The following must be completed and brought to the meeting in the football team meeting room located on the first floor of the Tom Oxley Athletic Center:

1. You must print a copy of your current class schedule and bring it with you to the meeting. You **MUST** be a fulltime, degree seeking student at FAU for the Fall 2011 semester (12 credits at FAU; Not 9 at FAU and 3 at PBSC).
2. Bring a **VALID** copy (front and back) of your insurance company's card. If you do not have insurance you must purchase a plan prior to trying out. If you have dental and prescription cards, please also include a **VALID** copy of those in your completed packet.

6. Sickle Cell Screen:

All student-athletes must have a sickle cell screen prior to working out with the team. The student-health center offers the test for \$15.00. This test must be completed and turned in with your paperwork prior to tryouts.

Be sure to follow the above steps and have all the above items taken care of prior to the meeting. You will not be allowed to participate if you have not turned in the required paperwork. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

If you are not currently enrolled at Florida Atlantic University as a full-time student:

- You must apply and be accepted into FAU
- Once you are accepted, proceed with the above instructions for the upcoming semester
- You will not be allowed to try out at FAU if you are not enrolled per NCAA rules

If you are currently enrolled at another four year University:
