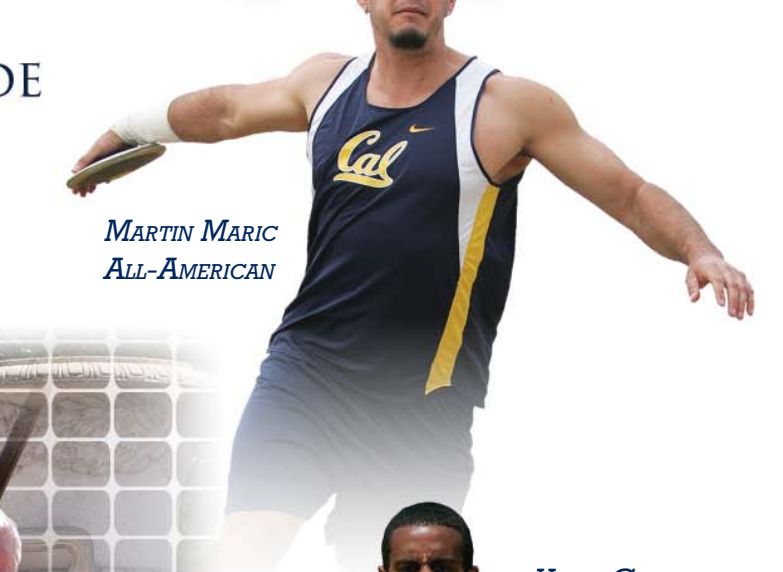

### Head Coach Tony Sandoval

**Tony Sandoval**, a familiar name in San Francisco Bay Area track and field circles, is in his 27th year of association with the California track and field program and his second as the Director of Track and Field, after serving numerous seasons as the associate director of track and field. Sandoval previously served 10 years as Cal's head women's coach prior to the merger of the men's and women's programs into a single entity.

### This Week

California returns to Eugene, Ore., this weekend for the NCAA West Regional from May 29-30. Events begin at 2:40 p.m. on Friday with the men's javelin and on Saturday at noon with the men's discus. The Cal men are currently ranked No. 15 in the USTFCCCA rankings and the Cal women are just outside of the top 25 at No. 27.

### Last Time Out: Bears Take Seventh at Pac-10 Championships

Both the Cal men and women took seventh place at the Pac-10 Championships on May 17 in Eugene, Ore. Highlighting the Golden Bears' performances were senior **Inika McPherson** winning the women's high jump title and junior **Kimyon Broom** capturing the 100-meter hurdles championship in a school-record time of 13.02, which also ranks fifth-best in the nation.

Senior **Jordan Paul** clocked a time of 13.66 in the 110-meter hurdles to place second and that time ranks fourth all-time in school history. The Bears got new regional qualifiers with senior **Kandi Bonty** (400), sophomore **Nick Porter** (100), senior **Sean Carey** (800) and sophomore **Michael Coe** (1500). Second-place finishers included sophomore **Cherrelle Garrett** (100), seniors **Jake Hanson** (400-meter hurdles) and **Martin Maric** (discus).

### Last Year's NCAA West Regional

Cal earned a total of 12 qualifiers for the NCAA Championships at last year's NCAA West Regional. The Cal men finished in sixth with 50 points, while the Cal women also came in sixth with 44.50 points. **Martin Maric** took top honors in the discus with a mark of 196-00 (59.75m). He also qualified in the javelin. **Katie Morgan** posted the current school record with a mark of 13-11.75 (4.26m) and placed second overall. **Cherrelle Garrett**, **Ryan Young** and **Jake Hanson** were among the other automatic qualifiers for NCAAs.

### In the NCAA rankings

The Bears in the NCAA's top 10 are **Michael Coe**, who is ranked No. 6 in the 1500 based on his mile time (3:56.18), while junior **Ryan Young** is fourth in the javelin (250-10, 76.45m), senior **Martin Maric** is No. 4 in the discus 198-6 (60.52m) and senior **Jake Hanson** is No. 10 in the 400-meter hurdles (50.32). On the women's side, senior **Inika McPherson** is No. 8 in the high jump (6-0, 1.83m), **Kimyon Broom** is No. 5 in the 100-meter hurdles (13.02) and **Katie Morgan** is No. 10 in the pole vault (4.22m).

