HITTER OF THE WEEK

Lacey Middlebrooks, Tulsa, Jr., Wake Village, Texas

Middlebrooks hit .471 (8-for-17) with 10 RBI, a .529 slugging percentage and a .444 on-base percentage, and picked up a win in the circle, to lead Tulsa to a 4-1 record at the FAU "Strike Out Cancer" Tournament. She tallied 10 of the team's 34 RBI in the five games over the weekend. In two games Friday, Middlebrooks went 4-for-6 at the plate, totaling five RBI, and earned a win in the circle for Tulsa. She was 2-for-3 with a double and two RBI in the first game, a 9-0 win over Loyola Marymount. She then went 2-for-3, driving in three of the four runs and allowed just one run and four hits with six strikeouts to earn the complete-game, 4-1, win over the Panthers. Middlebrooks was 2-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored in the 11-6 extra-inning win over Florida A&M, and then drove in two runs, going 1-for-3, in the 6-5 win at FAU on Saturday. She drove in two runs and was 1-for-3 at the plate Sunday against Michigan State. The award is Middlebrooks' first Hitter of the Week honor for her career.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Schmidt, a senior from Cordova, Md., won both of her starts last weekend against Seton Hall and Eastern Michigan. She struck out a career-high 12 against EMU while allowing a career-low zero walks. Schmidt scattered nine hits, struck out 20 batters and walked just one and posted a 0.93 ERA over 15 innings of work. This is Schmidt's first Pitcher of the Week award of her career.

C-USA/TEAM NOTES

East Carolina: How May We Help You?

As a result of more balls in play, East Carolina's infielders are racking up assists at a much higher rate. Through the first 13 contests, the Pirates have registered 147 assists, the second-most in Conference USA, and an average of 11.3 helpers per contest. In all of 2011, ECU totaled 326 assists, or an average of 5.2 per tilt.

East Carolina: Playing the Ranked

The Pirates have played three games against ranked foes so far this season and dropped all three contests, falling to No. 21 Louisville 5-0 and No. 2 Alabama 4-2 and 9-4. The schedule won't get any easier next weekend, as East Carolina faces No. 3 California and No. 14 Stanford.

ECU's four runs against No. 2 Alabama on Saturday afternoon were the most the Pirates had scored against a ranked team since putting up four versus No. 18 Virginia Tech on April 29, 2008.

Houston: Sunday Rally

Houston took down UNLV and Nevada (2-1) during its final day of the Gaucho Classic hosted by UC-Santa Barbara. The Cougars righted the ship as they fell to their first three opponents during the opening two days of the tournament.

Marshall: Blazing Trails

Marshall continues to swipe bases at an amazing rate. On the season, Marshall is 47-for-55. That's a rate of 3.35 stolen bases per game and puts the green and white on pace for 140 on the season.

Marshall: Taking Second

With a stolen base in Sunday's game versus Maryland, junior Jessica Hughes moved into second in career stolen bases with 89. She moved past current assistant coach Amanda Williams.

Memphis: Finding Their Groove

After a rough start to the season, the Tigers pitching staff is finding its groove. In the first 13 games of the season, Memphis gave up 89 runs for an average of 6.8 runs per game. In the last three outings, the U of M has given up a total of three runs and averaged 1.0 runs per game.

Memphis: Hurling Hummel

It's no wonder the pitching staff is beginning to find its groove. Preseason All-Conference USA selection Carly Hummel's resurgence has coincided with Memphis' improved pitching. In Hummel's first five appearances she posted a 7.56 ERA in just 16.2 IP, compared to a sizzling 0.91 ERA over 15.1 IP in her last two outings.

Memphis: Roberts is Rolling

Similar to Hummel's resurgence, Ellen Roberts has seen a similar change. In the Aussie's first seven appearances, she posted an ERA of 6.33. In her last three outings for the U of M, Roberts has a 1.78 ERA and a blistering 24-to-1 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Southern Miss: Head West

Next up for Southern Miss is a trip to the west coast for the Cal State Fullerton Demarini Invitational. The team will take on California and Cal State Fullerton on Friday, March 2, Michigan State and Indiana on March 3 and Northwestern on March 4.

Tulsa: Homestanding

After posting a 4-1 mark at the FAU Strike Out Cancer Tournament, the Golden Hurricane plays host to the Hyatt Downtown Tulsa Tournament March 2-4 at the Donna J. Hardesty Sports Complex.

UAB: Lowman Starts

Senior catcher Mandy Lowman has made 156 consecutive starts dating back to March 24, 2009. In addition, she has appeared in all of UAB's 183 games throughout her collegiate career.

UCF: Taking One for the Team

Vanessa Perez was hit by three pitches last week and moved into the top spot on the UCF all-time list.

UTEP: Weekend Action

The Orange and Blue will return home to host the UTEP Invitational starting Friday, March 2 and concluding on Sunday, March 4. The tournament will take place at the Helen of Troy Softball Complex and include UTSA, Brown, Iowa State, and Valparaiso. UTEP will face UTSA in its first game of the tournament at noon on Friday.

DIAMOND STARS

HITTERS:

Alex Fieldhouse, East Carolina

Fieldhouse batted .350 during six games last week, drove in the game-winning run in two of East Carolina's three victories and scored the deciding run in the third triumph.

Reina Gaber, Houston

Gaber just missed out on a cycle against UNLV as she went 5-for-5 with three extra base hits and helped UH set school record for steals in a game with seven against UNLV.

Ashley Gue, Marshall

Gue was best at the plate for the Thundering Herd during the Citrus Classic. Her batting average (.500), hits (8), runs (5), and stolen bases (5), were all the best for her squad during this past weekend's action.

Breslin Perry, Memphis

Perry was named to the Blues City Classic All-Tournament team after hitting .400 in the five games (4-for-10). She delivered a walk-off, game-winning single in the bottom of the 10th inning to defeat Western Illinois, 8-7.

Vanessa Perez, UCF

Perez hit safely in all five of the Knights' games last week. She raised her batting average 102 points from .231 to .333, thanks to her big week.

PITCHERS:

Williamson completed the Citrus Classic, appearing in each game. She was the winning pitcher in Friday's win over St. John's.

Ellen Roberts, Memphis
