Duquesne won 11 titles in going 75-9-0 (.893) in 14 seasons as a member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League (MAAC) from 1994-2007. The Dukes won titles in 1995, '96, '99, '00, '01, '02, '03, '04, '05, '06, '07 and a I-AA Mid-Major National Championship in 2003. This will be Duquesne's 10th season as an associate football only playing member of the Northeast Conference. DU has shared the NEC regular-season title in 2011, 2013 & 2016 and won the title outright in 2015 (school's first NCAA Playoff appearance).

### RB • A.J. HINES, So. (5-11, 225)

Put together the top freshman season by a Duquesne running back on the way to winning the Jerry Rice Award (top FCS freshman) ... earned NEC Rookie of the Week a conference-record 10 times, on the way to being named NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year ... was the only freshman named First Team All-NEC ... ranked 9th nationally - and first among freshmen - in rushing yards per game (117.4) ... posted seven 100-yard games with a high of 189 vs. Dayton ... his 13 rushing TDs ranked 11th nationally ... finished the year with 1,291 yards on 242 carries (5.3 ypc.) and 13 rushing TDs ... caught 15 passes for 200 yards and another score.

### OL • BEN HUSS, Sr. (6-2, 310)

Named Third Team All-American by STATS FCS ... also named First Team All-NEC ... has earned All-NEC honors in each of his first three seasons (Second Team in 2014 and First Team in 2015) ... three-year starter ... anchored an offensive line that helped the Dukes average 429 yards per game in 2016 (168.5 per game on the ground and 260.5 in the air) ... has helped clear the way for 13 100-yard rushing games by four different backs over the past two seasons.

### LB • NATHAN STONE, Sr. (6-0, 255)

Three-year starter has earned All-NEC honors three times (First Team as a freshman and junior and Second Team as a sophomore) ... has started every game of his college career (35 in a row entering 2017) ... begins his senior year with 232 tackles (123 solo) and 25.5 tackles for loss, including 12.5 sacks ... averaging 6.6 tackles per game for his career ... was second on the team with 73 tackles (8.0 TFL) last season ... his 42 solo stops tied for team-high ... was the NEC Defensive Rookie of the Year and Jerry Rice Watch List finalist as a freshman in 2014.

### DE • ANDY STRUTTMANN, Sr. (6-2, 250)

Second Team All-NEC pick in 2016 after making the move from linebacker to defensive line ... had 49 tackles last season ... his 10.0 tackles for loss (for -48 yards) ranked second on the team to All-American linebacker Christian Kuntz.

### OL • MATT FITZPATRICK, Jr. (6-3, 300)

Was named Second Team All-NEC after starting all 11 games at left guard ... 2016 was his first season as a starter ... helped the Dukes average 429 yards per game in 2016 (168.5 per game on the ground and 260.5 in the air).

### DB • ABNER ROBERTS, Jr. (5-11, 180)

Earned Second Team All-NEC honors in 2016 ... two-year starter at safety ... has 133 tackles in 23 games (5.8 per game for his career) ... was fourth on the team with 59 stops last season ... broke up a team-high eight passes.

# 2017 DUQUESNE FOOTBALL

• Duquesne, which returns 13 position starters, has won a share of four of the past six Northeast Conference titles (2011-co, 2013-co, 2015 and 2016-co). The Dukes were picked to finish first in the 2017 NEC preseason coaches poll. DU attempting to become the second program in conference history to win a share of three consecutive titles (Robert Morris won the first five, three outright, from 1996 through 2000).

• Duquesne is 31-17 in NEC play over the past seven seasons. The Dukes went 4-11 in their first two years in the conference while making the transition to a scholarship model. DU is 10-2 in NEC play over the past two years (outright champions in 2015 and co-champions with Saint Francis U in 2016).

• Duquesne is 32-24 in non-conference games under 13th-year head coach Jerry Schmitt with wins over Robert Morris (three times prior to joining the NEC), Dayton (six times), Bucknell (four times), Fordham (twice), Albany (once as a CAA member) and Monmouth (as an independent). At home, the Dukes are 22-3 in non-league play.

