NEWS AND NOTES

In the Last Meeting vs. IUPUI

A 19-point second half deficit and the absence of MAC Player of the Year Crystal Bradford proved to be too much to overcome and CMU fell to the visiting Jaguars, 72-66, bringing to an end a sometimes magical and record-setting 2013-14 season. The setback snapped CMU's 11-game season home win streak and dipped the program's postseason record to 0-6 all-time.

Lucky Number 7

Thursday's game marks the seventh time in program history the Chippewas have competed in postseason play, first time since 2014. The Maroon and Gold have made three prior WNIT appearances, and three NCAA tournament berths. The Chippewas have yet to earn a postseason victory.

Comeback Kids

The Chippewas have found themselves down at the half 14 times this season, but have come out victorious eight out of those 14 games, including the two victories in the MAC Tournament.

Confident Chippewas

Central Michigan has been the surprise MAC team this season, picked to finish fifth in the West in the preseason poll. The Chippewas went 5-0 against MAC West favorites Ball State and Eastern Michigan this season, and have gone 15-4 in their last 19 games.

2016 MAC Coach of the Year

Central Michigan's Sue Guevara was named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year Tuesday on the eve of the league women's basketball tournament. It is the first time that Guevara has earned the MAC Coach of the Year Award in her nine seasons at Central Michigan.

2016 MAC Freshman of the Year

Presley Hudson earned the Freshman of the Year Award Tuesday on the eve of the league women's basketball tournament. Hudson, a 5-foot-6 freshman guard from Wayland, Mich., is CMU's leading scorer at 14.0 points per game and is the MAC's most-efficient free throw shooter, knocking down her charity tosses at an 89.0 percent rate. She is the fourth Chippewa to be named the league's top freshman, and the first since Niki DiGuilio in 2011.

All-MAC Honors

Four members of the Central Michigan women's basketball team received various All-Mid-American Conference honors on Monday. Presley Hudson and Tinara Moore were both named to the All-MAC Second Team, Hudson and Reyna Frost each earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team, Moore was named to the All-Defensive Team, and Jewel Cotton was named the Co-Sixth Player of the Year Award.

#MAcTion

This marked the 10th consecutive season the Maroon and Gold made it to Cleveland, Ohio for the Mid-American Conference tournament. The Maroon and Gold will played for a MAC Tournament Championship Saturday, a familiar place for head coach Sue Guevara as she has led the Chippewas to the title game three out of the last five seasons, taking home a championship in 2013.

NEWS AND NOTES

How The West Was Won

The Central Michigan women's basketball team won the MAC West outright with a 78-70 victory over Eastern Michigan Saturday, while earning a first-round bye in the MAC Tournament, and a ticket to Cleveland. It is only the second MAC West title in program history, CMU also claimed the West in 2014.

Rebounds for Reyna

During MAC play freshman Reyna Frost has crashed the boards, putting her fourth in the conference in rebounds (185), 10.3 per game. The Reese, Mich. native has pulled down the most O-boards during conference play (77). Frost has pulled down double-digit rebounds 13 times this season.

Double Trouble

Sophomore Tinara Moore has recorded 18 double-doubles this season, tied for 11th most in the country. The Chippewas are 14-4 in games Moore records a double-double.

Triple Threat

Sophomore Cassie Breen has recorded a team-best 90 3-pointers on the season, which puts her tied for third all-time in single season triples made. Freshman Presley Hudson follows close behind with 82 made triples on the year, putting her fourth in a single season. The duo are the only teammates in program history to recorded at least 80 3-pointers in the same season. Niki DiGuilio holds the single-season record with 100 triples made set in 2013-14.

Building Blocks

Tinara Moore has swatted her way into the record books, with her 51 blocks, and counting, during the season. Moore's 51 blocks puts her third in a single season. Anna Skufca (2003-07) holds the single season record of 62 blocks.

Offensive Weapons

Central Michigan has featured seven different high scorers this season. Presley Hudson, Tinara Moore, Jewel Cotton, Cassie Breen, Da'Jourie Turner Reyna Frost and Jasmine Harris have all led the Chippewas at least one game in scoring.

