Features

STAFF

The coaching staff is comprised of college coaches who have demonstrated an ability to teach the principles of the game. The coach-to-camper ratio will not exceed 1:12. College players will also serve as dorm counselors and assistant coaches.

CAMPER EVALUATION

Each camper will receive a written evaluation detailing the camper's strengths and areas of improvement in the technical, tactical, physical, and psychological dimensions of the game.

GOALKEEPER SCHOOL

Goalkeepers who attend camp will be trained in the specific areas required for successful goal-keeping. The goalkeeper school is run by a specialized goalkeeper coach and is demanding.

CAMP BALL

You may purchase a camp ball for \$30 or you may bring your own. All campers must have a ball at each session of the camp. If you would like to purchase a camp ball, please indicate so on your camp application.

Fees

The camp fee is an all-inclusive fee with the exception of spending money and a refundable \$90 key deposit, which is due at registration. The key deposit will be returned at check-out.