## DUQUESNE'S NEC PROGRESSION

The 2011 NEC co-champion Dukes were the first to benefit from four classes of scholarship players. Duquesne, which added a second NEC co-title in 2013, offered 18 scholarships in conjunction to its move to the NEC in 2008. DU is currently up to 40 scholarships.

Duquesne has 14 Football Bowl Championship players on the 2017 roster (*as of July 18*) including: junior WR Kareem Coles (Idaho), junior PK Markus Colin (UMass), senior OL Cody Collins (Marshall), senior WR Jaquan Davidson (Pitt), sophomore LB Bryan Glover (Eastern Michigan), senior LB Carter Henderson (Penn State), senior WR Thomas Lucas (UConn), sophomore P/PK Mitch MacZura (Ohio State), senior WR Chavas Rawlins (West Virginia), junior OL Wyatt Santos (Louisiana Tech), junior DB Brandon Stanback (Buffalo), graduate student QB Tommy Stuart (Boise State), junior DB Daquan Worley (Penn State) and sophomore LB Brett Zanotto (Maryland).

## FOUR KEYS ENTERING 2017

**1** • Head coach Jerry Schmitt enters the fall looking to develop a replacement for four-year starting quarterback Dillon Buechel. Buechel, who finished his career as the NEC all-time passing leader with 10,320 yards, threw for 75 touchdowns as a three-time All-NEC player. The 2016 Walter Payton Award finalist led the Dukes to three Northeast Conference championships (2013-co, 2015 & 2016-co) and the school's first FCS Playoff appearance (2015). Schmitt will look to Boise State graduate transfer **Tommy Stuart** (6-0, 205), redshirt sophomore **Brett Brumbaugh** (6-4, 215) and true freshman **Alex Smith** (6-4, 200) to fill the void. Stuart attempted 23 passes in 12 games at BSU. Brumbaugh has attempted one pass as a Duke. The new QB will be working with a talented - but young - receiving corps led by junior **Nehari Crawford** (30-359-3). Gone are starting wideouts Wayne Capers (51-959, 9 TDs) and Blair Roberts (47-782, 8 TDs).

**2** • An area of strength should be the running game with Jerry Rice Award-winning sophomore RB **A.J. Hines** (1,296 yards and 13 TDs) and junior **P.J. Fulmore** (355 yards and two TDs) returning. The 5-11, 225-pound Hines, who enters the season as the nation's fifth-leading returning rusher (117.4 ypg), and the 5-7, 200-pound Fulmore, will be running behind a veteran offensive line led by senior guard **Ben Huss**, a Third Team STATS FCS All-American and three-time All-NEC player as well as junior guard **Matt Fitzpatrick**, a second team All-NEC pick. Junior left tackle **Alex Conley** is the third returning starter on the o-line.

**3** • Duquesne returns its top two tacklers in senior linebackers **Carter Henderson** (90 tackles) and **Nathan Stone** (73 tackles). The pair combined for 15.5 tackles for loss (7.5 by Henderson and 8.0 by Stone). Henderson and Stone, who started all 11 games last season, will help ease the loss of three-time All-American and NEC all-time sack leader Christian Kuntz. Redshirt junior safety **Abner Roberts**, who finished fourth on the team with 59 tackles and led the team with eight passes broken up, will anchor an experienced secondary that includes returning starters junior **Jonathant Istache** (CB), redshirt junior **Daquan Worley** (CB) and junior **Brandon Stanback** (S). Redshirt senior nickel back **Malik Shogog** (CB) is also back.

**4** • The Dukes will need to find a replacement for P/PK Austin Crimmins, who was the starting placekicker for four years (school record 57 career field goals) and three-year starting punter (school record 38.5 avg). Redshirt sophomore **John Domit** finished spring ball as the leader to placekicking duties, while fellow redshirt sophomore **Mitch MacZura** enters the fall as the leading candidate to take over at punter.

