**UCONN AS THE NO. 1 TEAM:** UConn has been in the No. 1 spot in the national rankings nine times and 29 weeks in school history. The Huskies have played 50 games in their history as the No. 1 team in the nation (29 total weeks), compiling a 41-9 record in those contests. UConn was the top-ranked team for:

1994-95 -- 2 games (1-1, 1 week)  
 1998-99-- 17 games (16-1, 10 weeks)  
 1999-00-- 2 games (1-1, 1 week)  
 2003-04-- 13 games (11-2, 3 wks and 5 weeks)  
 2005-06-- 9 games (7-2, 4 weeks and 1 week)  
 2008-09-- 7 games (5-2, 3 weeks and 1 week)

UConn is 21-3 at home as No. 1 (11-1 in Gampel, 10-2 in HCC), 17-3 on the road as the top-ranked team and 3-3 on a neutral court (2-3 in MSG, 1-0 at the United Center in Chicago).

**DUAL NO. 1's:** The Husky men and women have been ranked No. 1 at the same time a total of six different times/seasons (twice in 2008-09) and for 17 total weeks. Prior to 2008-09, in each of the previous four seasons (13 total weeks) that UConn accomplished this feat, one or both of the teams went on to capture the national championship. In 1995, both teams were top-ranked for one week, February 13, 1995, and the women captured the 1995 title. In 1998-99, the teams spent six weeks together at the top spot and the men were crowned national champs. In 1999-00, the teams spent one week together at No. 1 and the women won the title. In 2003-04, both teams started the season ranked No. 1 and were together at the top of the rankings for five weeks, going on to become the only school in NCAA history to capture a men's and women's title in the same season.
