### NANOOKS VISIT KALAMAZOO FOR FINAL CCHA ROAD TRIP

*Alaska heads into the weekend tied with Western in the CCHA standings; teams battle for chance to host first round playoff series*

#### FACE OFF

The Alaska Nanooks travel south to Kalamazoo, MI, this weekend to play their final regular-season conference road series. The Nanooks will face-off against the Western Michigan University Broncos both nights at Lawson Arena.

#### NANOOKS COVERAGE

Saturday's game will be televised live from Kalamazoo on FSN Detroit starting at 12:35 p.m. AKST. Two-time gold medallist Angela Ruggiero will serve as game analyst for the telecast that is a part of the 'Hockey Day in Michigan' celebration.

The games will also be simulcast live on the Fairbanks radio waves at KYSC 96.9 FM and KSUA 91.5 FM with Bruce Cech on the call.

The series against the Broncos will be available on the Internet through live audio streaming at <http://ksua.uaf.edu/> and live statistics will also be available online also at <http://alaskananooks.cstv.com/>.

#### THE SERIES

The Nanooks have met the Broncos 28 times since their first meeting on Jan. 2, 1992, when WMU split the weekend

series with Alaska. The Broncos took the first game 4-3 before the Nanooks got revenge with a 5-2 upset the following evening.

WMU has a five-game lead in the all-time series which stands at 17-12-4. The Broncos also hold the advantage in Kalamazoo with a 9-5 record when facing Alaska.

#### IN RECENT HISTORY

WMU and Alaska have only met for one two-game series in each of the last two seasons. Last year they met in Fairbanks and the Nanooks turned in a three-point performance with a 1-1 tie (OT) and a 5-3 win, Feb. 17-18.

On their last visit to Kalamazoo in 2004 (Oct. 15-16), the Nanooks split the series with the Broncos, falling 5-4 the first night before responding with a 5-3 triumph in the re-match.

Alaska holds a three game unbeaten streak (2-0-1) against WMU entering the weekend.

#### WHERE THEY STAND

The Nanooks are 2-9-3 overall and 2-7-3 in conference when playing on the road. They are looking to build on a two-game road unbeaten streak this weekend

## Coaches Corner



**Record at Alaska: 44-45-15**  
**CCHA Record: 29-37-12**

**Tavis MacMillan** enters his third season as head coach of the University of Alaska Fairbanks.

The Milk River, Alberta, native had an outstanding four-year career as a Nanook. He made an immediate impact during his time, opening his career at UAF by scoring 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points. MacMillan upped that total to 35 points in his sophomore campaign by earning seven goals and 28 assists. His junior season was even better as MacMillan had 16 goals and an amazing 41 assists for 57 points. And as if that wasn't good enough, he saved the best for last, tallying 23 goals and 51 assists for 74 points in his senior season.

He is UAF's fourth all-time leading scorer with 192 career points. He tied teammate Dean Fedorchuk for the NCAA scoring crown (74 points) during the 1993-94 season, also garnering team MVP and scholar-athlete honors.

Following graduation, he won the U.S. Senior championships with the Alaska Gold Kings in 1994-95. MacMillan returned to UAF to serve as an assistant coach for seven years to Dave Laurion and then Guy Gadowsky.

In 2003-04 MacMillan decided to take a year away from the ice to fill an administrative position in the UAF Athletics Department as the NCAA Compliance Coordinator. After a year off he was ready to rejoin the coaching ranks at the helm of his alma mater.

"I am very excited and energized by the challenge of continuing this program down the path of success," commented MacMillan after accepting the head coaching position."

"I have worn the Nanooks Blue & Gold and I take great pride in the opportunity to lead this team. I foresee this being a seamless transition because Guy (Gadowsky) and I share many similar values on what this program should represent."

MacMillan and his wife, Deon, have three daughters, Taryn (11) Camryn (6) and Lauryn (4). They reside in Fairbanks.

Alaska's two road wins this season were a 4-3 decision at Nebraska-Omaha on Nov. 4 and a 5-2 triumph at Bowling Green on Jan. 26.

### **OUTLOOK ON THE BRONCOS**

The Broncos were swept last weekend by No. 11 Michigan in a home-and-home series. After dropping the first encounter 7-4 at Lawson Arena, the Broncos stumbled 3-1 at Yost.

WMU is led offensively by first-year forward Mark Letestu, who has 18 goals and 19 assists in 28 games this season, while senior forward Paul Szczechura has tallied 13 goals and 18 helpers. Eight skaters on WMU's roster have scored in double-figures this year.

In goal the Broncos have utilized the tandem of junior Daniel Bellissimo and freshman Riley Gill. Bellissimo is 5-9 with a .864 saves percentage and 4.07 goals-against average, while Gill is 7-6-1 and has a GAA of 3.33 and Spt. of .899.

### **WHERE THEY FALL**

WMU and Alaska sit in a three-way tie with Northern Michigan for eight place, the final spot to earn home-ice in the first round of the CCHA playoffs. Each team has 19 points and sits one point behind seventh-place Ohio State and two-points behind sixth-place Lake Superior State. Fifth-place Nebraska-Omaha is four-points ahead of the Nanooks with 23 points.

