

**Tiger Paw Invitational
Clemson, South Carolina
February 10-11, 2012
REVISED**

Facility: The Clemson Indoor Track & Field Complex has a 200m flat Mondo Super-X Performance surface with a 73 foot radius. Six 44 inch wide lanes on the oval, eight 44 inch wide lanes on the straightaway, two long jump/triple jump runways and pits, two pole vault runways and landing pits, a separate throwing cage for shot put and weight throw, and has seating for 1,800 spectators. There is also an athletic training room, restrooms and concession facilities. This facility features a second floor mezzanine for event operations.

Entry Information

Teams Attending: This meet is by invitation only. All accepted entries will be approved by meet management.

Entry Process: Go to www.directathletics.com all competing teams will be allowed 3 entries per event and 2 relays.

Entry Deadline: 3:00PM, Tuesday, February 7, 2012

Entry Fee: \$425.00 per men's team and \$425.00 per women's team. For teams with less than 14 athletes the entry fee is \$30 per athlete. Make all checks payable to CUAD. Coaches may pick up their team packets in the lobby of the Indoor Track on meet day.

Athlete Check-In (Revised)

Athletes must check in with the Meet Clerk or the Event Official at least 60 minutes prior to the start of the event. Athletes not checked in by that time will be scratched from the meet. Check in for the running events are located by the start of the 60m by the garage door. **In the 200, 400 and 4x400 check-in will be 90 minutes prior to the start of the respective event. Athletes not checked in at this time will absolutely be scratched from the meet. Seeding for those events will take place at the end of the check-in period. Athletes must report to the clerk for lane assignments 30 minutes prior to the start of the respective event. Athletes must remain at the starting zone at this point until they have raced.**

RUNNING EVENTS:

There will only be a prelims, semi's and finals in the 60m dash and 60m hurdles. The preliminaries will be randomly drawn. Preferred lanes: (straightaway) 4-5-6-2-7-1-8 Preferred lanes: (oval) 5-4-6-3-2-1. All other running events will be run as finals in sections based on time. Heats will be seeded according to submitted times on directathletics.com. The fastest sections will be run first. Meet management reserves the right to adjust heats as necessary. Unseeded sections of running events will only be contested if needed. This will be determined by field sizes those particular events.

FIELD EVENTS

Three entries per event (ACC Schools 4 per event). There will be preliminaries in each of the field events. Each athlete will get 3 attempts in the preliminary rounds, with the top 9 advancing to the finals. Each athlete is guaranteed one legal measurement then the other marks must be further than the minimum to be measured.

STARTING HEIGHTS/MINIMUM MEASUREMENTS:

High Jump:	Men- 1.85m	Women- 1.55m
Triple Jump:	Men- 13.00m	Women- 11.00m
Shot Put:	Men- 14m	Women- 12m
Long Jump:	Men- 6.60m	Women- 5.30m
Weight Throw:	Men- 14m	Women- 14m
Pole Vault:	Men- 4.15m	Women-3.15m

Implement Weigh In: All shot and weight implements must be weighed in to the left of the throws cage 1 hr prior to the start of the first throwing event.

Medical Facilities: The indoor facility is equipped with an Athletic Training Center inside the facility and will be available for use throughout the event.

Showers: There are no shower facilities available to teams following the meet. Please plan accordingly
