HEAD COACH SUZIE McCONNELL-SERIO

Women's Basketball Hall of Famer and Pittsburgh native Suzie McConnell-Serio, one of the most highly-decorated players in the history of women's basketball, owner of over 300 wins as a high school head coach and former WNBA Coach of the Year, was named the ninth head coach in the history of the Duquesne women's basketball program in April of 2007.

It did not take long for McConnell-Serio to make an impact, as she took a team picked to finish 13th in the Atlantic 10 Conference and guided it to a 15-15 record and a seventh place tie in league standings with a 6-8 mark. McConnell-Serio, who inherited a team coming off its worst season since 1993, (7-20 in 2007) led the Dukes to their second most improved season in school history (6.5 games). Additionally, DU improved 79 positions in the RPI, which was the most since 2001. McConnell-Serio's success on the floor was recognized by league officials as Kristi Little was named Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Year as well as being named to the A-10 Third Team All Conference and All Defensive Team.

McConnell-Serio was one of the most successful high school coaches in the state in compiling a 321-86 (.789) record and winning three Class AAAA state titles and four District 7 (WPIAL) championships in 13 seasons at Pittsburgh's Oakland Catholic High School.

As a professional coach, she guided the WNBA Minnesota Lynx to back-to-back playoff appearances - including the first in franchise history - in 2003 and 2004 and was named WNBA Coach of the Year in 2004.

McConnell-Serio attended Pittsburgh's Seton-La Salle High School prior to beginning an outstanding playing career as a point guard at Penn State University. In four seasons at PSU (1984-85 through 1987-88), McConnell-Serio helped the Nittany Lions to a 95-33 record and four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances. In the process, she was named the school's first First Team All-American while setting NCAA Division I records for career assists (1,307), assists in a season (355 in 1987) and season assist average (11.8 in 1987). Her assist total and assist per game average led the nation in both 1986 & 1987.

Following her collegiate career, McConnell-Serio was a double medalwinner as part of both the 1988 and 1992 United States Olympic teams. In 1988 she helped the U.S. to a gold medal in Seoul and in 1992 she was a bronze medalist in Barcelona. She also won a gold medal as a member of the 1991 U.S. World University Games team.

SUZIE McCONNELL-SERIO BY THE NUMBERS

0 - Number of playoff appearances made by the Minnesota Lynx prior to the hiring of Suzie McConnell-Serio as head coach in 2003. McConnell-Serio led the Lynx to back-to-back playoff appearances in 2003 & 2004.

2 - Number of medals won as a player for the United States Olympic Basketball Team (1988 Seoul gold and 1992 Barcelona bronze). McConnell-Serio also won a gold medal as a member of the U.S. 1991 World University Games team.

2 - Number of Atlantic 10 Tournament championships won by Penn State (1985 & 1986) during McConnell-Serio's four-year career. She was named to the A-10 All-Championship Team three times (1985, 1986 & 1988) and Most Outstanding Player once (1985).

3 - Number of seasons McConnell-Serio played for the WNBA Cleveland Rockers. The 16th overall pick (second round) in the 1998 WNBA Draft, McConnell-Serio earned Newcomer of the Year and All-WNBA First Team honors in 1998. She was also a two-time winner of the league's Kim Perrot Sportsmanship Award.

4 - Number of NCAA Tournament appearances McConnell-Serio made as a player at Penn State between 1984-85 and 1987-88.

4 - McConnell-Serio - a four-time First Team All-Atlantic 10 player - still owns the top four assist per game seasons in Atlantic 10 history. She ranks tenth in career points (1,897), first in assists (1,307) and second in steals (507).

5-4 - McConnell-Serio was selected as the best 5-4 basketball player, male or female, of all-time by Sports Illustrated.

15 - Number of wins McConnell-Serio guided Duquesne to in her first season as coach.

