Blue Demon Notables

- Reached the Second Round with a 59-55 win over BYU, who was a No. 10 seed in the tournament.
- Reached the Second Round for the second consecutive year... is 2-5 in Second Round Games
- 3-0 in NCAA Tournament games played at the Allstate Arena.
- Is 10-16 all-time in NCAA Tournament Games
- Against BYU Anna Martin paced DePaul with 17 points... she has paced DePaul in scoring in
- Martin is averaging 19.0 points per game which ranks tops in the BIG EAST Conference
- Martin has 628 points this season which is the 10th-best single-season scoring output in DePaul's history... needs 25 points to tie for ninth with Diana Vines (1986-87) and Lenae Williams (2001-02) with 653 points.
- Katherine Harry leads DePaul and with BIG EAST with 9.5 rebounds per game... grabbed nine rebounds against BYU.

Opponent 34 - Tennessee (25-8)

- Played in every NCAA Tournament since 1982... 110-22 all-time in the NCAA Tournament... averages 4.4 games per NCAA Tournament
- Tennessee has never lost a Second Round Game... is 23-0 all-time in the Second Round.
- +14.9 average margin of victory ranks 14th in Division I
- +8.5 rebound margin ranks 13th in the country

The Series: 20th Meeting

- Monday's game is the 20th meeting between the two teams... Tennessee leads the all-time series 19-0
- The teams met earlier this season at the Maggie Dixon Classic in New York... Tennessee won 84-61.
- In that game, DePaul notched seven 3-pointers and limited Tennessee to an 0-for-5 performance from beyond the arc.
- The series between the Blue Demons and Lady Volunteers dates back to Feb. 13, 1991.
- The two teams met once previously in the NCAA Championships when they faced off in the Second Round in Tallahassee, Fla. ... Tennessee won 79-59.
- The closest matchup came on Dec. 17, 2003, in an overtime affair in Chicago... the Lady Volunteers went on to win by seven -- 96-89.

• **Noting the Blue Demons:** DePaul is 705-403 (.636) all-time... the 2011-12 campaign is the 37th season of women's basketball at DePaul University... since the start of the 2003-04 season (295 games), the Blue Demons have held 65.8 percent of their opponents to less than 70 points (194-of-295)... in that span, DePaul is 165-29 (.845) when holding opponents to less than 70 points... in that same time span, DePaul has scored 70 or more points in 194 games... DePaul is 170-24 (.876) when scoring 70 plus points... in the last seven plus seasons (264 games), the Blue Demons are 188-76 (.712)... in the last 77 home games against conference opponents, DePaul has posted 64 victories... over the last ten plus seasons (386 games), DePaul has scored at least 80 points in 125 games... the Blue Demons hold a 120-5 (.960) record in those games... in the same span, DePaul is 52-1, including 50 straight wins, when scoring at least 90 points.

• **Marching Along:** DePaul is making its tenth consecutive and the program's 16th NCAA Championship appearance in 2010... the Blue Demons were one of eight BIG EAST programs in the field of 64 in 2012... DePaul is 10-16 (.384) all-time in NCAA Championship play... DePaul is one of 11 teams to appear in each of the last 10 tournaments... joining the Blue Demons on the list of 11 teams with 10-straight NCAA's are Connecticut, Duke, Georgia, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Oklahoma, Rutgers, Stanford, Tennessee and Vanderbilt... the 10-straight appearances are a program record for consecutive NCAA's... DePaul earned four consecutive NCAA berths from 1990-93 followed by a three-year run from 1995-97... the program is 7-9 entering in its last nine plus tournament appearances, including a 2006 and 2011 NCAA Regional Semifinal appearance.

• **Second Round Games:** DePaul has reached the second round seven times in its 17 NCAA Tournament appearances... boasts a 2-5 Second Round record – winning its games in 2006 and 2011... DePaul is 1-0 in second round games that are played at the Allstate Arena... topped No. 12 Tulsa in 2006 to reach the Sweet 16... last season DePaul defeated Penn State on its home floor to reach the Regional Semifinal... second time DePaul has played Tennessee in the second round... Tennessee defeated the Blue Demons 79-59 in 2004 as a No. 1 in Tallahassee.

