

GAME-WINNING SHOTS

At the Buzzer

(back to the 1982-83 Season)

On Feb. 24, 2010, in Mott Gym, guard Jacques Streeter took the ball the length of the floor and hit a leaping 15-foot bank shot at the buzzer for a 70-68 win over Cal Poly. (It should have been ruled a 3-pointer as video replays showed he took off from behind the line.)

On March 16, 2005, at Gill Coliseum, Ralph Holmes hit a fall-away jumper from the elbow at the buzzer for an 85-83 overtime win over Oregon State in the opening round of the post-season NIT.

On March 5, 2005, in Titan Gym, Jamaal Brown tipped in an errant Ralph Holmes shot at the buzzer for a 72-70 win over Cal State Northridge.

On Dec. 5, 1995, in the San Diego Sports Arena, Brian Thomas banked in a 35-footer at the overtime buzzer for an 85-83 win over San Diego State.

On Dec. 29, 1990, in Titan Gym, Joe Small rebounded his own miss and hit a jumper from the top of the key for a 62-60 win over Colorado State.

On Jan. 13, 1990, in Titan Gym, after a Pacific turnover, Wayne Williams hit a 32-footer at the buzzer for a 76-73 win over Pacific.

On Feb. 9, 1989, in sold out Titan Gym, guard Wayne Williams rebounded a missed free throw, drove the other way and pulled up for a 3-point basket at the overtime buzzer for a 93-92 win over UNLV. Derek Jones had hit the only 3-pointer of his career after chasing down an offensive rebound into the corner, turning around and hitting a three as the regulation buzzer sounded and he fell into the team bench.

On March 8, 1985, in The Forum, Kevin Henderson rebounded his own miss and made a 15-foot jump shot at the buzzer for a 56-54 win over Fresno State in the semifinals of the PCAA Tournament.

On Feb. 4, 1985, in Titan Gym, Kerry Boagni's desperate tip-in of a Tony Neal miss kissed off the glass and through the net at the buzzer for a 52-51 win over Fresno State.

In the Final Seconds

(back to the 1982-83 Season)

On Jan. 26, 2012, in the Matadome, Kwame Vaughn made a driving layup with 3 seconds to play for a 70-68 win over Cal State Northridge.

On Feb. 13, 2010, in the Matadome, Cal State Northridge led, 112-109, with 4 seconds remaining in the third overtime. Gerard Anderson made the first of two free throws and then purposely missed the second. Guard Eric Williams grabbed the long rebound and made a layup to tie the game as he was fouled. He then made the ensuing free throw for a 113-112 win. It was the highest combined scoring game in Titan history.

On Jan. 29, 2009, in the sold out Walter Pyramid, guard Josh Akognon hit a fall-away jumper with 3.9 seconds left for a 61-60 win over Long Beach State.

On Jan. 20, 2007, in the Bren Center, Frank Robinson made a pull-up 3-pointer from the left wing with 1 second remaining for a 71-68 win at UC Irvine.

On Nov. 24, 2006, in the Cajundome, Bobby Brown drove the length of the floor and made a bank shot with 3.5 seconds left for a 91-89 overtime win over Louisiana-Lafayette.

On Dec. 10, 2004, at Eastern Washington, Jermaine Harper hit a 3-pointer with 4 seconds left in overtime for a 70-68 win.

On Jan. 8, 2003, in Titan Gym, Ralph Holmes drove the length of the court and made a bank shot and free throw with 0.00.3 on the clock in overtime for a 66-65 win over UC Irvine, which had erased a 10-point lead in the final 1:19 of regulation.

On Jan. 20, 2000, in Titan Gym, Kenroy Jarrett drove the length of the court and hit a high-arching jump shot with 0:00.1 on the clock for a 54-52 win over Boise State.

On Jan. 10, 1998, in Denton, Texas, Ike Harmon tipped in a missed shot by Mark Richardson with 2 seconds to play for a 72-70 win over North Texas.

On Jan. 26, 1995, in Titan Gym, Winston Peterson made a tie-breaking free throw with 3 seconds remaining for a 62-61 win over UC Santa Barbara.

On Mar. 6, 1993, in Titan Gym, Aaron Sunderland picked up a loose ball and sank a foul-line jumper with 2 seconds to play for an 84-83 win over UNLV.

On Jan. 16, 1993, in the Bren Center, Don Leary made a falling-down follow shot with about 3 seconds to play for a 61-59 win over UC Irvine.

On Jan. 25, 1992, in Titan Gym, Aaron Sunderland dribbled most of the length of the floor and hit a 10-foot jumper with 3 seconds left in overtime for a 78-77 win over Long Beach State.

On Feb. 18, 1989, in the Civic Auditorium, John Sykes grabbed a Cedric Ceballos miss and executed a 3-point play with 1 second to play in overtime with a layup with his back to the basket and a free throw for a 70-69 win over San Jose State.

On Dec. 9, 1988, in the USD Sports Center, Derek Jones hit a 12-foot baseline jumper with 2 seconds to play for a 68-66 win over University of San Diego.

On March 3, 1988, in Titan Gym, Richard Morton sank two free throws with 1 second to play for a 61-59 win over New Mexico State.

On Dec. 29, 1984, in Lawler Arena, Kerry Boagni made a pair of free throws with 5 seconds to play in overtime for a 66-64 win over Colorado State.