1,307 - NCAA Division I record number of assists handed out by McConnell-Serio in her four seasons at Penn State. McConnell-Serio, who averaged 10.2 assists per game for her career, also holds NCAA records for assists in a season (355 in 1987), and season average per game (11.8 in 1987). She led the nation in assists and assists per game in both 1986 & 1987.

1988 - Became the first First Team All-American in Penn State women's basketball history. Also named winner of the Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award given to the outstanding female senior collegian 5-8 or under.

McConnell-Serio was picked in the second round (16th overall) of the 1998 WNBA Draft by the Cleveland Rockers and went on to earn Newcomer of the Year and All-WNBA First Team honors in her first season in the league. She also won the Kim Perrot Sportsmanship Award twice (1998 & 2000) in her three seasons in the WNBA.

McConnell-Serio took the reigns of the Oakland Catholic program in 1990-91 and won her first of three Class AAAA State Championships in 1993. In 13 years, McConnell-Serio averaged over 24 wins per season. She added additional state titles in 2001 & 2003 and runner-up finishes in 2000 & 2002. Nearly a dozen of her former players went on to earn NCAA Division I scholarships.

In January of 2003, McConnell-Serio returned to the WNBA as head coach of the Minnesota Lynx and took a team that finished 10-22 in the previous season to an 18-16 record and first-ever playoff appearance. One year later, she took a team picked to finish last in the Western Conference by a number of preseason publications and made a return trip to the playoffs and in the process was named the 2004 WNBA Coach of the Year. The '04 Lynx, who earned a franchise-best No. 3 seed in the Western Conference, tied franchise records for wins (18), home victories (11) and road wins (7) all set in McConnell-Serio's first season. In addition, Minnesota enjoyed a franchise record six-game winning streak.

McConnell-Serio, who completed her degree in education at Penn State in 1988, has won numerous awards throughout her career. She was named to the USA Today All-Time Women's Basketball Team and was also named one of Sports Illustrated's Top 50 Pennsylvania Athletes of the Century.

She was a member of the 10-person USA Basketball Executive Committee from 2001-04 and was inducted to the Western Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame in 2001. She was also the first Dapper Dan Sportswoman of the Year winner in 1999.

The October 29, 2007 issue of *Sports Illustrated* listed McConnell-Serio as the best 5-4 basketball player, male or female, of all-time. McConnell-Serio and her husband, Pete, who along with Suzie was born and raised in the Brookline area of Pittsburgh - are the parents of four children: Peter (18), Jordan (14), Mandy (12) and Madison (11).

BACK ON THE BLUFF: Assistant coaches **Dan Burt** and **Blaine Patterson** return to Duquesne for their second season on the women's basketball staff. Burt brings 10 years of Division I experience to the Dukes' bench. He came to Duquesne from Bucknell where he was an assistant for three seasons (2004-07). He was also an assistant for three seasons at both West Virginia (1998-2001) and UNC Wilmington (2001-04). Patterson, known for his extensive knowledge of video editing and game preparation, spent three seasons at Illinois prior to coming to Duquesne. While at Illinois, he served as assistant to the head coach in 2004-05 and as an assistant coach under Theresa Greutz in 2005-06 and 2006-07. Director of Basketball Operations **Katie Kestler** also returns to the staff this season.

I REMEMBER YOU: New to the staff this season is assistant coach **Carmen Bruce**. The former standout guard played two seasons for the Red and Blue and finished her career with 290 assists, which is currently ninth all-time in DU history. Last season, Bruce served as a graduate student in the Duquesne athletics marketing department.