• **First Round Games:** DePaul is 8-9 in its 16 First Round Games... DePaul has won its First Round game the last two seasons... in both of those games DePaul had to overcome and deficit... prior to its last two wins, DePaul had dropped four-straight First Round Games.

• **Playing at the Allstate:** DePaul is 23-4 all-time in games played at the Allstate Arena... won its last 11 games at the Allstate which includes three NCAA Tournament wins... is 3-0 in NCAA Tournament games that have been played at the Allstate... last played in Rosemont in 2006 in the NCAA First and Second Rounds -- DePaul topped No. 13 Liberty and No. 12 Tulsa to advance to the program's first ever NCAA Regional Semifinal... in its 27 games in Rosemont, DePaul is averaging 75.2 points per contest while holding its opponent to 58.6... DePaul's current 11-game winning streak is a program-best... prior to its current streak, DePaul won 10 straight from Feb. 4, 1981 – Dec. 4, 1982.

• **It Could Happen:** Head coach Doug Bruno could win his 551st career coaching victory and 511th at the collegiate level... with one 3-pointer it would run DePaul's streak to 93 consecutive games with a 3-pointer... Anna Martin needs 25 points tie for eighth on DePaul's single season scoring list (Dianna Vines (1986-87) and Lenae Williams (2001-02 -- 653)... Katherine Harry needs two blocks to tie for ninth on DePaul's single-season block list... Harry needs 10 rebounds to tie Diana Vines (1988-89) on DePaul's single-season rebounding list with 325... DePaul needs two 3-pointers to tie for first (253 -- 2011-12) in a single season... both Martin and Harry could play in their 103rd career game.

• **Streaking:** Dating back to last season and in some cases, the last couple of seasons, the Blue Demons have put together various streaks. Listed below are some current active streaks:

- 92-games with at least one 3-pointer
- 72-straight victories over unranked non-conference opponents at home
- 15-consecutive wins over programs from the State of Illinois
- 10-consecutive NCAA Championship appearances

• **Taking Advantage from Beyond the Arc:**

Since the start of the 2005-06 season (232 games), the club has knocked down 1,595 (6.88 per game) trifectas compared to just 1,132 (4.88 per game) for the opposition... DePaul has knocked down at least one 3-pointer in its last 921 games and has tallied a three-pointer in 496 of the last 500 games... DePaul has made 200 or more 3-pointers in 13 of its last 14 seasons, including this season (253)... the 2009-10 team tallied 163 to end DePaul's streak at 10 seasons... in 2010-11 DePaul set a school record with 255, 3-pointers... this season DePaul has tallied 253, 3-pointers (7.7) through 33 games... 253, 3-pointers is the second most in school history... in seasons in which DePaul recorded 200 plus 3-pointers its best average was 7.9 3-pointers per game... DePaul averaged 7.9 3-pointers in 2007-08 (252 in 32 games) and in 2001-02 (230 in 29 games)... DePaul needs two triples to tie for the most in school history.

• **Ten Plus:** DePaul has hit 10 or more 3-pointers in eight of its 32 games... made a school record 16 against St. Mary's and tied for second with 15 against Portland... DePaul is averaging 7.8 triples per game which is the second best average in the BIG EAST and is eighth in Division I (Mar. 11)... three Blue Demons have 50 or more 3-pointers... Anna Martin leads the team with 62 3-pointers and ranks eighth in the league with 1.9 3-pointers per game... Brittany Hrynko sits at 1.8 per contest (56) which ranks 10th and Megan Rogowski ranks 12th with 1.7... DePaul is 250-for-725 (.345) from behind the arc this season which ranks third in the BIG EAST behind Connecticut (.355) and Notre Dame (.350)... season best .481 (13-for-27) effort against SIU-Edwardsville on Dec. 7.

