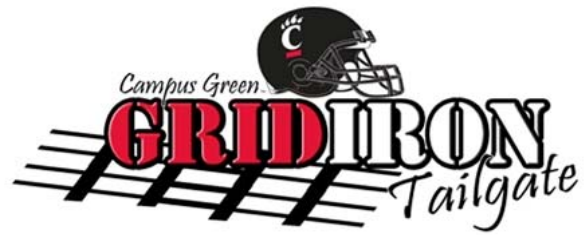


GRID GUIDE



THE PLOTS

See attached map for your plot location. Plot sizes will vary. The approximate average size of one GRID space is 20' x 16'.

Your plot number remains the same for all four games in 2011. Plot numbers will be displayed at each location for your convenience.

DROP-OFF ZONES

Two drop-off zones are conveniently located near the GRID for unloading all of your tailgating supplies. A 10-minute parking limit will be enforced at these locations.

Locations:

West University Ave. Circle (off of Jefferson Ave.)
Lindner Hall Circle, Campus Green Dr. (off of MLK)

Recommended Parking:

University Avenue garage is a nearby lot that requires a parking pass. Both Campus Green and Woodside garages are close cash parking options.

TIMES

THE GRID will be accessible beginning four (4) hours prior to the scheduled game time.

The area will close 30-minutes before kickoff. Tailgating equipment may remain at your space during the game; security will remain on hand.

THE GRID will re-open after the game for a brief period. Groups must begin to disassemble their parties no later than one hour after the conclusion of the game.

BRINGING SUPPLIES/EQUIPMENT

Plot holders may bring their own food, beverages, and tailgating supplies including grills, coolers, tables, chairs, and small pop-up canopy tents (maximum size of 10' x 10'). Groups who have multiple neighboring plots may inquire about the use of larger tents.

Due to fire safety regulations pertaining to the distance between a working grill and a tent structure, **NO TENT MAY BE UPRIGHT ON YOUR PLOT WHILE GRILLING.** Groups who have multiple neighboring spaces must grill on a tent-free plot.

Commercial advertising signage and displays are prohibited.

Beverages are permitted; no visible glass bottles or cans.

Individuals are responsible for compliance with all local and state laws governing alcohol consumption.

Help keep Campus Green beautiful by utilizing the various trash receptacles located throughout the GRID. We encourage tailgaters to bring plastic garbage bags that can be left at your space and easily collected by clean up crews.

Coals from grilling must be disposed of in one of the designated coal dumpsters located around the GRID.

Groups are to avoid blocking sidewalks, damaging landscaping or property, and obstructing neighboring tailgates.

The sale of food or beverages or other commercial activity is prohibited without the express written consent of the University of Cincinnati.

ALL AMERICAN RENTAL CENTER

The GRID has partnered with All American Rental Center who can provide various tailgating supplies for your gathering.

Please note that AARC is the only rental company with access to THE GRID on game day.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES AVAILABLE

Several food and beverage vendors will be on hand including Donatos, City Barbecue, and Buffalo Wild Wings!

CATWALK

Two hours and twenty minutes prior to kickoff for each home game, the Bearcats team buses will arrive and the Band will lead the team parade right through the heart of the GRID.

OPEN ACCESS

All fans that do not have a reserved area are encouraged to attend the Gridiron tailgate. Any unreserved green space in the tailgate area (inside boundary marked by rope) may be utilized by walk-up tailgaters.

Coolers and chairs are permitted. (Grilling is only allowed on reserved Grid space)

We will attempt to leave a large area open in the corporate tent section each week. However, the number of corporate tents will vary from game to game altering the size of the space.