Notre Dame leads the standings with 36 points while Michigan is on its heels with 32 points and Miami trails them with 30. The top four teams in the CCHA earn first round byes in the CCHA Playoffs and then host the winners of the first round during the second weekend of post-season action.

### **WHO'S THE BOSS?**

Jim Culhane is in his eighth full season at Western Michigan having established the second-longest tenure behind the bench in WMU's hockey history.

He is 1-2-1 vs. Alaska's third-year head coach, Tavis MacMillan.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

After suffering the third longest losing streak in program history (nine games), Alaska has turned a new leaf and enjoyed a two-week unbeaten streak through their last four-games (2-0-2).

For the second weekend in a row the Nanooks got a win on the first night of the weekend series and then pulled out a tie in the series finale.

Last Friday night Alaska was finally able to do what it had narrowly missed in seven previous contests this season. After being robbed of a 1-0 shutout by an extra-attacker goal with 23 seconds remaining in regulation, the Nanooks junior forward Aaron Lee found the answer for the Blue and Gold at 3:36 of the extra session to lift them to victory.

### **EXTRA SESSION**

Friday night the Nanooks were finally able to accomplish a feat they had narrowly missed in seven previous contests this season. Aaron Lee's goal during the extra session gave Alaska its first win in overtime on the season.

### **EXTRA, EXTRA SESSIONS**

One night after getting its first OT win of the season, the Nanooks came from behind for a third straight time to tie the game and force a fourth period of play. Unable to break the score through the extra five minutes, the Nanooks earned their sixth tie of the season and improved to 1-2-6 in overtime.

### **OVERTIME WIN OVERDUE**

Aaron Lee's overtime game-winner couldn't have come at a better time. Not only did it give Alaska its first such victory of the season, but it marked Alaska's first overtime win since Oct. 14, 2004 when forward Kyle Greentree netted a game-winner in overtime against (then) No. 1 Minnesota in Minneapolis. It was the first win in an extra session at the Carlson Center since Feb. 11, 2005, when Ryan McLeod netted the GWG for the Nanooks in OT to lift them over



Michigan State 6-5.

#### **A DECADE FOR TWENTY**

Alaska's leading scorer Kyle Greentree tallied his team-leading 20th goal of the season on Feb. 3 against Miami. In doing so he is the first Nanook skater in ten years to reach the 20-goal mark in a season. Jeff Trembecky (1996-97) was the last Alaska player to accomplish the feat.

#### **SPREADING SOME BROTHERLY LOVE**

Last weekend the Nanooks made the most of their family ties. Junior left wing Aaron Lee scored the overtime game-winning goal Friday night to help Alaska upset No. 10 Miami, before his younger brother Jeff notched the game-tying goal in Saturday's rematch to salvage a third point on the weekend against the RedHawks.

#### **ROAD RAGE**

The Nanooks will look to improve their road record this weekend at WMU. The trek to Kalamazoo is the last regular-season road trip for Alaska, who is 2-9-3 overall and 2-7-3 in the CCHA when playing away from Fairbanks.

#### **HOBEBY WATCH**

Junior forward Kyle Greentree has received over twenty-one thousand votes in the "Vote for Hobey Baker" online polls. He has the fourth highest vote total and is garnering 11 percent of the votes in the online balloting.

#### **APPROACHING A CENTURY**

Junior forward Kyle Greentree is just 6 points shy of joining Curtis Fraser in the 100-point club. As a junior he will potentially become the 28th skater in program history to accomplish the career feat, making him the youngest skater to do so since head coach Tavis MacMillan and Dean Fedorchuk joined the club during their junior seasons (1992-93). The youngest skaters in program history to join the club were Steve Moria and Eric Stokes, who each had registered 100 points amidst their sophomore season (1983-84).

#### **THE CENTURY CLUB**

Senior center Curtis Fraser became the 27th member of the Nanook Hockey program's 100-Point Club on Jan. 19 when he notched an assist on sophomore forward Adam Naglich's power-play goal at 9:48 of the third period. He then added a second helper on junior forward Kyle Greentree's goal at 16:41 of the third period and a power-play goal of his own on Jan. 20.

He has 55-53--108 in 139 career games for Alaska.

#### **SENIOR LEADERSHIP**

Senior forward Curtis Fraser has stepped up his game for the Nanooks in recent games to help them get back on the winning track. In the last six games he has scored four goals and five assists to lead the team with nine points through those games, which included three multi-point games. His greatest output (2-1--3) in that span was on Jan. 26, when his offensive contributions helped Alaska break its nine-game losing streak with a 5-2 victory at Bowling Green.

#### **TOP RE(AR)GUARDS**

Junior blueliner Darcy Campbell and sophomore defenseman Tyler Eckford share the lead in defenseman scoring and are also tied for third on the team in points. Eckford has five goals and 16 assists, while Campbell has a pair of goals and 19 assists this season. Eckford leads the team in power-play assists with 11 and is third overall for power-play points (3-8--11).

