Credential Requests

Credentials for East Carolina home basketball games are for working media only and are issued on a priority basis. Credentials should be requested as early as possible.

- Requests for credentials should be made in advance by mail or fax on company stationery and directed to ECU Media Relations Office.
- Children, spouses, dates, and pets are not permitted on press row. Likewise, smoking is not permitted.
- Requests are honored from sports editors of daily and weekly newspapers, editors of sports periodicals, and sports directors of radio and television stations who broadcast regularly scheduled daily sports reports and talk shows.
- The ECU athletic media relations office reserves the right to revoke or deny working media credentials to any individual or organization at any time for any reason. All credentials are the property of East Carolina University and must be surrendered upon request.
- Any requests placed less than 24 hours prior to the game may not be honored.

Photographers

Photographer credentials are limited. Accredited photographers may work along the baseline at either end of the court in the designated areas.

- No photographer will be allowed to shoot in front of the scorer's table, press row, behind the team benches or from the stands.
- The platform atop the south side of Williams Arena is reserved exclusively for team videographers and network television cameras.
- Photographers must be sitting or kneeling in the endzone areas at all times.

Covering Practice

East Carolina practices are closed to the media and public. Media desiring to conduct coach or player interviews before or after a practice session should contact the ECU Media Relations Office at least 24 hours in advance. Photographers shooting practice are asked to remain off the court and away from the vicinity of workouts.

Internet Guidelines

Information with regards to East Carolina basketball can be found at "www.ecupi-

rates.com." Pregame releases, statistics, coach and player biographies will be posted to this site. With the recent growth of the internet the following procedures have been put into place for both the issuing of credentials and allowing access to practice and interviews:

- Only the official website of the opponent (and/or its official conference site) will be issued credentials. No online service other than the official web site of an opponent will be allowed to cybercast or transmit in "real time" any East Carolina University athletic event. Those rights belong to the university, Conference USA and the Pirate-ISP Sports Network. "Real Time" is defined as any online media that provides continual play-by-play coverage, digital photographs, audio or video of an event. This includes the use of in-game comprehensive statistics.
- Websites which focus primarily on East Carolina University athletics that sponsor "chat rooms" or "message boards" where people are allowed to post anonymous information and rumors are INELIGIBLE for any consideration of credentials. Credentials will not be granted to any online agency operating sites that are in any way affiliating with gambling or to "free-lance" or "fan-based sites" that aren't affiliated with legitimate news gathering organizations. Any online service that places emphasis on the recruitment of student-athletes will also not qualify for credentials.
- Internet sites and agencies that will be considered for credentials include those that represent over-the-air cable network or established news organization (ESPN, CNN/SI, CBS Sportsline, etc.). Membership in a writer's organization doesn't automatically qualify an online agency or any other organization for credentials or access.

Interviews

For interviews with ECU head coach Sharon Baldwin-Tener and/or players, media should request interviews through the ECU Media Relations Office. Amy Howard is the women's basketball contact, and she will assist you in this endeavor.

- Requests for player interviews must be made 24 hours in advance with the media relations office. Media making short notice requests may be denied interviews.
- ECU players will not be available for any



media activities prior to the contest on game day. This includes newspaper, radio or TV interviews, or still-frame mug shots.

- Phone numbers of student-athletes and coaches will not be given out and media are not to call ECU student-athletes directly.

Game Services

Complete team and individual statistics, a running play-by-play, coaches' quotes and game notes are provided to working media during and after each East Carolina home game. Complete stat books will be available to media after the completion of each contest. Statistical monitors will be provided to television and radio broadcasts based on availability. A fax machine is located in the media work room.

Parking

Media parking is located in the lower Minges lot. Entry to the lot is off Charles St. and onto Ficklen Drive. Parking is distributed on a first-come, first-served basis, and passes are extremely limited.

Postgame Interviews

The ECU locker room is located in the southeast corner of Minges Coliseum, and the visitor's locker room is located near the front entrance of the coliseum.

- At home games, the East Carolina locker room is closed to the media, although players are available for interviews either in

the interview room, which is located at the front of the coliseum, inside the ticket office, or on the court. A representative of the media relations office will gather interview requests during the second half.

- When home games are covered on the radio, Head Coach Sharon Baldwin-Tener will conduct a postgame radio show when on the floor before being brought to the interview room. Otherwise, interviews will be conducted after a cool-down period at the discretion of Coach Baldwin-Tener.

- The visiting coach will also be asked to speak to the media in the interview room after each game. For visiting player interviews please contact the visiting SID prior to the game.

- On the road, the ECU locker room will be off limits to any member of the media. Coach Baldwin-Tener and/or any player will meet the media after a cool down period.

Injury Reports

Due to a recent university policy, coaches and training room personnel are not allowed to publicly comment on player injuries. All requests for player injury reports should be directed to Amy Howard in the media relations office.

Will Call

Media and general will call windows are located at the Minges Coliseum ticket window, which is on the side of Minges Coliseum closest to Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium.

