GAMEDAY STORYLINES

- Coastal and Texas State are meeting for the fifth time on Saturday. The series was evened at 2-2 after Texas State won the second regular season game this year in San Marcos, 78-69, on Feb. 1.
- On Tuesday, Coastal won its first conference tournament game since 2013-14, when it defeated Charleston Southern in the first round of the Big South Conference Championship.
- Coastal is attempting to win multiple conference tournament games for the first time since the 2000-01 season, when it reached the championship game in the Big South.
- Tuesday's win over Georgia State featured five Chanticleers scoring in double figures. It was third time that happened for Coastal this season, the previous two times occurring versus UTA (Dec. 29) and at Troy (Jan. 20).
- Texas State enters Thursday's quarterfinal having won nine of its last 10 games, including the last five consecutively.
- The Bobcats have averaged 13 triples in the two games against this season. Toshual Leavitt has averaged eight 3-pointers herself against the Chants this season. Taeler Deer, the Sun Belt Player of the Year, has been limited to 9 ppg against Coastal this year, including just three points in the first meeting on Dec. 31.

UP NEXT

- The winner of Tuesday's first-round game will advance to face second-seeded Texas State on Thursday at 5 p.m.

COASTAL'S ALL-SUN BELT MEMBERS

- Jas Adams and DJ Williams were named first and second team All-Sun Belt, respectively.
- Adams is the Sun Belt's leading scorer while Williams currently ranks fifth in points per game.
- Adams has scored in double figures in all but three games this season, including a stretch of 10 straight games from Dec. 4-Jan. 13. Williams has reached that mark in all but six games.
- The two have combined to score over 30 points as a pair in 22 of Coastal's 30 games this year.

ADAMS BACK ON TOP

- A 40-point performance against Troy on Feb. 15 returned Jas Adams to the top of the Sun Belt scoring race. She led the league in scoring from Dec. 4-Jan. 13 before dropping as low as third place.
- Adams has scored in double figures in her last 10 games, including 20 or more points in six of those.
- She is averaging 22.8 ppg in her last eight games.

ADAMS SCORES 1,000

- Jas Adams became the 15th Coastal women's basketball player to score 1,000 career points. The senior reached the milestone while scoring 24 points at UTA on Feb. 3.
- Adams became Coastal's 11th all-time scorer during Coastal's win over Georgia State in the first round of the Sun Belt Championship. She has 1,184 career points to date, and sits behind the 1,258 career points of Kim Lewis (1990-93).
- At Little Rock on Feb. 22, Adams became the ninth player in Coastal history to record a 500-point scoring season.

WILLIAMS' COMPLETE GAME

- DJ Williams ranks in the top 10 in the Sun Belt in five categories on both sides of the ball.
- In addition to being fifth in scoring, Williams ranks second in assists, fourth in steals, sixth in rebounds and 10th in minutes.
- Williams set a career high with 29 points at South Alabama on Jan. 18, and matched that effort at Texas State on Feb. 2.

HAMILTON DOUBLES HER DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Naheria Hamilton collected four double-doubles in a span of six games from Jan. 25 - Feb. 15, more than doubling her season total to seven.
- Hamilton collected her eighth double-double at Arkansas State on Feb. 24, and ninth against Georgia State in the first round of the 2018 Sun Belt Championship.
- The sophomore center is now sixth in the Sun Belt in rebounding averaging just fewer than eight rpg.
- Hamilton is also third in the conference in blocks per game, and has recorded a career high of five rejections on three occasions this season.

BLANDING'S CAREER HIGH

- Junior point guard Breeilyn Blanding scored a career high 21 points in Coastal's win over UTA on Dec. 31. She later matched that with 21 points in Coastal's win at Troy on Jan. 20.
- It was her first game scoring 20 or more points. Her previous high was nine points, which she reached in three games this season.
- The Chants are 6-2 this season when Blanding scores nine or more points.

SECOND HALF CHANTS

- Since Coastal began its Sun Belt schedule, the Chants are averaging over 36 points in the second half compared to 30 points in the first half of games.
- Coastal has scored more second-half points in 15 of its 18 conference games.
- The Chants are particularly strong in the third quarter, averaging 18 points coming out of the halftime break.



Williams is the sixth head coach in the 43-year history of Coastal Carolina women's basketball.