ABOUT TEMPLE: Founded in 1884 by Dr. Russell Conwell, Temple College was chartered in 1888 and became Temple University in 1907. Temple University is the 28th largest university in the United States, the sixth largest provider of professional education in the country. The school's athletic teams are called the Owls: this name comes from Temple's early days, when it was a night school. As early as 1923, the University's women began participating on club sport teams. In fact, that year Coach Blanche Voorhees guided an Owl basketball team to a perfect 12-0. The Owls are also a part of the Philadelphia Big 5 which also includes Penn, Saint Joseph's, Villanova and La Salle. Notable Temple Alumni include sports talk radio host Tony Bruno, actor/comedian Bill Cosby, musicians Daryl Hall and John Oates, actor/comedian Bob Saget, actor Tom Sizemore, former National Hockey League President Gil Stein and actress Patricia Wettig. Temple has produced dozens of professional athletes including Raheem Brock, Dan Kleko, Joe Kleko, Mike McGann, James Parrish, Al Singleton, Rian Wallace of the National Football League and Rick Brunson, Mardy Collins, Steve Javie, Eddie Jones, Mark Macon, Aaron McKie and Pepe Sánchez of the National Basketball Association and Candice Dupree and Kamesha Hairston of the Women's National Basketball Association.

LAST TIME AGAINST TEMPLE: Temple's Ashley Morris had a game-high 27 points and Lady Comfort had a double-double of 16 points and a career-best 18 rebounds as Temple held off a late Duquesne run in their 74-66 win at the Liacouras Center Feb. 17, 2008. Morris, who was 11-22 from the field, led Temple to their ninth consecutive win against the Dukes. Kelly Britcher's layup with 3:04 left in the game cut the TU lead to one point 63-62. Morris and Lauren Reinshuttle exchanged jumpers to make the score 65-64 before the Owls went on a 7-0 run to ice the game behind a pair of Comfort foul shots with 27 seconds remaining.

Lebanon), **Kelly Britcher** (Johnstown, Pa./Westmont Hilltop), **Rachel Frederick** (Gibsonia, Pa./North Catholic), **Alex Gensler** (Pittsburgh, Pa./Upper St. Clair), **Kristi Little** (Altoona, Pa./Altoona), **Samantha Pollino** (Johnstown, Pa./Conemaugh Valley), **Eve Pyle** (Export, Pa./Oakland Catholic) **Samantha Thompson** (Southampton, Pa./Saint Basil Academy). A pair of Dukes are from West Virginia in **Amanda Peck** and **Keri Pryor** - both are from Morgantown, W.Va. and Morgantown High School. **Lauren Reinshuttle** (Fairfax Station, Va./South County) lives the farthest from the Bluff.

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY: Coach Serio announced on Nov. 27 the signings of guard **Jocelyn Floyd** (Washington, Pa./ Washington), guard **Ahjah Hall** (Bowie, Md./Eleanor Roosevelt) and forward **Carly Vendemia** (Beaver, Pa./Beaver) to National Letters of Intent. Both Floyd and Vendemia have been members of the *Pittsburgh Post-Gazette* Fabulous Five teams and Hall is a three-time Maryland state girl's basketball champion.

WHAT A WEEK!: Not only was Little named Atlantic 10 Player of the Week during the final week of the 2007-08 season, but she also became the first Duke to be named the conference's defensive player of the year. Additionally, she was named to the A-10 Third Team All-Conference and All Defensive Teams.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF: Little's accomplishments last season have already translated over to this season. She was voted to the A-10's preseason All-Conference First-Team.

KEEP IT ON THE DOWN LOW: On Dec. 20th, Little was named as a finalist for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The award - presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. Based on criteria focusing on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition, the award winners will be selected by national balloting of head basketball coaches, national media and college basketball fans.

CENTURY CLUB: Little and Frederick look to become members of Duquesne's 1,000 point club. Little entered the season with 777 points and has scored 220 points so far in 2008-09. She needs 3 points for 1,000. Frederick started this season with 806 points and has scored 165 points so far in 2008-09. She needs 29 points for 1,000.