DIRECTIONS TO ECU

From the Tidewater, Va., Area

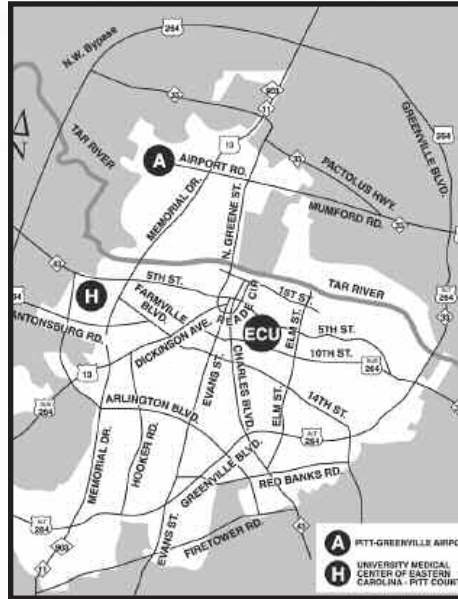
Take U.S. Highway 13 from Suffolk to Ahoskie, N.C. Take bypass around Ahoskie (N.C. Highway 11) and take N.C. Highway 11 to Greenville where it turns into Memorial Drive. Take Fifth Street to Cotanche Street and take a right. Take Cotanche, which turns into Charles Boulevard to Ficklen Drive and take a left. Minges Coliseum is up the hill on the right.

From I-95 North

Take I-95 South to U.S. Highway 264 exit (Wilson, N.C.). Take a left at the end of the exit ramp and continue on U.S. Highway 264 past Wilson and head into Greenville. Take U.S. Highway 264 to Allen Road (second traffic light) and turn right. Allen Road turns into Greenville Boulevard. Take Greenville Boulevard to Charles Boulevard and take a left (ECU message board on corner). Take Charles Boulevard down hill (passing Clark-LeClair Stadium on the right) and turn right on Ficklen Drive. Minges Coliseum is up the hill on the right.

From I-95 South

Take I-95 North to US 264 exit (Wilson, N.C.). Take a right and continue on U.S. High-



way 264 past Wilson and head into Greenville. Take U.S. Highway 264 to Allen Road (second traffic light) and turn right. Allen Road turns into Greenville Boulevard. Take Greenville Boulevard to Charles Boulevard and take a left (ECU message board on corner). Take Charles Boulevard down hill (passing Clark-LeClair Stadium on the right) and turn right on Ficklen Drive. Minges Coliseum is up the hill on the right.

From the Triangle Area

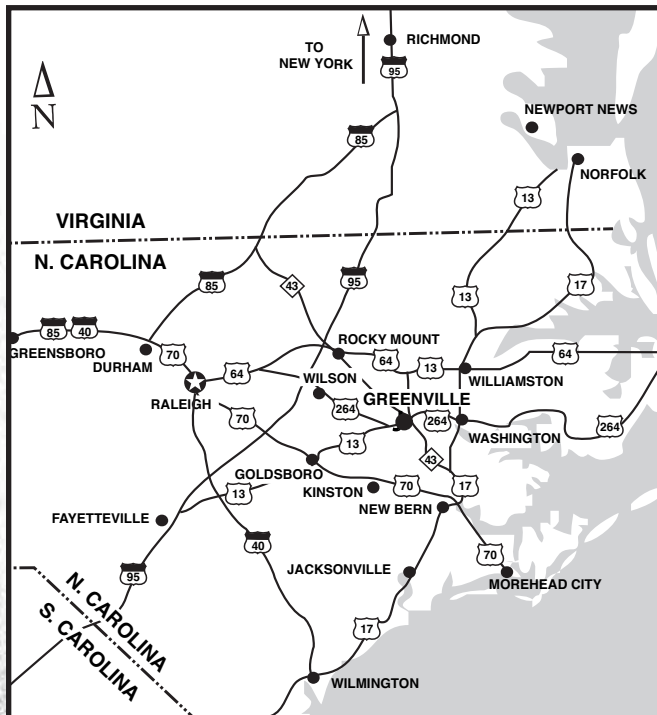
Take U.S. Highway 64 from Raleigh and head east. Exit right onto U.S. Highway 264 past Zebulon and head east past Wilson and toward Greenville. Take U.S. Highway 264 to Allen Road (second traffic light) and turn right. Allen Road turns into Greenville Boulevard. Take Greenville Boulevard to Charles Boulevard and take a left (ECU message board on corner). Take Charles Boulevard down hill (passing Clark-LeClair Stadium on the right) and turn right on Ficklen Drive. Minges Coliseum is up the hill on the right.

From Wilmington

Take I-40 northwest to Wallace. Take right onto N.C. Highway 51 and head north through Chiquapin and Beulaville (about 20-25 miles). Get on N.C. Highway 241 in Beulaville and head about 10 miles north to Pink Hill, where you will pick up N.C. Highway 11. Take N.C. Highway 11 through downtown Kinston and into Greenville, where it turns into Memorial Drive. Take Memorial Drive to Greenville Boulevard and take a right. Take Greenville Boulevard to Charles Boulevard and take a left (ECU message board on corner). Take Charles Boulevard down hill (passing Clark-LeClair Stadium on the right) and turn right on Ficklen Drive. Minges Coliseum is up the hill on the right.

Directions to Media Parking

Media parking is available in the lower Minges or "B" Lot, located off Charles Boulevard just west of Minges Coliseum and north of Clark-LeClair Stadium. Turn onto Ficklen Drive from Charles Boulevard.