Making History

Sophomore Tinara Moore tied the NCAA record Saturday against Akron (1/9) becoming just the second player to go 16-of-16 from the floor, the first time it's happened since 1988. Her perfect 16 buckets is tied for the most made in a perfect game. Moore finished with 35 points and 20 boards in CMU's 97-77 win over Akron.

Show Us Moore

Moore became the first player in CMU women's basketball history to finish 100 percent from the field (with at least eight attempts), and set a MAC record, surpassing a 14-for-14 performance by Ball State's Emma Jones in 1985.

Im-PRES-sive Presley

Freshman Presley Hudson has made a statement in the first season of her Chippewa career. The Wayland, Mich. native is averaging 14.0 ppg to lead the Chippewas and puts her 11th in the conference. Hudson has led the Chippewas in scoring in 10 games. Hudson is the only freshman in the conference to lead her team in scoring, and has done so the entire season.

NCAA Record

The Chippewas set a NCAA record Sunday, Nov. 15 against Oakland University scoring 45 points in the first quarter. The 45 points is the most in the ten minute span since women's basketball converted from halves to quarters this season. The next closest is 39 points in one quarter which was accomplished by Long Beach St., Robert Morris, Morehead State and Seton Hall.

New Year, New Team

The Chippewas have a new, youthful squad that features a combined 10 freshmen and sophomores. All five sophomores made at least two starts last season, the most among any MAC institution.

CMU's Roster is Home Grown

Central Michigan's roster features 13 of its 14 players who hail from the state of Michigan. The 13 student-athletes from Michigan ranks first among the state's Division I programs, followed by, Oakland (10), Michigan State (7), Eastern Michigan (5), Western Michigan (5) and Michigan (3).

CMU WOMEN EYE POSTSEASON RUN

MOUNT PLEASANT, Mich. — The stage isn't as big and the lights aren't as bright, but the Central Michigan women's basketball team is in the postseason with a chance to accomplish great things for the program.

The Chippewas will play host to Indiana-Purdue-Indianapolis in the opening round of the Women's National Invitation Tournament Thursday (7 p.m.) at McGuirk Arena.

After a heartbreaking overtime loss to Buffalo in the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship game on Saturday -- a result that ended CMU's quest for an NCAA Tournament bid -- Chippewa coach Sue Guevara made her team aware that there was still plenty to play for.

A win over the Jaguars on Thursday would give CMU its first postseason tournament victory in program history.

"I talked to our players in Cleveland (after the loss to Buffalo) and explained to them that we still have an opportunity to accomplish a first for this program," Guevara said. "We have to focus on the process of that and that is what I talked a lot about in practice."

CMU (22-10) played the IUPUI (20-10) two years ago in the first round of the WNIT in McGuirk and fell, 72-64.

"When we played them two years ago it was such a disappointing year for us going into that game," Guevara said. "I felt like there was a lack-luster performance because of that disappointment.

"I can tell you with this team, there is no disappointment whatsoever, there is a lot of excitement about playing this game."

The Jaguars place third in the Summit League at 11-5. They fell to Omaha in the quarterfinal round of the conference tournament.

IUPUI finished the season second in the Summit League in scoring defense, allowing just 60 points per contest, and held its opponents to a 39.4 field goal percentage. Offensively, the Jaguars ranked No. 2 in the league with a 42.8 field goal percentage.

"They're athletic, they're physical, they're aggressive and they just get after you defensively," said Guevara. "They love to go inside and have a couple good shooters and have a real nice inside-outside balance."

Sophomore guard Danielle Lawrence leads the Jaguars offensively, averaging 13.2 point per game. Mikale Rodgers, a 6-foot-2 junior forward, averages 12.8 and leads IUPUI on the glass with seven rebounds a game.

The Chippewas claimed the MAC West crown this season and led the MAC in scoring (74.6 point per game), rebounding (43.9), field goal percentage (.424) and free throw percentage (.746).

Freshman guard Presley Hudson leads CMU in scoring with 14 points per game. She was also the MAC leader, and ranked sixth nationally, with an .890 free throw percentage.

Sophomore Cassie Breen ranks as the league's second-best 3-point shooter with a .404 clip from behind the arc.

Forwards Tinara Moore (9.6) and Reyna Frost (9.3) rank third and fourth, respectively, in the MAC in rebounding.

