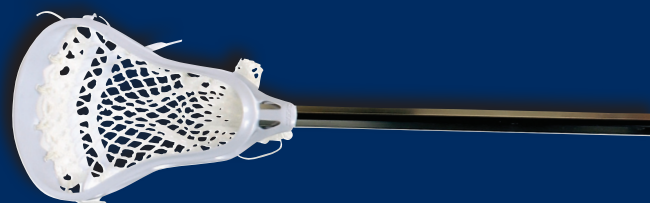

Head Coach Michael Scerbo

In 2007-08, Mike Scerbo entered his third season as the head coach of Duquesne's lacrosse program. Scerbo is just the second mentor in the 11-year history of the DU lacrosse program. He took over the Duquesne position in August of 2005 after a four-year stint as an assistant coach at Ohio State, where he helped guide the Buckeyes to a pair of NCAA appearances (2002 & 2003) and one American Lacrosse Conference title (2003). Scerbo was also the head coach at Division II Limestone College for five seasons. In 2001, his final season, the Saints went 10-1 and earned a No. 2 national ranking.
