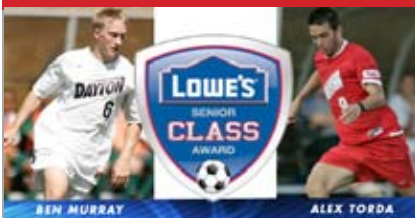

### MURRAY AND TORDA ARE 'CLASSY'

University of Dayton men's soccer players Ben Murray and Alex Torda have been selected as candidates for the 2009 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. They are included on a list of 30 of the best men's soccer student-athletes in the country. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. Dayton was one of only two schools to have two student-athletes named to the 2009 Men's Soccer Senior CLASS Award List.

### FLYERS' SIX-GAME WIN-STREAK ON THE LINE AT BAUJAN

Today's match between Dayton and Saint Louis is a battle against two squads that are 5-1 in Atlantic 10 play. The top six teams advance to the Atlantic 10 Championship in Kingston, R.I. Nov. 12-15. The Billikens are No. 3 and the Flyers are No. 5. in the NSCAA Mid-Atlantic Regional Rankings.

### SERIES INFORMATION

SLU has dominated the series against UD 11-1-1, however the Flyers notched their first-ever win over the Billikens last season. Jack Pearson scored the lone goal in the contest.

### FLYER NOTES

- Dayton is coming off a 3-0 win over No. 11 Charlotte, marking the highest ranked Division I team a Dennis Currier-coached squad has ever beaten.
- UD celebrated 11 seniors prior to the match. Seniors contributed in all three goals; Alex Torda, Isaac Kissi and Peter Chilemena scored them, while Ryan Handbury had two assists and Sonny Renner dished one assist.
- The Flyers are 10-4-1, including 6-1-0 at Baujan Field this season.
- UD has allowed just two goals against A-10 opponents this season, and has outscored them 12-2 after six games.
- The Flyers are ranked 20th in scoring offense (1.86 goals per game) in the latest NCAA Men's Soccer National Ranking Summary. UD is ranked 34th in the nation in shutout percentage (.43).
- Since 1992 the Flyers have excelled at Baujan Field with a 105-35-11 record (.732). Last season UD went 9-0-0 at home.
- The Flyers are 25-0-1 when scoring three or more goals in Coach Dennis Currier's tenure, including 7-0-1 in eight games during 2008, and five times this season (5-0).
- This is the 53rd season of Dayton Flyers men's soccer. UD showcases an all-time record of 408-355-62 (.530). The Flyers have had a winning record in 11 of the last 13 seasons.
- Senior Isaac Kissi leads the Flyers with 20 points. His 2.92 shots per game are ninth in the Atlantic 10. He is tied for third in the conference for goals scored (8).
- For the second consecutive season, University of Dayton men's soccer players Alex Torda and Tommy Watkins were named to the CoSIDA ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District 4 First Team, it was announced Friday, Oct. 30.

### BILLKEN NOTES

- Saint Louis is 10-5-0 overall and 5-1-0 in the Atlantic 10. The Billikens are 1-2-0 on the road this season.
- SLU has won its last three games, Friday night against Xavier (2-1), a 4-1 win over Fordham, currently first on the A-10 leader board, and La Salle (1-0). The Billikens' only loss in A-10 play was to Charlotte (2-1) on Oct. 17.
- Sophomore Mike Roach leads Saint Louis with seven goals, despite only playing nine games.
- Freshman Alex Sweetin leads the Billikens with five assists.
- Senior Ross Kaufman (901:27) sees most of the minutes in goal for SLU, but freshman Mark Pais also contributes quality minutes (465:25). Kaufman has 33 saves, a 7-3-0 record, three shutouts and a 1.22 GAA. Pais has 24 saves, a 3-2-0 record, one shutout and a 2.13 GAA.

### UP NEXT

The Flyers close out the regular season against Xavier on Friday, Nov. 6 at 7 p.m. at Baujan Field.