CMU junior Jewel Cotton earned co-Sixth Player of the Year honors, coming off the bench to average 9.0 points and 6.2 rebounds a game.

Not many schools get a chance to play a postseason game in front of a home crowd, Guevara said, and that is a factor the Chippewas are planning to take full advantage of.

"I think if you look at the crowd that we had at (Quicken Loans Arena), it was awesome," Guevara said. "We had a great crowd, it was loud and they were into it just like we have back here in McGuirk.

"We have the Sixth Man Band and the sixth man in the stands. We feed off the excitement and appreciate the enthusiasm that our fans have and we're just really looking forward to having this place rocking Thursday night."

A win over IUPUI Thursday would set up a second-round matchup with either Northwestern or San Diego. Those two teams play Thursday in Evanston, Ill. The location of the second-round game is to be determined.

CHIPPEWA WOMEN FALL IN OT IN MAC FINAL

CLEVELAND, Ohio – Disappointing? Absolutely.

But Sue Guevara refused to allow her Central Michigan women's basketball team to feel sorry for itself after the Chippewas fell to Buffalo, 73-71, in an overtime heartbreaker Saturday in the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship game at Quicken Loans Arena.

The Chippewas, with just one senior starter, are 22-10, and will await word on a potential Women's NIT bid. Buffalo (20-13) advances to the NCAA Tournament after becoming the lowest seed (eighth) ever to win the MAC Tourney.

"I told the team, 'If you want to feel like cow manure right now, you can, go ahead,'" said Guevara, whose team was picked to finish fifth in the MAC West in the preseason poll, then went out and won the division title and earned the No. 2 seed in the tournament.

"But understand what we did this year," Guevara continued. "No one expected us to be in this room today. And we're not done playing. I'm pretty sure we're going to get a bid to the WNIT.

"On Monday when we come back into practice, I don't want to see anybody's head down, I don't want to see 'Oh, poor me.' I don't want to see that because we still get to play and that's the best thing.

"I couldn't be prouder of our team. We have sophomores and freshmen. We'll be back. We'll be back, and we'll be better for it."

Stephanie Reid banked home a jumper from near the free throw line as time expired to give the Bulls the victory and the unlikely title. Buffalo won four tournament games in six days, three of them against higher-seeded teams.

Tinara Moore scored 18 points, Da'Jourie Turner had 15, and Cassie Breen and Presley Hudson added 10 each for the Chippewas, who were vying for their first MAC Tournament championship and NCAA Tourney bid since 2013.

Moore and Turner were both named to the all-tournament team.

Joanna Smith scored 23 points to lead Buffalo, which held CMU to a 4-for-16 performance from 3-point range, one day after the Chippewas went 15-for-27 from behind the arc in an 86-71 semifinal win over Eastern Michigan.

Smith made five triples as the Bulls finished 10-for-20 from long range. Reid finished with 10 points and 12 assists.

Breen, who hit eight triples against Eastern, finished 1-for-5 from long range against the Bulls. Hudson had two 3-pointers on Saturday after hitting five against the Eagles.

"I thought that they did a really nice job of switching on to (Breen), and not giving (Hudson) a lot of room," Guevara said. "Same shots they hit yesterday, we just didn't hit today."

The game was tight all the way and included 10 lead changes and 10

We were that close, but that also just lets us know that we were meant to be here, and our next strategy is to learn from this, take it and move forward with it."

Guevara, Hudson Garner Individual MAC Honors Chippewas grab coach, freshman of the year accolades

CLEVELAND, Ohio – Central Michigan's Sue Guevara was named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year and Presley Hudson earned the Freshman of the Year Award Tuesday on the eve of the league women's basketball tournament.

It is the first time that Guevara has earned the MAC Coach of the Year Award in her nine seasons at Central Michigan.

Hudson, a 5-foot-6 freshman guard from Wayland, Mich., is CMU's leading scorer at 13.8 points per game and is the MAC's most-efficient free throw shooter, knocking down her charity tosses at an 89.5 percent rate.

She is the fourth Chippewa to be named the league's top freshman, and the first since Niki DiGuilio in 2011.