#### **THEY'LL TAKE YOUR FACEOFF**

Fraser has emerged as the Nanooks top faceoff taker this season. He has won 223 faceoffs and lost 138 for 61.8 percent efficiency.

Rookie center Dion Knelsen, who has taken the draw the most times for Alaska this season, leads the team in faceoff wins with 230 and 192 losses for 54.5 percent efficiency.

#### **ROLLER COASTER RIDE**

After losing only two of their first 10 contests (5-2-3) the Nanooks took a plunge mid-season, losing eleven of their

next 14 games (2-11-1). They have made a move in the winning direction again, going 2-0-2 in their last four outings.

#### **MR. NICE GUY**

Alaska's rookie forward Brandon Knelsen is the least penalized player on the Nanooks roster to play in every game this season. In 28 contests he has only assessed three minors for six penalty minutes.

#### **POWER-FUL PLAY**

Despite ranking sixth in the CCHA for its power play, Alaska has the second best power play overall with 20.3 efficiency (37 of 182).

#### **POWER-PLAYER**

The Nanooks leading scorer, junior forward Kyle Greentree, has tallied just under half of his points this season on the power play. Ten of his 20 season goals and eight of his 15 assists (18 of 35 total points) this year were scored when the Nanooks were skating with a man-advantage. He has also registered 63 shots on goal during Alaska's 182 power-play attempts.

He leads the CCHA in overall and conference power-play goals.

#### **MULTIPLICITY**

Junior Kyle Greentree has ten multi-point games under his belt this season, including two four-point performances, three three-point games and five two-point showings.

In his career he has recorded 20 multi-point games.

#### **HOME COOKING**

The Nanooks play four of their remaining six conference contests on the Carlson's Olympic ice-sheet, where they are 7-4-3 this season. They have completed two series sweeps at home against Air Force, Oct. 13-13 and Ferris State, Oct. 27-28.

#### **BROTHER BEARS**

Alaska's roster boasts two sets of brothers this season. Junior forward Aaron Lee is joined by his younger



brother and freshman forward Jeff Lee. First-year forwards Dion and Brandon Knelsen are also keeping it in the family. Brandon is the elder sibling.

Next fall the Nanooks will welcome a third pair of brothers as red-shirt defenseman Dustin Molle, who transferred for the University of Alaska Anchorage this fall, will be joined by his younger brother Bryant, a defenseman currently playing in the British Columbia Hockey League, who has signed a National Letter of Intent for the Fall of 2007.

#### HE LOOKS GOAL-LORIOUS

Junior Kyle Greentree continues to pace the Nanooks for the third consecutive season. His 20 goals in 28 games this season have surpassed his goal output from a year ago.

#### CALLING THE SHOTS

Alaska has outshot its opponent in just over half (15) of the games played, been outshot in 12 and equaled its opponent's shot output once this season. The Nanooks are 4-7-1 with the disadvantage in shots and 5-5-5 when they hold the advantage. The Jan. 19 game against Michigan marked the first time that Alaska tied its opponent in shots on goal, each registering 31 apiece. The Wolverines won the contest 5-2.

#### TRIPLE THREAT

Alaska's third line, composed of senior forwards Lucas Burnett and Jordan Emmerson and sophomore forward Trevor Hyatt all snapped scoreless streaks when they registered two points apiece against Michigan State Jan. 13. Hyatt notched a goal and an assist to end a three-game scoreless skid, while Burnett got his first points in as many games with two helpers. Emmerson, who had been out for five games with a wrist injury, got his first goal of the season and added an assist for his first multi-point game of the season and first points since he helped on a goal at Northern Michigan on Nov. 11.

#### DION KNELSEN IS 'A' OKAY

Rookie forward Dion Knelsen was named an 'A' Prospect by the

National Hockey League's Central Scouting Service (CSS) in November.

The 5-10, 180-pound center is the first player in Nanook history to be listed as an 'A' prospect and is one of only four collegiate players to be recognized as such and the only 'A' prospect in the CCHA.

Knelsen made his return to the ice against Lake Superior State after sitting out four conference games with a shoulder injury he sustained in practice before the Nanooks series at Nebraska-Omaha.

#### HIGH-FIVE FOR DION

Freshman Dion Knelsen is the only Nanook skater this season to register five points in a game. He had two goals and three assists against Air Force on Oct. 14, 2006. For his stellar performance he nabbed CCHA Rookie of the Week honors on Oct. 17.

The freshman standout leads the Alaska rookies in scoring with 5-13--18 this season and is the fifth best scorer on the Nanooks' roster.

#### SHORT STUFF

Junior left wing Aaron Lee's short-handed marker on Jan. 7 against the Buckeyes was the Nanooks second such goal in a three-game stretch and fourth of the season. Senior center Lucas Burnett also tallied one against Alaska Anchorage on Dec. 30.

#### FROZEN FOUR SKILLS CHALLENGE

Senior forward Curtis Fraser was one of 89 finalists named for the 2007 Frozen Four Skills Challenge.

The finalists were pared down from an original list of 181 student-athletes, who were nominated by their head coaches. A committee will select the 32 players that will compete in the event.

The second annual Skills Challenge will be held April 6 at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis and will be shown
