Natalie Cocchi joined the Duquesne athletics staff in May 2008 as Assistant Women's Soccer Coach. Cocchi, who graduated from West Virginia University in 2008, comes to the Bluff after a stellar playing career from 2003-2007 where she scored 15 goals, 5 assists and 35 points. She was captain of the 2007 Mountaineer team that was Big East Champions, made it to the Elite 8 of the NCAA Tournament and finished ranked #1 in the NSCAA Mid Atlantic Region and #7 in the NSCAA National Ranking.

This camp will focus on individual technical development and small group tactical development. This camp will have a limited number of spaces available to ensure that every player has the opportunity to work in small groups and receive proper personal attention.

GOALKEEPER TRAINING

Goalkeeper training for the individual and team camps will be under the supervision of the Duquesne University women's soccer staff. Goalkeepers will have a technical session every morning, followed by a functional training session in the afternoon

CAMP PHILOSOPHY

Our camp gives the athlete a chance to receive college-level coaching in an atmosphere that promotes individual development. The learning environment is enhanced with small sided games and skill sessions that will guarantee personal and team improvement.



Each camper will receive a camp T-shirt upon arrival.

FACILITIES

Our camp includes meals for all of the participants. The overnight campers will stay in an air-conditioned residence hall on Duquesne's campus, supervised by camp staff. Training sessions and games will take place on Duquesne University's A.J. Rooney Field, home of the Duquesne Dukes Women's Soccer Team. Rooney Field is a state of the art stadium with next generation Field Turf.

SUPERVISION AND DISCIPLINE

Supervision is provided full-time by the staff from check-in to checkout. Each camper will be informed of the camps rules and regulations. Every camper will be liable and responsible for any damage to Duquesne University property. If inappropriate behavior does occur, parents/guardians will be called and asked to come and pickup their child. NO REFUNDS will be given.

WHAT TO BRING

Campers are responsible for bringing their own pumped-up size 5 soccer ball. Overnight campers need to bring pillows, towels, bedding, toiletries, fans, running shoes, swimsuits, extra money for snacks, and all necessary soccer gear. Duquesne is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
