Three-time All-Valle Vista League first teamer (2006, 2007, 008)... 2008 Co-Valle Vista League MVP, First-Team All-CIF. Hit. 463 with 4 HR and 32 RBI at the plate and was 7-4 with a 2.01 ERA on the mound... Is the younger brother of former Titan first baseman, Brett Pill. Drafted in the 38th round by the Rockies.

Nick Ramirez (Fr., LHP/1B, Katella HS)

Three-time All-Empire League first teamer...2008 Empire League MVP, All-CIF, All-State, All-American for the Knights.

Kyle Witten (Jr., RHP, Bakersfield, Calif., Bakersfield College)