### NCAA Regional Qualifiers

Cal boasts 37 NCAA regional qualifiers - 16 on the women's team and 21 on the men's team. The regional qualifiers are - Brook Turner (400), Kandi Bonty (400), Cherrelle Garrett (100, 200), Debra Maier (5000), the women's 4x100 and 4x400, Allison Stokke (Pole Vault), Inika McPherson (High Jump), Kristen Meister (High Jump), Artensia Young (Triple Jump), Tracey Stewart (Triple Jump), Katie Morgan (Pole Vault), Evelyn Smith (400-H), Cyrena Giordano (Pole Vault), Kimyon Broom (100-meter hurdles), Kellan Patterson (100), Nick Porter (100), Michael Coe (mile, 1500), the men's 4x100, Jordan Paul (110-H), Jake Hanson (400-H), Francis Gadayan (800), Sebastian Sam (800), Yosef Ghebray (1500, 5000, 10,000), Eric Lee (1500), Kari Karlsson (5000), Sean Carey (800), Martin Maric (Discus, Javelin), Patrick Kowalsky (Shot Put), Ryan Shuler (Pole Vault), Ryan Young (Javelin) and Kyle Mills-Bunje was a provisional qualifier in the decathlon.

## 2009 Updated Athlete Bios

**Kandi Bonty (400)** – Crossed the finish line in a personal-best time of 54.34 at the Pac-10 Championships, placing eighth overall.

**Kimyon Broom (100-H)** – Set the new school record at the Pac-10 Championships, where she successfully defended her title with a time of 13.02, which ranks sixth in the nation...her time of 13.08 in the 100-meter hurdles at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational surpassed her previous school record-setting time of 13.17, which she set in the prelims at the Pac-10 Championships last year...earned Pac-10 Women's Track Athlete of the Week honors for that performance at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational...clocked a time of 13.52, placing fourth overall, at the Jackie Joyner Kersee-Invitational...set a new Big Meet record in the 100-meter hurdles, clocking a time of 13.26, surpassing the old record time of 13.43, set in 2004 by former Cal star Osarhiemen Omwanghe...won easily at the Payton Jordan Invitational, crossing the finish line at 13.37.

**Sean Carey (800)** – Notched a time of 1:50.33 in the prelims at the Pac-10 Championships.

**Michael Coe (1500, Mile)** – Broke the school record in the mile and set the fastest collegiate, U.S. and third-fastest time in the world this season with a time of 3:56.18. at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational... earned Pac-10 Men's Track Athlete of the Week accolades for that performance at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational...notched a personal-best time of 3:43.34 in the prelims of the 1500 at the Pac-10 Championships...won the 3000 at the Big Meet with a time of 8:13.09. **(Indoors)** Named the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation 2009 MPSF Indoor Track and Field Male Athlete of the Year...earned two All-America honors when he came in second at the NCAA Indoor Championships with a time of 7:54.42 in the 3000 and also when he anchored Cal's third-place distance medley relay that clocked a 9:30.39...posted an NCAA automatic-qualifying and Cal overall record time of 7:48.05 in the 3000 to take second place at the Husky Classic on Feb. 14 in Seattle, and that time ranked third in the nation going into the NCAAs...anchored Cal's winning men's DMR at the MPSF Indoor Championships...posted the nation's 20th-fastest time in the nation and a provisional qualifier (4:00.29) in the men's one-mile run as well as the nation's 33rd fastest time and a provisional qualifier (1:49.65) in the men's 800-meter run this season.

**Francis Gadayan (800)** – Recorded Cal's best 800-meter time of the season in the prelims at the Pac-10 Championships (1:48.90)...clocked a regional-qualifying time of 1:50.09, placing fifth overall, at the Stanford Invitational...took top honors at the Payton Jordan Invitational, crossing the finish line at 1:50.57...MPSF all-academic honoree.

**Cherrelle Garrett (100, 200)** – Clocked a new personal-best time of 11.38 in the 100 at the Pac-10 Championships, earning that time in both the prelims and the final, where she placed second...two-time winner at the Stanford Invitational, capturing first place in both the 100 meters and the 200...in the 100, posted a season-best time of 11.60, which was also a regional-qualifying time, besting her previous regional-qualifying time of 11.73 in prelims...in the 200, Garrett clocked a personal-best time of 23.63, just shy of fifth on Cal's all-time career list (23.62)... also a two-time winner at the Sacramento State Elite Meet, taking first in the 100 (11.69) and the 200 (24.03)...won the 100 for the fourth time this season at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational, clocking a personal best time of 11.40, second best in school history...won both the 100 and the 200 for the third time this season at the Big Meet, clocking a wind-aided time of 11.34 in the 100...in the 200 at the Big Meet, crossed the finish line at 23.81...clocked a time of 11.41 in the 100 at the Jackie Joyner-Kersee Invitational. **(Indoors)** Came in 14th in the prelims of the 60-meter dash at the NCAA Indoor Championships (7.42)...reached the NCAAs with a provisional-qualifying time of 7.34 (tied for 15th in the nation) to win the women's 60-meter dash in the Husky Classic on Feb. 14...also ran 7.34 in the 60-meter prelim at the MPSF Indoor Championships on Feb. 27 in Seattle.

