Notes

This Week:

- Lake Superior State was in the midst of a 12-game winless streak when it lost 4-2 and 3-1 to Northern Michigan in November. The Lakers are 4-2-2 in their last eight games heading into this weekend's home-and-home re-match with NMU. The Wildcats are also hot, going 5-1-2 in their last eight contests.
- Lake Superior State finished 3-1-0 against Northern Michigan and won the total-goals series 9-4 last year to claim the Father Cappelletti Cup for the first time since the 1999-00 season. NMU leads this year's series, 7-3.
- LSSU senior forward Dan Eves scored a goal in both games of the Nov. 23-24 series against NMU, and sophomore forward Zac MacVoy had an assist in both games. Eves leads the Lakers in points with 8-14—22 and has 3-7--10 in the Lakers' last 10 games. MacVoy is second in points with 8-13—21 and has 5-6—11 in his last 10 games.
- This weekend's series will match up first cousins Steven Kaunisto (LSSU) and Ray Kaunisto (NMU), who are both sophomores. Steven Kaunisto, a defenseman, has 4-7—11 this season. Ray Kaunisto, a forward, has 7-2—9.
- Sophomore goaltender Pat Inglis, with a season goals-against average of 3.84 and save percentage of .873, is 2-1-1 in his last four games with a 2.47 gaa.

Last Week:

- Freshman forward Rick Schofield scored a goal in both games of last weekend's 2-1 OT and 5-3 victories over Alaska. He tallied his first collegiate game-winning goal at 2:42 of overtime on Friday. Sophomore forward John Scrymgeour scored two goals during Saturday's 5-3 win, including LSSU's second short-handed goal of the season. Senior forward Dan Eves totaled 1-2—3, while senior forward Jason Blain (1-1—2), sophomore defenseman Steven Kaunisto (0-2—2) and sophomore forward Zac MacVoy (0-2—2) also had multiple-point weekends.
- By beating Alaska 2-1 in overtime and 5-3 last weekend, the Lakers swept a series for the first time since taking the first two games of last season's CCHA second-round playoff series at Miami.
- All three Laker seniors – Dan Eves, Jason Blain and Justin Gutwald – recorded a point on Senior Night last Saturday against Alaska.
- LSSU heads into its final regular-season series with a 6-8-1 home record and 2-10-5 road record.

Lake Superior State coach Jim Roque



Jim Roque became the ninth coach in the 41-year history of Lake Superior State hockey when he replaced Frank Anzalone in June of 2005. He is the second former Laker player to take the helm of the LSSU program.

During his first season (2005-06), he led the Lakers to a 15-14-7 finish and their first winning season since 1999-00. The Lakers also earned home ice for the first round of the Central Collegiate Hockey Association Playoffs for the first time since that year.

The Lakers continued their upward climb in 2006-07 by finishing 21-19-3 and reaching the CCHA semifinals at Joe Louis Arena for the first time since 1995-96. Roque and his coaching staff mentored outstanding leaders during those two seasons, including Lowe's Senior CLASS first-team and All-CCHA goaltender Jeff Jakaitis, All-CCHA defenseman Derek A. Smith and outstanding captains Steve McJannet and Barnabas

Birkeland.

Roque began his third stint as an assistant coach at Lake Superior State University in 2001-02. Previously, he was an assistant coach for the Lakers from 1988-91 and also in 1994-95. After six seasons as an assistant at Clarkson University, he returned to LSSU in 2001. Roque also spent two and one-half seasons coaching in the Saskatchewan Junior Hockey League from 1991-93.

With Roque's during a four-year span under Anzalone, LSSU moved up in the CCHA standings after enduring three straight 12th-place finishes. The Lakers improved to 11th in 2003-04 and ninth in 2004-05. In 2005-06, they placed sixth in the CCHA and began to attract notice in the national polls.

After graduating from LSSU in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in management, the Killarney, Ont., native started his coaching career as an assistant under Anzalone and stayed on to work with former coach Jeff Jackson. This is his 11th overall season as a coach at LSSU.

Roque played for the Lakers from 1983-87 and totaled 56 goals and 144 career

points, which was good for 19th place on the Lakers' total career points chart. Roque was a part of the first recruited class brought in by Anzalone and was also a member of the first Laker squad to advance to the NCAA Tournament in 1985.

The only other former Laker who went on to become the program's head coach was Rick Comley, who is now the head coach of the Michigan State Spartans. He coached at LSSU from 1973 through '76.

Roque was on the LSSU coaching staff when it won the 1988 NCAA Championship, and he recruited the majority of the 1992 title team. He has played a role in all five NCAA Tournament appearances and was part of two CCHA playoff and two regular-season titles.

At Clarkson, he coached two Hobey Baker finalists and four National Hockey League players. He was also a part of three Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference (ECAC) regular-season titles, four trips to the NCAA Tournament and one playoff championship.

He and his wife, Julia, have two children—Emma (12) and Abby (10).
