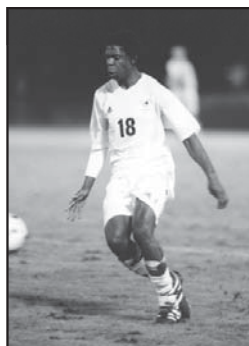


# ALL-TIME GREATS



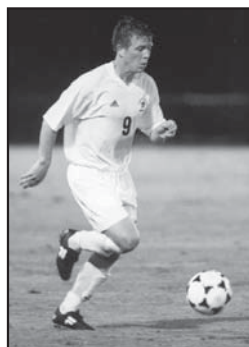
**CHRIS MALINKY**  
1997-2000

Named the Big South Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year for all sports in 1999... Two-time member of the Big South All-Academic Team... Tied a Coastal Carolina single-season record with eight shutouts in 1999... Tied for the career lead with 16 total shutouts... Tied for second in career matches started at goal with 47... Ranks third in career saves with 189... Posted the fifth-best career goals against average with 1.31 in 4,171 minutes logged between the pipes.



**JOSEPH NGWENYA**  
2000-03

*Soccer America* and *Soccer Times* National Player of the Year in 2003... Two-time NSCAA All-American and CSTV All-American... NSCAA and CoSIDA Academic All-American in 2003... Big South Male Athlete of the Year, two-time Player of the Year, three-time First Team performer, Big South Tournament MVP in 2003 and Rookie of the Year in 2000... Holds eight Coastal Carolina single-season and career records, including all scoring records... Led nation in goals scored in 2002.



**THOMAS RUTTER**  
1999-2002

NSCAA All-Region performer in 2002... One of three Coastal Carolina players to be named Big-South Rookie of the Year... All-Big South Conference First-Team member in 2000 and 2002... All-Big South Second-Team member as a freshman in 1999... Big-South All-Tournament team member in 2002...



**NEIL PAYNE**  
1992-95

1995 Big South Tournament MVP... Two-time NSCAA All-Regional selection... Two-time Big South First Team honoree... Netted 15 goals and tallied 13 assists for 43 points in 1995, all three top-10 rankings in a Coastal Carolina single-season... Big South Second Team selection in 2003... Ranks third in career points (123), fourth in goals (46) and fourth in assists (31)... Started all 74 career games at Coastal Carolina.



**ERIC SCHMITT**  
1989-93

Named the Big South Player of the Year in 1992... Selected to the Big South All-Tournament team in 1989... Scored 20 goals in 1992 a then-Coastal Carolina single-season record... Totaled 46 points in 1992 also a then-single-season record... Ranks in a tie for second on the Chanticleer career goals list with 47... Ranks fifth in career points with 112... Helped Coastal Carolina reach its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992... Led the Chants to back-to-back Big South Tournament titles 1989 and 1990.



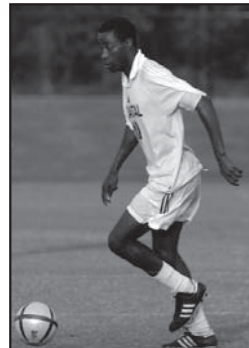
**DAVID SKULASON**  
1985-89

One of two players in Chanticleer history to be named to the Big South All-Tournament team all four seasons... Two-time Big South First Team honoree... Ranks second on the Coastal Carolina career assists list with 42, sixth in points with 102 and tied for 10th in goals with 30... Started all 80 career games at Coastal Carolina... Dished out 15 assists in 1989, tied for fourth in a single-season... Dished out three assists against Baptist (Charleston Southern), tied for the second most in a single-game



**SIGURDUR SVEINBJORNSSON**  
1984-87

Four-time Big South All-Tournament Team selection... Three-time All-Big South First Team member... Two-time NSCAA All-Region selection... Big South Tournament MVP in 1987... Coastal Carolina career leader in assists (56) games played (86) and games started (56)... Ranks second in career points with 130 and sixth in goals with 37... Hold the single-game record with four assists against Augusta (Oct. 29, 1986).

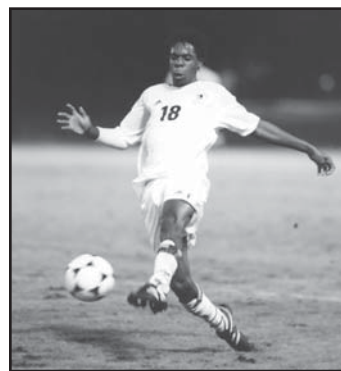

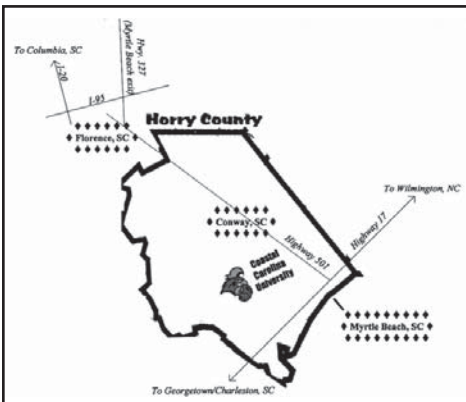

### DIRECTIONS TO COASTAL CAROLINA UNIVERSITY



#### FROM I-95

From the South, take Highway 327 exit to SC Hwy. 76/301. Turn left onto Hwy. 76/301. This will become Hwy. 576 and then Hwy. 501. After passing through Conway, turn right at the second stop light (approx. 2 miles) into the entrance of Coastal Carolina University. You are now on College Road. Kimbel Arena (basketball/volleyball), Charles L. Watson Baseball Stadium, and the Football/Soccer Stadium are visible on the right from College Road. To get to the Softball Field or the Track & Field Complex, turn right onto Chanticleer Drive after passing Kimbel Arena and before getting to the Baseball Stadium.

From the North, take the "South of the Border" exit (IMPOSSIBLE to miss). Follow signs to Myrtle Beach and this will lead you to Highway 501. Then follow the directions above.

#### FROM HIGHWAY 17

Follow Highway 17 Bypass to Highway 501 (Conway exit). At this point, you are approx. eight miles from campus. You will pass the stoplight at Conway Hospital and then pass a Food Lion shopping center (on left). Just after passing Horry-Georgetown Technical College (on left), take the next left into the entrance of Coastal Carolina University. See directions above to find athletic facilities.
