East Carolina Game Notes:

- East Carolina advanced to its third Super Regional in school history (2001, 2004). The Pirates will play North Carolina in Chapel Hill Saturday and Sunday at 12 noon. If necessary, the two teams will play Monday at either 1 or 7 p.m.
- After losing seven in-a-row to South Carolina in the NCAA Tournament, ECU has won the last two meetings.
- ECU earned its 46<sup>th</sup> win of the year, tied for fourth most in school history.
- Tonight's game was ECU's first extra inning game of the season.
- South Carolina's 16 hits were the most allowed by ECU in a victory this season.
- The Pirates registered double digits hits in all five regional games.
- Ryan Wood homered for the 14<sup>th</sup> time this season and first since May 12 against UNC Wilmington, ending a streak of 42 at-bats without a home run. His fifth inning home run was the 35<sup>th</sup> of his career, ranking him tied for sixth on the school's all-time list. Woods also added to his ECU career record for runs scored which now stands at 222 and his single season mark of 86.
- Ryan Wood recorded his 98<sup>th</sup> hit of the year, moving into a tie for third with Pat Watkins on the school's single-season list.
- Jared Avchen collected his first double and RBI since Conference USA Tournament opener on May 20 against UCF. Avchen recorded two hits in each of the three games against South Carolina. Avchen has registered multiple hits in 15 games this season.
- Freshman Michael Wright earned his first career victory.
- Devin Harris tied his career-high with four hits and five RBIs on the night.
- Kyle Roller was plunked by a pitch in the seventh inning extending his single-season (24) and career (38) records.
- Greenville Regional Most Outstanding Player Trent Whitehead had his 16-game hitting streak snapped with an 0-for-3 performance at the plate.
- Joining Whitehead on the all-tournament team were Brandon Henderson, Ryan Wood, Kyle Roller and Kevin Brant. Henderson is a two-time selection as he was named to the 2008 Conway Regional team.
- The Pirates hit two home runs on the night to push their season total to 107, which extended their single-season school record.
- ECU scored a pair of runs in the fifth, sixth and seventh innings and three in the bottom of the ninth marking the 128<sup>th</sup> time they have plated multiple runs in an inning.
- ECU hit the double-digit mark in runs scored for the 25<sup>th</sup> time this year and third time in the regional.

South Carolina Game Notes:

- South Carolina finished its season with a final record of 40-23.
- South Carolina dropped to 2-2 in extra inning games this season.
- The Gamecocks recorded double digit hits in all four games of the NCAA Greenville Regional.
- All nine batters in the starting lineup recorded a hit.
- Justin Dalles recorded multiple hits in all four games and finished the tournament, 11-18
- Scott Wingo hit his fifth home run of the season and first since the regular season finale against Georgia.
