Next on the tee

The Colorado State men's golf team returns to the NCAA regionals for the sixth consecutive season and the 12th time in the last 13 seasons overall. Colorado State was selected as the No. 11 seed in the 14-team regional hosted by Western Kentucky at The Club at Olde Stone in Bowling Green, Ky. Tee times will begin at 8 a.m. CT each day, with 18 holes scheduled Thursday-Saturday. Teams and individuals are re-paired according to score prior to the second and third rounds.

The field

The regional, one of six around the country, features 14 teams and five individuals vying for a spot in the NCAA Championship Tournament. Colorado State is seeded 11th in the region. Also competing in Bowling Green, Ky., are: No. 1-seeded UCLA, Arkansas (2), Texas A&M (3), Clemson (4), North Texas (5), Chattanooga (6), Memphis (7), Virginia Tech (8), Northwestern (9), Iowa State (10), Jacksonville State (12), Pennsylvania (13) and Alabama State (14). The five individuals are: Jace Long (Missouri), Justin Dorward (Louisville), Derek Fribbs (Colorado), Emilio Cuartero (Missouri) and Anthony Bradley (Austin Peay).

The five low teams and the low individual not on those teams will advance to the finals.

The course

The regional will be played at The Club at Olde Stone, a Par-72 course spanning 7,248 yards. The site was also host to a regional tournament in 2009.

Rams Lineup

Senior Zahkai Brown, Junior Kirby Pettitt, Senior Michael Wuertz, Freshman Cameron Harrell and Sophomore Parker Edens will be swinging for Head Coach Jamie Bermel.

The Rams are coming off of a fifth-place finish at the Mountain West Championship where Brown and Pettitt earned ties for second and fifth, respectively.

ERIE, Colo.- The CSU men's golf team finished the Mark Simpson Invitational in sixth place, with senior Zahkai Brown pacing the Rams and capturing his first top-10 finish of the 2011-12 season. Brown shot a three-round total of 5-under 213 (67-74-72) to conclude the season's first tournament in a tie for ninth place. Kirby Pettitt and Mike Sorenson finished tied in 24th place with identical scores of 218 (+2). Cameron Harrell, a true freshman, finished his first tournament as a Ram in a tie for 50th place. COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo.- The CSU men's golf team carded a team score of 857 to clinch the team's first top-5 finish of the young season. Zahkai Brown led the Rams with a three-round total of 210 (-6) finishing in a tie for 3rd. Kirby Pettitt and Mike Wuertz finished tied for 15th and tied for 21st, respectively. Cameron Harrell (73-70-74--217) finished tied for 26th at 1-over par and Mike Sorenson (72-74-78--224) tied for 56th at 8-over.
