Registration for Learn to skate- Basic Skills

Children (ages 4 and up) and Adults

Lessons will occur on the following **Wednesday** nights
from 6:10-7:30 pm:

May 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th
27th **June** 6th, 13th, 20th,

The price for 8 lessons is \$85 / \$75 per additional family member
(Faculty and Staff must pay full price)

- Rental skates are available for \$4 per pair of skates for each individual session.
- You will not receive a confirmation. Please arrive 20 minutes early for the first lesson to allow adequate time for check-in. At this time, you will receive nametags and all necessary lesson information.
- During their lesson time, skaters are taught and evaluated on USFSA Mandated "Basic skills".
- Skaters may advance from one level to the next once they can demonstrate all of the skills required for each specific level.
- Any student that has never participated in a Learn to Skate program, must start in Basic 1.
- In order to participate in the Learn to Skate program, skaters must be willing to try to hold themselves up on the ice without parental assistance.
- Groups are determined by age and skill level.
- Only those who pay for lessons are allowed to skate on the ice, regardless of whether or not they attend a lesson.

- Space is limited and is on a first come first served basis. Please register as early as possible to guarantee a spot in a class. Lessons occur every 20 minutes and are ongoing.
- Not all lessons begin when the session starts. In some instances skaters will be able to practice first, followed by a lesson.
- Nametags must be worn on the ice at all times.
- All arena rules apply for skating lessons. Skaters violating these rules may be subject to dismissal from the program without refund.
- Make up lessons are not available if a lesson is missed.
- Lessons will not be cancelled due to inclement weather unless the State of Connecticut/UConn is shut down.
