Tennis preview: Colorado State travels to Santa Barbara for Gaucha Classic

Rams face 6 other teams in second tournament of season

FORT COLLINS, Colo. -- The Colorado State women's tennis team will travel to Santa Barbara this weekend to take part in the second annual Gaucha Classic hosted by UC Santa Barbara. The tournament will be held Friday-Sunday.

The Gaucha Classic will be held at three locations in Santa Barbara, Calif., UCSB's Robertson Gymnasium Courts, Recreation Center Courts and Harder Stadium Courts. In addition to CSU, UCSB will also host players from Wyoming, Cal Poly, Northern Arizona, Loyola Marymount and Cal State Northridge.

The tournament format will consist of three singles brackets and three doubles brackets. Each player will take part in four singles matches and three doubles matches during the three-day event.

The Rams go into this weekend's tournament with two players on the roster undefeated. Tori Arneson and Natalie Heffron swept Northern Colorado in singles at the Rams' first tournament of the season, the CSU Invitational.

The Rams will take the opportunity this weekend to play tough opponents in order to prepare them for regionals the following weekend.

"This weekend is going to give us a chance to play some really tough competition and also play teams we have never played before," said Head Coach Jon Messick. "I am hoping this will allow us to get where we need to be next weekend at regionals."

Scoring in Collegiate Tennis