## JERRY RICE AWARD WINNER A.J. HINES

A.J. Hines, the 2016 Jerry Rice Award winner (top FCS freshman), led the nation's freshmen in rushing yardage last season. His 117.4 yards per game average is the fifth-best among FCS returnees:

**ONE OF THE TOP 100 PROGRAMS OF ALL-TIME:** Duquesne, which fielded its first football team in 1891, was ranked among The Associated Press' Top 100 programs in a unique ranking system released in the summer of 2016. The AP, which has been ranking teams for over 80 seasons, compiled an all-time Top 100 based on a formula that counts poll appearances, No. 1 rankings and AP championships. The results placed Duquesne 97th. The Dukes were one of just 11 current Football Championship Subdivision programs to earn a spot on the list. DU, which competed at college football's highest level through 1950, appeared in the AP final poll in 1936 (14th), 1939 (10th) and 1941 (8th).

**ALOHA:** Last August, Duquesne announced that the team will be traveling to Honolulu for a game against Hawaii on Sept. 22, 2018. The game, which will be DU's second against an FBS program, will also be the program's first game west of the Rocky Mountains since 1947, when the Dukes played at San Francisco. The furthest Duquesne has traveled since moving to the FBS level in 1992, was to Thibodaux, Louisiana to face Nicholls in 2009. Duquesne was just the third NEC team to face an FBS team when it traveled to Buffalo to take on the University at Buffalo in the 2014 season opener. In that game, DU led 28-24 with under 10 minutes left before Buffalo, a Mid-American Conference team which was coming off an 8-5 season and bowl appearance, scored a pair of late touchdowns to pull out a 38-28 win.

### 6 DEGREES OF STEELERS:

The Duquesne football program has had a long relationship with the Pittsburgh Steelers, with a number of links to the 2017 team. Steelers founder Art Rooney, for whom DU's home field is named, was a quarterback/kicker for the Dukes in 1920. His son, Dan Rooney, the Steelers late chairman, graduated from Duquesne. Dan's son, Art Rooney II, the current Steelers president, earned a law degree from DU. Junior receiver **Nehari Crawford** is the cousin of Steelers LB Ryan Shazier. Shazier can regularly be seen at DU games when it fits the Steelers schedule. Defensive assistant **Luke Smith** is the nephew of Steelers special teams coordinator Danny Smith. In addition, defensive backs coach **Darnel Dickerson** was selected to attend Steelers training camp from

July 27th through August 5th as part of the 2017 NFL Bill Walsh Diversity Coaching Fellowship. The Steelers regularly practiced on Rooney Field in the 1990s under a bubble that covered 80 yards of the field during the winter months. The team moved off campus following construction of its South Side practice facility.

**DUKES WITH DEGREES:** Three current members of the 2017 roster will begin the season with their undergraduate degrees: defensive back **Adam Clopton** graduated with a bachelor of science in business administration, with a double major in international business and supply chain management (December 2016). He is currently in Duquesne's master of science in management program. Linebacker **Carter Henderson** graduated with a bachelor of science in business administration, with a major in finance (May 2017). He is currently in Duquesne's master of business administration (MBA) program. Quarterback **Tommy Stuart** graduated from Boise State University with a bachelor of arts in communication (December 2016). He is currently in Duquesne's master of science in leadership program. (Stuart is a first-year grad transfer).

# THE 2017 SCHEDULE

Non-conference games at perennial Football Champion Subdivision power South Dakota State and at Football Bowl Subdivision-reclassifying Liberty highlight the 2017 Duquesne football schedule. The Dukes, who return 13 starters from last year's 8-3 Northeast Conference co-Championship team, open with three consecutive road games for the first time since 1950. DU kicks off the 2017 season on Thursday, August 31 against a South Dakota State team coming off its first Missouri Valley Football Conference title and fifth-straight FCS playoff appearance. SDSU, which went 9-4 in 2016,