**Yosef Ghebray (1500, 5000, 10,000)** – His time of 28:32.27 at the Stanford Invitational was an automatic qualifier and also set a new school record, surpassing the old time of 29:17.78 by Girmay Guangul...clocked a regional-qualifying time in the 5000 at 13:44.75, placing ninth overall at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational, and that time was also a personal best and ranks fourth all-time in school history...clocked Cal's sixth-best time in school history at 3:42.14 in the 1500 at the Big Meet.

**Cyrena Giordano (Pole Vault)** – Earned a personal-best mark of 13-04.25 (4.07m) to take fourth overall at the Pac-10 Championships...at the Jackie Joyner-Kersee Invitational, came in eighth overall with a mark of 12-7.50 (3.85m)...tied that mark when she took third at the Payton Jordan Invitational.

**Jake Hanson (400-H)** – Clocked a season-best time of 50.60, taking first at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational...came in second at the Stanford Invitational with a regional-qualifying time of 51.25...took top honors at the Sac State Elite Meet (51.38)...came in second at the Pac-10 Championships with a season-best time of 50.32.

**Kari Karlsson (5000)** – Regionally qualified with his personal-best time of 14:06.61 at the Payton Jordan Invitational.

**Patrick Kowalsky (Shot Put)** – Notched a qualifying mark of 56-8 (17.27 meters) at the Hornet Invitational...at the Sac State Elite Meet, finished first in both the shot put and the discus, with his mark in the shot put at 53-8.25 (16.36m) and his personal-best mark in the discus at 158-00 (48.15m)...claimed first at the Big Meet with his throw of 55-11.00 (17.04m)... won at the Payton Jordan Invitational with a mark of 55-8.25 (16.97m)...MPSF all-academic honoree.

**Eric Lee (1500)** – In the 1500 at the Big Meet, notched the 10th-best time in the program (3:44.01).

**Debra Maier (5000)** – Secured a regional-qualifying time of 16:31.41 at the Stanford Invitational, placing sixth overall.

**Martin Maric (Discus, Javelin)** – Took top honors in the discus with a season-best throw of 195-09 (59.67m)...earned a regional-qualifying mark of 56.71 meters and took first place at the Cal Outdoor Opener...improved on that mark at the Stanford Invitational where he took top honors (191-06, 58.37m)...notched a regional-qualifying mark of 218-0 (66.46m) in the javelin at the Jackie Joyner-Kersey Invitational...came in second at the Pac-10 Championships (197-00, 60.06m).

**Inika McPherson (High Jump)** – Won the Pac-10 Championship in the women's high jump with her first-place jump of 5-11.25 (1.81m)...took top honors at the Cal Outdoor Opener with a regional-qualifying mark of 1.80m...at the Big Meet, took first with her mark of 6-0.0 (1.83m). **(Indoors)** Tied the Cal indoor school record and earned All-America honors at the NCAA Indoor Championships with her mark of 6-0 (1.83 meters), placing fourth in the event...notched an NCAA provisional qualifier of 5-11.5 (1.82 meters, tied for 7th-best in the nation) when she took second in the women's high jump at the MPSF Indoor Championships.

**Kristen Meister (High Jump)** – Placed second at the Cal Outdoor Opener, just behind teammate Inika McPherson, with a regional-qualifying mark of 1.75m. **(Indoors)** Earned 11th place at the NCAA Indoor Championships with a mark of 5-8.75 (1.75)...posted a provisional-qualifying 5-11.5 (1.82, tied for 7th-best in the nation) when she won the women's high jump at the UW Invitational on Jan. 31 in Seattle... MPSF all-academic honoree.

**Kyle Mills-Bunje (Decathlon)** – Provisionally regionally qualified at the Pac-10 Multi Event Championships, when he posted a personal-best score of 7,007 points...highlighting his performance at the Pac-10 Multis was taking second in the javelin and the shot put, with his marks of 177-11 (54.22m) in the javelin and 40-10.25 (12.45m) in the shot put.

