- Denver's power play ranks 4th in the NCAA (27.7%). The Pios went 4/10 (40.0%) on the man advantage last weekend and have gone 9/31 (29.0%) over their last five.

- Jaillet is 3rd among Denver's all-time goalies in career wins (65) - Denver AD Ron Grahame holds the record with 85.