finished the season ranked No. 6 by STATS FCS and No. 7 in the FCS Coaches Poll. This will be the second-ever game between the Dukes and Jackrabbits, who last met on Nov. 11, 1932. DU continues with back-to-back road games against Pioneer Football League members Valparaiso (Sept. 9) and Dayton (Sept. 16). It will be the first meeting with Valpo since the Dukes swept a home-and-home series in 2011 & 2012. This will be the tenth consecutive season Duquesne and Dayton will meet. The Dukes, who were one of two teams to defeat the 9-2 Flyers last season, hold an 8-6 edge in the series that dates back to 1920. DU has won seven of the past 10, with all three Dayton wins coming at home. Duquesne follows an off week with its home opener against West Virginia Wesleyan on Sept. 30. It will be DU's latest home opening game since becoming

an FCS member in 1993. The Dukes, who have won a share of four of the past six NEC titles, open conference play on Oct. 7 vs. Wagner in a Homecoming Weekend matchup. DU continues with NEC games at Robert Morris (Oct. 14), vs. Saint Francis U (Oct. 21) and at Sacred Heart (Oct. 28) before heading to Lynchburg, Va. to face Liberty in its final non-conference game. Liberty, which opens on Sept. 2 at Baylor, is beginning a two-year FBS reclassification process. The Flames, who joined the Big South Conference in 2002, have won eight conference titles - with the last coming last season. The Dukes host CCSU on Nov. 11 before concluding the regular season at Bryant on Nov. 18.

## SCHEDULE QUICK NOTES

**FOUR AT HOME:** The Dukes will play four times at home and seven times on the road. The four home games are the fewest since 2007.

**LATE START:** DU's Sept. 30 home opener vs. West Virginia Wesleyan is the school's latest home opener since 1970, when the program competed at the club level. This is the first time since 1950 that Duquesne is opening with three consecutive road games.

**NEW FACE:** The Dukes will be playing one first-time opponent in Liberty which is in the process of reclassifying into the Football Bowl Subdivision.

**LONG TIME, NO SEE:** This will be DU's second game against South Dakota State. On Nov. 11, 1932, head coach Elmer Layden's Dukes defeated SDSU 34-12 at Forbes Field.

**NON-CONFERENCE BREAKDOWN:** DU will play five nonconference games: South Dakota State (Missouri Valley Football Conference), Valparaiso (Pioneer Football League), Dayton (Pioneer Football League), West Virginia Wesleyan (Division II Mountain East Conference) and Liberty (Big South Conference).

## HOME SWEET HOME

Duquesne is 99-27-0 all-time at Rooney Field including winning streaks of 16, 14 and 10 games (twice). Duquesne owns nonconference home wins over Dayton (five times), Bucknell (four times), Lafayette (twice), Albany, VMI, Monmouth, Butler, Morehead State and Fordham among others over the past 16 seasons. DU is 40-12 in nonconference home games (23-3 under Jerry Schmitt) on Rooney Field.

# JERRY SCHMITT

Head Coach • 13th Season at Duquesne

18th Season Overall

Four Northeast Conference championships in the past six seasons, and the University's first trip to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2015, highlight the resume of 13th year Duquesne football coach Jerry Schmitt.

A finalist for the 2015 STATS FCS Coach of the Year, Schmitt has seen seven players invited to NFL rookie camps over the past two seasons.

Last year, Duquesne, which tied for the NEC title, was one of just four FCS programs with players among the finalists for the three major FCS individual awards. Linebacker Christian Kuntz finished 12th in the voting for the Buck Buchanan Award (top defensive player), quarterback Dillon Buechel was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award (top offensive player) and freshman A.J. Hines was named winner of the Jerry Rice Award (top freshman).

Schmitt, who played an important role in the development of the Duquesne football program as an assistant from 1985-87 and again from 1992-99, returned to the DU campus in 2005 after spending five years as head coach at his alma mater, Westminster College, in New Wilmington, Pa. The Pittsburgh native oversaw the program's move to the Northeast Conference and ensuing adoption of athletics-based aid in February of 2008.

It is a transition that has been an overwhelming success, as over the past six seasons, Schmitt's Dukes have won more overall games (43) and conference games (26) than any NEC school. In addition, DU - which has at least shared four of the past six NEC titles - is the only league school with four winning conference records in the past six years.

