

Post Graduate Athletic Training Residency Application

The University of Connecticut is currently accepting applications for the Athletic Training Fellowship positions.

The Athletic Training Residency will provide a clinically intensive educational opportunity to help prepare young professionals for a career in athletic training. Candidates will have a dedicated team(s) assignment which will provide mentored experience in evidence-based collaborative care of Division I varsity student-athletes. Additional educational opportunities will be provided through varied disciplines within Sports Medicine, including, but not limited to, primary care, orthopedics, cardiology, neurology, and mental health.

Responsibilities: Work as an ATC under the supervision of staff athletic trainers in providing care and coverage to Division I student-athletes in the Division of Athletics. Assist in the supervision and instruction of student athletic trainers.

Qualifications: NATABOC certified, state licensure in CT or eligible.

Preferred Qualifications: Master's degree, independent athletic training experience.

Date of Service: The starting date is June 1st. This is a 12-month position. Following administrative review, the position may be renewed for a 2nd year.

Benefits: The annual stipend is approximately \$26,000. In accordance with the Affordable Care Act, your temporary appointment may afford you the opportunity to purchase optional State employee health insurance at group rates.

Application Procedure: Applicants must submit a cover letter, resume and at least three (3) reference letters to Search Committee: jobsinathletics@uconn.edu by January 30th (subject line should read Athletic Trainer Residency). Screening of applicants will begin immediately. Employment is contingent upon the successful completion of a pre-employment criminal background check.

Applications will **not** be accepted electronically through the NATA website. Applications will be reviewed as they are received and the search may move forward prior to the January deadline.
