The Gary Waters Basketball Team Camp will be held on June 20-21, 2008, on the Cleveland State campus with Coach Waters and the Cleveland State men's basketball coaching staff. Last year was a successful and exciting two days of hard-nose basketball. Over 32 teams came to Cleveland State from all over the Midwest to compete.

In Waters' first season at Cleveland State, he guided the Vikings to impressive victories over ACC member Miami (Fla.) as well as Kent State.

When Gary Waters takes over a program, he places a strong emphasis on character and discipline. Waters' family-oriented approach, combined with an up-tempo game that relies on fundamentals and relentless defensive pressure, has paid huge dividends at both Kent State and Rutgers.

Waters, the 2007-08 Horizon League Co-Coach of the Year, has amassed over 200 wins during his 12 seasons as head coach at Kent State, Rutgers and Cleveland State leading his teams to post-season appearances six times. He was respon-

sible for building the Golden Flash program to national prominence, completing a highly successful five-year stint (1996-2001) that featured a 92-60 (.605) record. In 2004, Waters directed Rutgers to the NIT Championship game and reached the 20-win plateau, a first for Rutgers since the 1982 season. Waters's five years at Rutgers has provided the program with the building blocks for sustained success.

Each team will play a minimum of four games during the two-day shootout, with all of the games being played in either the Wolstein Center — the site of NCAA First and Second round tournament games twice in the last decade — or historic Woodling Gym.

Each high school is welcome to bring their varsity or junior varsity teams to compete in this camp. The games will be played at the highest level that high school basketball has to offer as some of the best teams from around Ohio and adjoining states are expected to attend.
