

TITANS CHEER SQUAD AND MASCOT FAQ

Who is eligible?

Cheer: CSUF currently has an all-girl cheerleading squad, but we are open to men as well. We are looking for charismatic individuals with strong leadership abilities, and a background in cheerleading, dance or gymnastics, or anyone who is interested in supporting Titans Athletics. Current CSUF students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, and must be enrolled full-time (12 units).

Mascot/Flag: CSUF currently has a team of two people playing the role of "Tuffy", but we are open to a larger team of mascots/flag carriers to accommodate the numerous appearance requests that we receive. We are looking for charismatic, energetic men and women with a background in mascot performance. Current CSUF students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, and must be enrolled full-time (12 units).

When do you perform?

The cheer squad, mascot and flag carrier currently perform at all men's and women's home basketball games, as well as other campus and community events throughout the year.

Do you compete?

The Titans Cheer squad is not a competition squad. Our focus is promoting Titan Pride, and supporting Titans Athletics.

What is the time commitment?

Some practices will be held in late summer to prepare for summer camp. During the school year, practices are held twice per week (currently 7:00-10:00 PM, subject to change). Cheerleaders are required to participate in a strength training or other workout class each semester. Additional workouts and open gym time on your own are expected. Games and appearances 1-3 times per week, August through April. Cheerleaders and mascot may also be asked to participate in fundraisers throughout the year.

Can freshmen tryout?

Yes, freshmen are welcome to tryout, provided they have been accepted to the University and show proof of registration for New Student Orientation. Incoming freshmen must also have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Is tumbling required for the Cheer Squad?

Tumbling is not required, but strongly encouraged (at least a standing backhandspring). Applicants will be given bonus points at tryouts for demonstrated tumbling ability.

When are tryouts?

Tryouts will be held in the spring each year. Please check back for dates and time.
