Speaker Biographies

Gary Kubiak

In three seasons as head coach, Gary Kubiak has led the Texans to unmatched levels in franchise history. In his first year he tripled the team's win total. A season later, Houston had the best record in franchise history, finishing 8-8, and last season equaled that mark. All signs point to success in 2009 for Kubiak and his team. The former Denver Bronco player and assistant coach has two sons playing at Colorado State.

Blaise Winter

An 11-year NFL veteran, Blaise Winter is now regarded as one of the nation's foremost inspirational and motivational speakers. Winter's message is to teach people to believe in themselves, overcome obstacles, and be relentless in the pursuit of their dreams. Winter played collegiately at Syracuse then spent 11 seasons with the Colts, Packers, and Chargers, and was a member of Green Bay's most recent world championship team.

Steve Bradley

After more than two decades as a top-flight assistant coach, Steve Bradley in his first season made as head coach made an impression at Poudre High. Bradley, who has been on the staff at Poudre more than 20 years, guided the Impalas to the Class 5A semifinals in 2008, where the team lost to eventual state champion Mullen. Bradley has long been regarded as a passionate teacher and coach.

John Ivlow

Former CSU runningback John Ivlow is now the highly-respected head coach at Bolingbrook (Ill.) High School. Ivlow played at CSU from 1991-92, where he was a two-year starter and one of the conference's top runningbacks. Following his CSU career, he played in the NFL three seasons, and was a member of the Denver Broncos 1998 Super Bowl championship team. Since 2002, he has been the head coach at Bolingbrook, earning local and regional.