Schmitt wasted no time putting his mark on the program by leading the Dukes to three consecutive Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championships and earning MAAC Coach of the Year two times in his first three seasons as head coach.

In 2011, Schmitt continued Duquesne's transition as a scholarship-granting associate member of the Northeast Conference by guiding the Dukes to a 9-2 record and NEC co-Championship with a 7-1 record. The 2011 co-title was part of a gradual progression for the Dukes who finished the 2010 season with a 7-4 record and third place league finish with a 5-3 mark.

In 2013, Duquesne once again earned a share of the title - this time tying with Sacred Heart. The 2014 season saw the Dukes finish 6-6 overall.

In 2015, Duquesne went 5-1 in conference play, earning its first outright NEC title and the league's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs, Duquesne's first.

Under Schmitt, the Dukes have fashioned a 31-17 record in NEC play over the past seven seasons after posting a 4-11 mark in their first two years while integrating a scholarship model.

In Schmitt's first season, the Dukes posted a 7-3 record (4-0 in the MAAC) - against the most challenging I-AA mid-major schedule a Duquesne team ever faced - and finished with a No. 3 national ranking in The Sports Network I-AA Mid-Major Top 10. The 2005 Dukes finished ranked No. 1 nationally in I-AA total defense, rushing defense and pass efficiency defense.

In year two, Schmitt again led DU to a 7-3 record (3-1 in the MAAC) and eighth consecutive MAAC championship as the Dukes finished ranked sixth in The Sports Network I-AA Mid-Major Top 10. The 2006 Dukes ranked second nationally in passing offense and 15th in total offense.

In 2007, Duquesne won a share of its ninth consecutive MAAC title in posting a 6-4 overall record. Five years ago the Dukes, in their first season as a scholarship program since the 1950s, went 3-7 in the school's inaugural season in the NEC and followed that with a 3-8 record in 2009.

In 2010, with DU's first scholarship class comprising a good portion of the sophomore and junior classes, the Dukes broke through with their third place NEC finish.

Winning titles at Duquesne is nothing new to Schmitt, who helped the Dukes to their first three MAAC championships in 1995, 1996 & 1999 and the school's first Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Bowl game in 1996, during his 11 years as an assistant.

Schmitt, who served under three different head coaches in Terry Russell (1985-87), Dan McCann (1992) and Greg Gattuso (1993-99), was the offensive coordinator for his last seven seasons at DU, during which time the Dukes posted a 53-21 record, won three titles and saw 16 different offensive players named First Team All-MAAC. He was promoted to assistant head coach by Gattuso prior to the 1994 season.

## DU'S TENTH SEASON IN THE NEC

Duquesne, a member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League from 1994 to 2007, is beginning its 10th season as an associate member of the Northeast Conference Football League. With the move to the NEC, Duquesne offered 18 scholarships beginning in February of 2008. That number currently rests at 38 and will be at 40 for the next recruiting class. Duquesne granted only need-based financial aid for football playing student-athletes as a member of the MAAC. The NEC competed as a non-scholarship member of the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision until 2006 when the conference adopted an athletics-based aid model. "I think this move will cause prospective student-athletes to look at Duquesne University a little differently," said head coach Jerry Schmitt when the Dukes joined the NEC. "Not only will they see Duquesne's high academic standards, but they'll also see the enhanced commitment to the football program. From a competitive standpoint, we always strive for improvement." Duquesne started its program in 1902 and competed at the highest level - winning a pair of New Years Day Bowl games (1934 Festival of Palms and 1937 Orange) - before disbanding following the 1950 season. DU returned at the Club level prior to the 1969 season and won a National Club Championship in 1973. The Dukes competed at the NCAA Division III level from 1979-92 before moving up to the non-scholarship Football Championship Subdivision in 1993. The NEC Football League, which was established in 1996, includes full-time conference members Bryant University, Central Connecticut State University, Robert Morris University, Sacred Heart University, Saint Francis (Pa.) University and Wagner College along with associate member Duquesne University.