On Monday, Hudson was named to the All-MAC Second Team and the All-MAC Freshman Team. Teammate Reyna Frost finished second in the freshman-of-the-year balloting.

League coaches and sports information directors along with media covering the league voted on the awards.

"I'm very, very happy for Pres and for Reyna because of all the hard work they put in, the time they put in off the court, whether it's watching tape, working on specific parts of their game, finding their weaknesses and working to try and get better," Guevara said.

"She's just very unselfish. Our kids look to her and they believe in her, as a freshman. They are very supportive of her, give her a lot of confidence.

"Yes, Pres and Reyna are only going to get better, but they're only going to get better because of their inner drive, because of what they want to do. As a coach you can set goals and lay out aspirations, but if they don't want it, it's tough. They want to get better; they want to be coached."

The Chippewas, who are 20-9 overall, open the tournament on Wednesday against Western Michigan (17-14). Tip is scheduled for approximately 5 p.m.

The Guevara-led Chippewas won the MAC West title with a 14-4 record, earning the No. 2 seed in the MAC Tournament in what appeared to be a rebuilding season.

CMU graduated several standouts after last season, including Crystal Bradford, the Chippewas' all-time leading scorer who was drafted in the first round with the seventh pick in the WNBA Draft by the Los Angeles Sparks.

The Chippewas returned just one starter, guard Da'Jourie Turner.

"I appreciate it, I'm grateful for it," Guevara said. "I think we exceeded everyone else's expectations because we are so young. We had limited minutes coming back, limited production coming back.

"Was it a rebuilding year? Absolutely. The work ethic that this group has -- the will, the want, the determination. I've said this all along, I feel like this is the most coachable team I've ever had. It's been a lot of work and we're not done. I'm just grateful for where I am."

Guevara also credited her staff, which is led by associate head coach Heather Oesterle, who is in her sixth season at CMU, along with assistants Raina Harmon and Kristin Haynie.

"As much as our kids are in the gym, our staff is too, working them out, talking to them, giving them the confidence," Guevara said. "It takes a village. I just happen to be the mayor."

Guevara is the third CMU coach, and the first since Donita Davenport in 1985, to earn the MAC Coach of the Year Award.

In nine seasons at CMU, Guevara has led the Chippewas to at least 20 wins five times. All five of those campaigns have come in the last six years.

Her teams have captured two MAC West titles and in 2013 won the MAC Tournament to gain a berth in the NCAA Tournament. It was just the third time in school history, and the first since 1984, that CMU has appeared in the tournament.

Guevara's record at CMU is 150-133 and her career record, which includes seven years as the head coach at Michigan, is 273-215.

Quartet Of Chippewas Earn All-MAC Women's Basketball Honors Hudson, Moore, Frost and Cotton pick up accolades ahead of MAC Tournament

MOUNT PLEASANT, Mich. - Four members of the Central Michigan women's basketball team received various All-Mid-American Conference honors on Monday.

CMU's Presley Hudson and Tinara Moore were both named to the All-MAC Second Team, Hudson and Reyna Frost each earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team, Moore was named to the All-Defensive Team, and Jewel Cotton was named the Co-Sixth Player of the Year Award.

The Chippewas, 20-9, won the MAC West Division title with a 14-4 record and earned the No. 2 seed in the league tournament. CMU will play either Northern Illinois or Western Michigan on Wednesday at approximately 5 p.m. in a MAC Tournament quarterfinal game at Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland.

The league office is scheduled to release the league player, coach and freshman of the year winners on Tuesday.

Hudson, a 5-foot-6 freshman guard from Wayland, Mich., is CMU's leading scorer at 13.8 points per game and is the MAC's most-efficient free throw shooter, knocking down her charity tosses at an 89.5 percent rate.

She has made 73 3-pointers this season, which ranks second on the team, and averages a team-best 3.5 assists per game.

Moore, a 6-3 sophomore, averages 13.1 points and 9.6 rebounds per game, and she leads the MAC in field goal percentage (.575). Moore ranks third in the league in rebounding and second in blocked shots per game (1.6).

She has recorded 16 double-doubles this season.

Frost, a 6-foot freshman from Reese, averages 8.9 points and 9.5 rebounds per game. She ranks fourth in the conference in rebounding, 10th in field goal percentage (.498) and first in offensive rebounds per game (3.7).