ROCKIN' RACHEL: Frederick, who sat out last season under NCAA transfer rules, is showing no signs of rust in her return to the hardwood. The junior who played her first two years at Ohio University was the 2005-06 Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year as well as being named to the All-MAC third team. She scored 11 points in her Duquesne debut against Morehead State. Frederick followed that with a 23 point effort against Cornell go-

ing 10-13 from the floor with seven rebounds. She registered her first double-double in a Duquesne uniform at Binghamton scoring 10 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. She recorded a season-best 12 rebounds vs. Pittsburgh. Frederick leads the team in rebounding with 7.0 boards per game. She was perfect from the line against Saint Francis, Pa. hitting 8-of-8 shots and tied a career-high making 11 foul shots at IPFW. Frederick completed her degree in communications in December and is working toward her master's in education.

SCORING SAMANTHA: Coming off a team-best 10 rebounds against Morehead State in the season opener, Pollino responded by scoring a career-high 22 points on 9-10 (.900) shooting against Cornell on Nov. 16. Her previous high was 18 points against Robert Morris in the 2007 home opener. She was named the GoDuquesne.com GNC Student-Athlete of the Week on Nov. 17. Pollino recorded her first double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds at Robert Morris.

AWESOME ALEX: Gensler had a strong debut against Morehead State in the season opener. She scored 11 points and grabbed six boards in 21 minutes. She followed that with a nine point effort against Cornell. After being held scoreless in the first half at Mount St. Mary's, she exploded for 14 second half points. Gensler recorded 12 points against Penn, Binghamton and Niagara. After missing five games with an illness, she recorded 11 points against #9 Auburn. Gensler made her first career start the following game against Brown and made a career-best four 3-pointers.

PRYOR ON FIRE: Pryor scored 10 points and had a game-best four steals against Morehead State in the season opener. She recorded a game-high 20 points against Mount St. Mary's and a season-best eight rebounds at Towson. She scored a game-best 18 points vs. #24 Pittsburgh. She scored a season-best 23 points at IPFW.

PECK'S IN EFFECT: One of the Dukes' most improved players last season, Peck has developed into a defensive threat. She leads DU with nine defensive rebounds and had eight total rebounds in Duquesne's win over Cornell. In just 13 minutes of action against Penn, she scored a team-best 15 points.

ON THE REBOUND: After sitting out last season under NCAA transfer rules, Pyle has made quite an impression so far. She pulled down 11 rebounds in both exhibition games and added 12 points against Clarion. Pyle had a season-high 13 boards against Penn.

TERRIFIC THOMPSON: Thompson set a new career-best against Cornell when she drained all three of her 3-point attempts. This season, she is 18-for-34 (.529) from behind the arc, which is tops in the A-10. Her 3-pointer against Niagara gave DU 100 points, which was the first time in 18 years the Dukes reached the one hundred-point mark. Thompson had a career-best three blocks against Saint Francis, Pa.

KOOL KELLY: Britcher set a personal-best by grabbing six rebounds against Cornell. Her previous high was five against Robert Morris in the home opener last season. She scored a season-best 12 points against Penn and had four assists against #24 Pittsburgh.

FIRST #1: Babe is the first Duquesne women's basketball player in program history to don uniform number 1. She started off the season going 6-6 from the floor, including a 4-4 effort against Morehead State in the season opener. Babe recorded a career-high seven assists against Penn. Babe pulled down a career-best five rebounds against Saint Francis, Pa.

LAUREN NOT YET SCORIN': Due to a back injury, Reinshuttle has been forced to miss all of the Dukes' games this year. The sophomore came off the bench in 29 of DU's 30 games last season.

READY BUT NOT YET ABEL: This season, Abel will be redshirted. The 5-5 guard will be eligible for the 2009-10 season.

D-ING UP: Duquesne's defense yielded only 33 points against North Carolina Central Jan. 7, 2008. This was the fewest points the Dukes have allowed since they began Division I play in 1983-84. The best defensive performance came Feb. 1, 1974 when the then Duchesses gave up 14 points to Indiana University of Pennsylvania.
