights with 12 points and 10 rebounds for her 15th career double-double, which ranks her among the top-5 double-double leaders in school history. Patrick led the charge in UCF's defensive effort that limited UAB to a season-low 39 points as well as a 14.8 shooting percentage in the second half. Patrick converted UCF's go-ahead points off free throws in the final minutes to seal the win.

✦ Rice senior F **BRIANNA HYPOLITE** scored a game-high 19 points and had eight rebounds in 35 minutes against Tulsa Sunday.

✦ East Carolina sophomore F **KRISTINE MIAL** averaged 16 points and five rebounds per game over the week while racking up five steals and two blocks. She netted double figures offensively in each contest, including 19 points against Marshall to lead ECU to its first C-USA win of the season as well as snap a 14-game losing streak.

Senior G **ROXANA BUTTON** earned Capital One Academic All-District VII first team honors and is now placed on the national ballot for Academic

All-America accolades. Button graduated in December with a 3.88 GPA in psychology and a minor in chemistry and plans to attend medical school next season.

UTEP ITCHING CLOSER TO TOP 25

UTEP moved up to 28th after garnering 22 votes in the most-recent ESPN/USA Today Coaches' top-25 poll. The Miners also appear at No. 31 in the Associated Press Poll after receiving 17 votes.

It marks the fourth straight week that the Miners (22-2, 11-0 Conference USA) have received votes in both major polls.

UTEP extended its overall win streak to 12 after defeating Marshall, 64-56, and Tulane, 80-65, last week while also remaining atop the Conference USA standings. The Miners (22-2, 11-0 C-USA) have won 12 games in a row, the third-longest streak in program history, including 11-straight to christen Conference USA play. UTEP stands 4-1 on the year vs. teams in the top-100 of the RPI, having swept the season series vs. Tulane (45) while also defeating Idaho State (64) & Memphis (94).

The Miners lead C-USA in six major team stat categories while checking in second in four others. They stand 11-0 in league play, but Memphis (9-2) and UAB (8-3) are both within striking distance with still five games remaining on the docket.

CARTER FINALIST FOR LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Senior G **BRITTANY CARTER** is one of 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The Covington, Ga., native is working on a second bachelor's degree, after receiving her first degree in May of last year in criminal justice. The Lowe's Senior CLASS Award honors senior student-athletes for their accomplishments in four areas: community, classroom, character and competition. The award is designed exclusively for college seniors who are utilizing their complete athletic eligibility.

WE ARE C-USA

Conference USA was formed in 1995 and quickly emerged as one of the nation's top conferences. The conference unveiled its name, logo and commissioner on April 24, 1995 in Chicago. The league's charter members included Charlotte, Cincinnati, DePaul, Houston, Louisville, Marquette, Memphis, Saint Louis, Southern Miss, Tulane, UAB and USF. Eleven of the institutions began athletic participation in 1995, while Houston joined competition in the fall of 1996.

The league's headquarters were established in Chicago and after nine years, relocated to the current office in Irving, Texas. Britton Banowsky was named Commissioner in October 2002, succeeding Mike Slive, the league's first commissioner.

C-USA added East Carolina (September, 1996) and the United States Military Academy (March, 1997) as football members. ECU began league competition in 1997; Army in 1998 and UAB began football play in 1999. The league added TCU and ECU (1999) for all sports and they began competition in 2001. USF started C-USA football in 2003.

After celebrating its 10th Anniversary during the 2004-05 season, C-USA began a new chapter in 2005-06 when its current membership came together to form the new look of the league.

Since its formation, C-USA has established a strong foundation, an identity and a history that reflects the league's national presence. Eleven years of remarkable history has reinforced the league's position in collegiate athletics, setting the course for the next decade and beyond.

TEAM NOTES: East Carolina broke through for its first Conference USA win of the season and snapped a 14-game skid along the way with a 61-57 victory against Marshall Sunday at Minges Coliseum in front of a 3,258, the fifth-largest in program history. For the second consecutive game, sophomore F Kristine Mial paced the Pirates offensively as she scored a season-high 19 points to go along with seven rebounds and two blocks. Additionally, with two made three-point field goals, Mial extended her streak to 11-games with a made three.