**Katie Morgan (Pole Vault)** – At the Pac-10 Championships, took second in the pole vault with a season-best mark of 13-10.00 (4.22m)...in her outdoor opener, came in second with a regional-qualifying mark of 12-7.5 (3.85m)...took top honors with a jump of 13-6.50 (4.13m) at the Big Meet, setting the meet record for the second straight year, and won the event in a jump-off that took 15 jumps in order to find a winner...took top honors with a mark of 13-3.50 (4.05m) at the Payton Jordan Invitational. **(Indoors)** Posted an NCAA automatic-qualifying mark and Cal indoor record of 4.20 meters (13-9.25) in the Jan. 24 Cherry and Silver Invitational...MPSF all-academic honoree...won the pole vault title at the 2008 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships with that same mark.

**Kellan Patterson (100)** – Notched a personal-best time of 10.45 in the prelims at the Pac-10 Championships, and that time ranks sixth all-time in school history...had previously clocked a then-lifetime-best 10.49, coming in second overall at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational...won the 100 at the Cal Outdoor Opener with a regional-qualifying time of 10.54...won the 100 in 10.60 at the Big Meet...came in second at the Stanford Invitational with his time of 10.65...took top honors with his time of 10.61 and second in the 200 (21.84) at the Sac State Elite Meet.

**Jordan Paul (110-H)** – Has earned regional-qualifying times in the 110-meter hurdles on four separate occasions so far this season, with his season-best time of 13.66 coming at the Pac-10 Championships where he placed second, and that time ranks fourth all-time in school

history...clocked a time of 13.79 coming in the prelims at the Stanford Invitational...won the 110-H at the Cal Outdoor Opener with a time of 14.08.

**Nick Porter (100)** – Recorded a personal-best time of 10.50 in the prelims of the 100 meters at the Pac-10 Championships.

**Sebastian Sam (800)** – Earned a personal-best time of 1:49.44 in the 800 at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational...notched a personal best of 1:49.85 at the Jackie Joyner-Kersey Invitational, which also was Cal's best 800 time of the season at that time...took second at the Payton Jordan Invitational with a time of 1:50.71.

**Ryan Shuler (Pole Vault)** – Tied the meet record at the Hornet Invitational with his first-place, regional-qualifying mark of 16-6.75 (5.05m)...won the event with a mark of 17-00.75 (5.20m)...took first with a mark of 16-7.50 (5.07m), a then-season best, at the Big Meet...tied for second at the Cal Outdoor Opener with a mark of 17-0 (5.18m)...took first at 16-6.75 (5.05m) at the Sac State Elite Meet...MPSF all-academic honoree.

**Evelyn Smith (400-H)** – Took first place at the Sacramento State Elite Meet with her regional-qualifying time of 59.85...clocked in at 1:00.92 to win the 400-meter hurdles at the Big Meet.

**Tracey Stewart (Triple Jump)** – Came in fourth at the Pac-10 Championships with her season-best mark of 40-9.00 (12.42m)...notched a mark of 40-6.25 (12.35m) at the Payton Jordan Invitational.

**Allison Stokke (Pole Vault)** – Recorded a new personal best at the Sacramento Open surpassing her previous personal best by four inches with her first-place mark of 13-9.75 (4.21m) that ranks second all time in school history, is Cal's best mark of the season and earned her Pac-10 Women's Field Athlete of the Week honors that week...tied her then-collegiate best mark at 13-5.75 (4.11m) at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational, which also ranks second in school history...tied for second at the Cal Outdoor Opener with a mark of 13-2.25 (4.02m)...recorded a regional-qualifying mark of 12-7.50 (3.85m) at the Stanford Invitational...at the Payton Jordan Invitational, tallied a score of 12-11.50, 3.95m and came in second.

**Brook Turner (400)** – Set her season-best time of 53.73 at the Pac-10 Championships when she took fifth overall...at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational, won the 400 in a then-season-best time of 54.12...clocked a time of 54.14 at the Jackie Joyner-Kersey Invitational...won the 400 at the Cal Outdoor Opener with a regional-qualifying time of 54.35...followed that performance at the Stanford Invitational with a 54.39, taking third in the event...won the 400 with a time of 54.81 at the Sac State Elite Meet, and at the Big Meet (54.42).

**Artensia Young (Triple Jump)** – Secured a new personal best of 41-07.25 (12.68m) at the Brutus Hamilton Invitational, which ranks fifth all-time in school history...notched a regional-qualifying mark at the Cal Outdoor Opener with her first-place mark of 12.44 meters.

**Ryan Young (Javelin)** – Named the Pac-10 Men's Field Athlete of the Week on April 13 after his record-setting performance at the Jackie Joyner-Kersey Invitational when he set both the school and meet records, posting a record-setting mark of 250-10 (76.45m)...broke the previous Big Meet record in the javelin, which was set in 1931, with his throw of 224-10 (68.52m)...took fourth in the javelin at the Stanford Invitational, earning a mark of 217-11 (66.42m).