• **Breaking Down the "Magnificent 7":** DePaul head coach Doug Bruno called his seven-person rotation following DePaul's win over Pittsburgh... DePaul is down to a 7-person rotation after losing five players to injury... the Magnificent Seven are – Anna Martin, Katherine Harry, Jasmine Penny, Deanna Ortiz, Megan Rogowski, Brittany Hrynko, and Kelsey Reynolds... only Martin and Harry have started more than 35 games in their careers... both Martin and Harry are three-year starters... Ortiz was a key reservist before entering the starting-lineup on a permanent basis against Illinois State on Dec. 18... Penny played in just 17 games as a freshman including just five BIG EAST Conference games... Rogowski and Hrynko are both freshmen while Reynolds, a sophomore, joined the team last season after transferring from Boston College... DePaul is 13-7 since losing Keisha Hampton to a career-ending exploratory knee surgery.

• **National Numbers:** The Blue Demons rank in the top 35 in six national statistical categories which were released on Mar. 11 by the NCAA... eighth in 3-pointers per game (7.8)... 16th in assists per game (16.4)... 19th in scoring offense (73.2)... 24th in assist to turnover ratio (0.99)... 35th in 3-point field goal percentage (.345)... individually, Anna Martin ranks 25th in scoring (19.1) and Katherine Harry's 9.6 rebounds ranks 36th.

• **Martin's Moments:** Anna Martin became DePaul's 27th 1,000-point scorer against Northern Illinois on Dec. 31... she scored 30 points against the Huskies... has 1,362 career points which ranks 15th on DePaul's all-time list... she is averaging a team-high and leads the BIG EAST with 19.0 points this season... her career average stands at 13.4 since arriving in Lincoln Park in 2009... reached double digits in 69 of her 102 games (67.6%) and in 29 of DePaul's 33 games this season... scored a career-high 36 points against Cincinnati... her 36 points were the most by a BIG EAST player in league games and the second-best scoring output this season by a

ROSEMONT, Ill. -- DePaul earned another shot at taking down Tennessee by holding off BYU.

Anna Martin led a balanced attack with 17 points as DePaul claimed a 59-55 victory against the Cougars in the first round of the NCAA women's tournament Saturday at the Allstate Arena.

BYU (26-7) fought back from a late eight-point deficit and had a chance to tie with 2.8 seconds to play. But Haley Steed's 3 point try missed, DePaul (23-10) rebounded and Steed fouled Brittany Hrynko.

Hrynko added a free throw and closed with 15 points while Katherine Harry and Jasmine Penny had 12 each. Harry added nine rebounds to pace the Blue Demon on the boards. Deanna Ortiz and Penny both paced the floor with four steals each.

Jennifer Hamson had 21 points for BYU and Kristen Riley had 10 and 12 rebounds.

Martin scored six points as a fast-starting DePaul hit 5 of its first 7 shots to open an early 10-1 lead.

Hamson collected six more points over a six minute span as the Cougars forced a 12-12 tie and took their first lead at 14-12 on Dani Peterson's bank shot with 10:55 left in the half.

BYU never trailed through the balance of a tight first half, but never extended a lead beyond five points. The Blue Demons twice rallied to tie in the final 1:32, but the Cougars opened a 29-27 lead on a pair of Lexi Eaton free throws.

DePaul then took over in the second half.

The Blue Demons took advantage of five Cougars turnovers and opened the second half with 14 unanswered points -- including five from Hrynko -- for a 41-29 lead at the 14:30 mark.

BYU broke the run at 13:41 on Easton's layup, but still trailed 45-34 when Steed when to work.

Steed hit back-to-back 3 pointers -- her first field goals of the game -- to briefly trim the deficit to 45-40.

BYU hit two more 3-pointers and cut the lead to 54-48 with 3:26 on Vermunt's long-distance shot.

The Cougars continued to chip away and trimmed the deficit to 58-55 on Lexi Eaton's 3 with 41.8 seconds left.

The Cougars were making their first NCAA trip since 2007. They won the West Coast Conference tournament earlier this month for an automatic berth.

The Blue Demons are a tournament regular, qualifying yearly since 2003. They reached the NCAA Sweet 16 last year before falling to Duke and also advanced in 2006. The program's 2006 trip to the Sweet 16 came after it won its first and second round games -- the last time DePaul hosted at the Allstate Arena.

The seventh-seeded Blue Demons (23-10) will play No. 2 Tennessee at 8:30 p.m. on Monday.