Cotton, a 6-2 junior forward from Harper Woods, returned from a knee injury that wiped out most of her 2014-15 season and is averaging 8.7 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. She ranks second on the team with 20 blocks.

Cotton shared the award with Toledo's Kaayla McIntyre.

Head Coach
Ninth Season

Sue Guevara has rebuilt Central Michigan back to its former glory during her time with the Chippewas, leading the team to its first Mid-American Conference Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance since 1984 during the 2013 season.

Guevara followed up the MAC Tournament title with the program's first MAC West title and a 16-win conference season, the second most conference victories in program history in 2014.

During her time with the Chippewas Guevara has compiled 130 wins in the last eight seasons, including four consecutive seasons of at least 20 wins from 2011-14.

Her 130 wins at CMU are already second-most in program history, while her 60-54 victory at Miami (Oh) on January 14, 2015 marked career victory No. 250.

Guevara has guided 21 All-MAC selections, including two-time first-team selection Crystal Bradford. Bradford also became the program's first MAC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in 2014.

In 2015, Bradford was selected seventh overall in the WNBA draft by the L.A. Sparks. Her first round pick made her the highest ever selection in the MAC and first ever in program history.

Also among the honors received under Guevara's tenure are two MAC Freshman of the Year honors, three MAC Sixth Players of the Year awards and six MAC All-Freshman selections, as well as the program's second MAC Tournament MVP in Crystal Bradford.

Bradford is also the only player in program history to earn WBCA Region 4 All-American nominee honors, claiming the distinction in both 2012-13 and 2013-14.

In addition, 10 players have joined CMU's 1,000-point club under Guevara, five of whom currently rank in the program's top 10 in career scoring. In 2014 Bradford, Taylor Johnson, Niki DiGuilio and Jessica Green appeared in the 1,000-point club, making CMU just the 12th program in NCAA history to feature four 1,000-point scorers on the same roster.

Other highlights during Guevara's tenure include setting a single-game attendance record with 5,195 fans against Georgetown on Nov. 25, 2010, defeating the highest ranked team in program history, No. 12/14 Purdue on Dec. 11, 2011, an upset of No. 23 Louisville on Dec. 2, 2010, both the final win in Rose Center and the first win at McGuirk Arena, back-to-back trips to the MAC Tournament and the first title since 1984, four-straight 20-win seasons and four-straight postseason appearances.

The Chippewas faced the toughest non-conference schedule in the country in 2013-14, including

10 games against teams that played in the 2012-13 postseason and four games versus teams ranked in the top 25. CMU played No. 2 Duke at the Paradise Jam and visited No. 7 Kentucky, No. 4 Notre Dame and No. 17 Purdue during the regular season.

CMU's non-conference schedule prepared it for a Mid-American Conference season in which it started 12-0 and finished 16-2 to claim the first MAC West title in program history.

In 2012-13, the Chippewas faced the third-toughest non-conference schedule in the country, taking on likes of No. 5 Notre Dame, Purdue, Green Bay twice, St. Joseph's and South Dakota State.

The non-conference schedule prepared the Chippewas for MAC play where they started 8-0 for their best start since the 1983-84 campaign.

During the 2011-12 season, Guevara's team went on a seven-game win streak, the longest since the 1987-88, to make an appearance in the MAC Tournament championship game. CMU came within 1.5 seconds of advancing to the NCAA Tournament, but No. 2 seed Eastern Michigan scored a layup just before time expired to claim the conference title.

The 2010-11 20-win campaign marked the program's best season since 1990-91 (21-8). The 10.5-game improvement in 2008-09 (18-14) from Guevara's first season is the third-largest in MAC history.

Prior to CMU, Guevara served as an assistant coach at Auburn for three seasons under Nell Fortner, head coach of the gold medal winning 1998 World Championship and 2000 Olympic teams. The Tigers advanced to the WNIT Elite Eight in 2006-07 and sent a pair of players to the WNBA during Guevara's time there.

Guevara is a native of Saginaw, Mich. where she attended Saginaw St. Stephens High School. She earned her bachelor's degree in physical education from Saginaw Valley State University in 1982 and her master's degree in athletic administration from Ohio State in 1985.