ADAMS NAMED SUN BELT PLAYER OF THE WEEK (x3)

- Jas Adams was named Sun Belt Player of the Week on Dec. 12, Jan. 2 and Feb. 19.
- She is the first to receive the award since Coastal moved to Sun Belt in 2016, and fourth player in program history to be named Player of the Week three times in a season.
- The first honor saw Adams average 22.5 points in wins over Fort Wayne and NC Central. She shot 55 percent from the field that week, was 8-13 from 3-point range and a perfect 7-7 at the free-throw line.
- The second time, Adams averaged 20.3 points and 7.3 rebounds as Coastal went 3-1 with wins against Wofford, UTA and Texas State, and a loss to #23 Syracuse. She recorded her first double-double (17 pts, 12 reb) of the season against Wofford, and scored 22 and 24 points versus UTA and Texas State, respectively, to lead Coastal to a 2-0 conference start.
- The third time, Adams averaged 29.5 points and 9.5 rebounds in wins over Troy and South Alabama. That included her 40-point performance against the Trojans.

CAMP AWARDED LINDA P. HOLLANDSWORTH SCHOLARSHIP

- On Jan. 10, Janae Camp was awarded the Linda P. Hollandsworth Scholarship. The recently contributed scholarship is to be awarded annually to a CCU women's basketball player that is in good academic standing, and strives for greatness both on the court and in the classroom.
- Camp, a freshman, surpassed a 3.0 GPA in her first semester despite having moderate to severe dyslexia, which is genetic in her family.
- Because of her dyslexia, Camp was homeschooled and played basketball at TPLS Academy in Richmond, Va.
- Camp is one of 18 children in her family, including part of one of two sets of twins. Janae's twin, Janeen, was also homeschooled because of her dyslexia, and played alongside Janae at TPLS.

WINNERS IN THE CLASSROOM

- Eight of the 12 team members finished the 2017 fall semester with a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- Isiuwa Oghagbon made the President's list with a perfect 4.0 GPA, while Mery Visone, Kaylin West and Jamie Williams made Dean's list with a 3.5 GPA or higher.
- Senior Jas Adams graduated cum laude in December with a BS in Management, and was named CoSIDA Academic All-Region 4.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Coastal plays 17 regular season games at the HTC Center during the 2017-18 season, tying the women's record for most regular season games played in the arena. The Chants were also at home for 17 regular season games during the 2014-15 season.
- Coastal did not play its first true road game of the season until it traveled to ULM on Jan. 4.
- The Chants' non-conference schedule included three neutral-site games, two in the San Juan Shootout (Daytona Beach, Fla.) and one in the Carolinas Challenge (Myrtle Beach Convention Center).

AT THE HTC CENTER

- Coastal is 57-36 overall playing inside the HTC Center since the building opened for the 2012-13 season.
- The Chants won 10 games in each of the first three seasons in which the arena was open, followed by eight wins in 2015-16 and seven wins in 2016-17.

SEASON OUTLOOK

- The 2017-18 Chants are the youngest team under head coach Jaida Williams, who is in her fifth season leading Coastal.
- This season's team features only five returners, including one returning starter in sophomore center Naheria Hamilton. Jas Adams is the team's only senior.
- The rest of the roster is comprised of seven newcomers, all of whom are freshmen.
- During Williams' tenure, the previous high in freshmen on a single team was six (2015-16) while the previous low in seniors was two (2014-15).

Coastal Downs GSU, Advances to Sun Belt Quarterfinals

NEW ORLEANS, La. - The seventh-seeded Coastal Carolina women's basketball team ran away with a 74-55 win over No. 10 Georgia State in Tuesday's first round of the 2018 Sun Belt Women's Basketball Championship from Lakefront Arena.

Coastal (17-13) advances to Thursday's quarterfinal round, where it will face No. 2 Texas State (21-8) at 5 p.m. (CT). Georgia State ends its season with an 8-22 overall record.

Tuesday's game was similar to the first time these teams met this season on Jan. 13. In the first matchup, Coastal claimed a double-digit lead at halftime after outscoring GSU 18-5 in the second quarter. This time around, the Chants outscored the Panthers 22-6 in the second quarter to lead by 15 points at the break. Coastal held onto its double-figure lead for the remainder of regulation as it closed out the win.

Five Chants scored in double figures in the winning effort, with Jas Adams' 16 points leading the way. Her team-leading performance moved her into 11th place among Coastal's all-time career scorers with 1,184 points.

Kaylin West scored 15 points, followed by Breelyn Blanding with 13. Janae Camp had a career night with 11 points, and Naheria Hamilton collected her ninth double-double of the season with 10 points and a game-high 15 rebounds.

