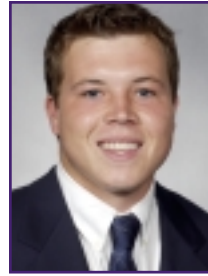

- Third in the nation in field goals made per game (2.0).
- Sixth in the nation in kick scoring points per game (9.0) and is tied for 18th overall in the nation in scoring (all positions).
- Ranks 12th in the nation in career field-goal percentage among active players (77%).
- Has made 22 of 29 field goals (76%) in the 2005 season after making 80 percent in 2004 (12-15).
- Needs just one field goal to tie Obed Ariri's (1980) Clemson single-season record.
- Tied for first in the ACC in scoring with 9.0 points per game.
- Is a perfect 33-33 on extra points in 2005.
- One of three Lou Groza Award finalists, and the only ACC kicker among the finalists.
- Made a school-record six field goals in Clemson's season-opening win over #17 Texas A&M, including the game winner from 42 yards with 0:02 left (also scored 19 points in that game to set a school record for kick scoring).
- [USAToday.com](#) National Player-of-the-Week for his performance against Texas A&M.
- Has only two missed kicks inside of 40 yards in 27 career attempts from that range (his only two misses were a 39 yarder and a 31 yarder that was blocked).
- Is 9-14 on field goals from 40-49 yards in his career.
- Made 12 of 15 field goals (80%) in 2004.
- ACC Specialist-of-the-Week for his performance against South Carolina in 2004 when he was 3-3 on field goals and scored 11 points.
- Made his last five attempts in 2004 and his first seven in 2005.
- Has kicked at least three field goals in six different games.
- Had a kick of 48 yards at #10 Miami (FL) in 2004, and also had a six-yard run for a first down on a fake field goal in that game. Clemson went on to win 24-17 in overtime in the Orange Bowl.
- Made his first 15 field goal attempts in home games.
- First-Team Academic All-ACC selection in 2004.
