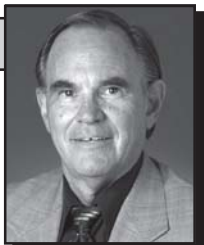

PETE NEWELL CHALLENGE

On Dec. 3, 2006, the Pete Newell Challenge will celebrate its 10th anniversary with a doubleheader at HP Pavilion in San Jose. Texas Tech will face Stanford in the opener at 3:30 p.m., followed by California vs. Nevada at 6 p.m.



In its brief history, the Pete Newell Challenge has become one of the premier events in college basketball. Texas Tech and Nevada join an impressive list of past participants that includes Duke, North Carolina, Kansas, Temple, Gonzaga, Indiana, Michigan and Michigan State.

The Pete Newell Challenge was created to honor the Hall of Fame legend who won a coaching version of the Triple Crown – an NIT championship at San Francisco (1949), an NCAA title at California (1959) and an Olympic gold medal for the United States (1960).

Newell, who turned 91 last Aug. 31, was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1978 and into the Cal Athletic Hall of Fame in 1987. He served as head coach of the Bears from 1954-60 and compiled a 119-44 record.

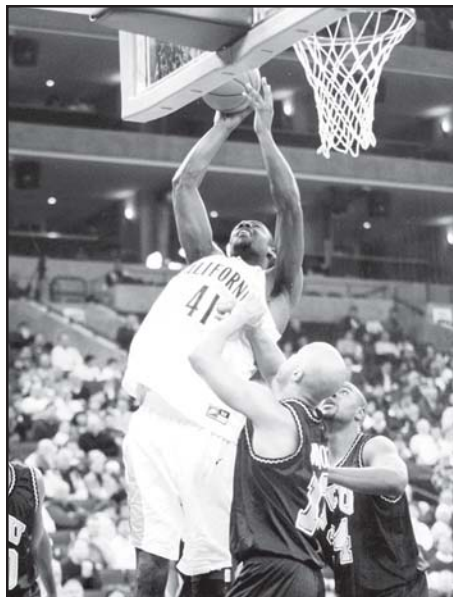

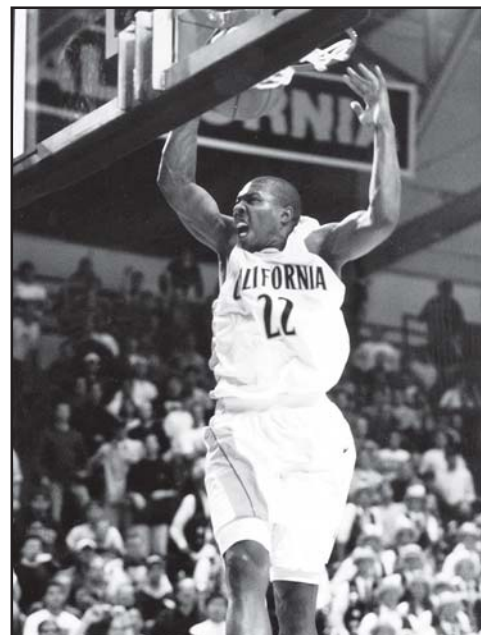

Now expanded to all 10 teams, the winner receives the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA playoffs. The first three rounds of the tournament will be broadcast on Fox Sports Net, while the championship game will air on CBS.

Last year, Cal earned the third seed in the field and reached the final for the first time. The Bears downed USC, 82-67, in the opening round, before outlasting Oregon, 91-87, in double overtime in the semifinals. Cal then lost the championship game, 71-52, to UCLA. Leon Powe was named tournament MOP



after setting a tournament record with 41 points vs. Oregon, and Ayinde Ubaka joined him on the all-tournament team.