Coastal closed the game shooting 46 percent from the field and 80 percent from the free-throw line. The Chants also held a 37-30 advantage in rebounds, and further dominated down low by outscoring the Panthers 34-20 in the paint.

GSU's Kierra Henry led the game with 18 points, including 11 in the first quarter. Janessa Murphy added 15 points, and K.K. Williams rounded out the Panthers' double-digit scorers with 13 points.

A tightly-contested first quarter saw Coastal and Georgia State tied three times as the two sides fought to gain an advantage. Henry opened the game hot for the Panthers, scoring 11 points on 4-of-5 from the field with a trio of 3-pointers. Henry only received four points from her teammates, however, allowing Coastal to keep pace. The Chants were buoyed by a stretch of eight unanswered points in the opening frame, with Janae Camp and Breelyn Blanding combining for six of those eight points.

Coastal began the second quarter trailing by one point, but quickly overtook the lead as Adams started to heat up. The senior guard drained a pair of 3's early in the quarter, and scored eight points as part of a 13-4 Coastal run over the frame's first four minutes. West was the Chants' leading scorer in the quarter with 10 points, shooting 4-of-6 from the field with a pair of 3-pointers. Coastal limited GSU to shooting 16 percent from the field in the second, and held the Panthers scoreless for a stretch of six minutes.

The Chants continued to pour it on in the third quarter as they scored a game-high 28 points. Coastal opened the quarter on a 15-4 run over the first five minutes, and later scored seven straight points to take a 30-point lead, its largest of the game.

GSU outscored Coastal in the final quarter, but could not manage to trim the margin lower than 16 points.

Coastal's Second Half Rally at Texas State Falls Short

CONWAY, S.C. --DJ Williams tied her career scoring high of 29 points while collecting her fourth double-double of the season, and Jas Adams added an additional 23 points, but it was not enough as Texas State held off a surging Coastal Carolina team, 78-69, Thursday night at the Strahan Center.

Coastal (11-11, 5-6 SBC) scored 47 points in the second half in its attempt to erase the 24-point deficit it found itself in during the first half. The Chants made it a two-possession game with six minutes remaining, but were outscored by three points for the rest of regulation as the Bobcats fought to stay in front.

Texas State (15-7, 8-3 SBC), which made 14 3-pointers the last time these teams met in December, sunk 12 shots from beyond the arc as it held a double digit lead over Coastal for the majority of the contest. The Bobcats shot 55 percent from the field for the game, including 66 percent in both the first and third quarters.

Williams out-dueled the Sun Belt's leading scorer, Toshua Leavitt, who had 27 points for Texas State. CCU's sophomore guard tied for the team lead in rebounds with 10, and had team highs with four steals and three assists.

Naheria Hamilton also had 10 rebounds, and scored 11 points for her fifth double-double of the season. Adams scored 20 of her 23 points in the second half as the Chants tried to rally.

Leavitt made half of the Bobcats' 3-pointers and was 10-of-15 from the field overall. Ti'Aria Pitts scored 16 points while finishing 4-of-5 from beyond the arc, and Taeler Deer

added 15 points and six assists.

The first quarter saw Texas State jump out to a 26-11 lead as it shot over 66 percent to open the game. Five of the Bobcats' 10 baskets in the first quarter were from 3-point range, with Ti'Aria Pitts sinking all three of her long-range attempts to lead the way. Williams accounted for six of the Chants' 11 first-quarter points.

Williams then scored all 11 of Coastal's points in the second quarter, bringing her halftime total to 17 points and seven rebounds. The second frame began with Williams scoring six unanswered points in the first two minutes, and ended with her scoring five unanswered in the final three minutes. The time in between included Texas State scoring 15 straight, including three more triples to bring its halftime total to eight 3-pointers.

Trailing 41-22 coming out of halftime, Coastal attempted to mount a second-half comeback. The Chants shot 58 percent from the field in the third quarter and controlled the first six minutes of the frame, outscoring the Bobcats 15-6 to cut the margin to 10 points at the media timeout. Coastal was unable to lower it to single digits, however, as Texas State scored six unanswered points out of the break and outscored the Chants 15-10 over the final four minutes.

Coastal made it a two-possession game after starting the fourth quarter on a 10-2 run, with Williams accounting for six of those points. Leavitt ended the streak with a 3-pointer, and hit her sixth of the game about a minute later. Deer made the Bobcats' final 3-pointer of the game with a minute-and-a-half remaining, and hit a pair of free throws in the final minute to close the scoring.
