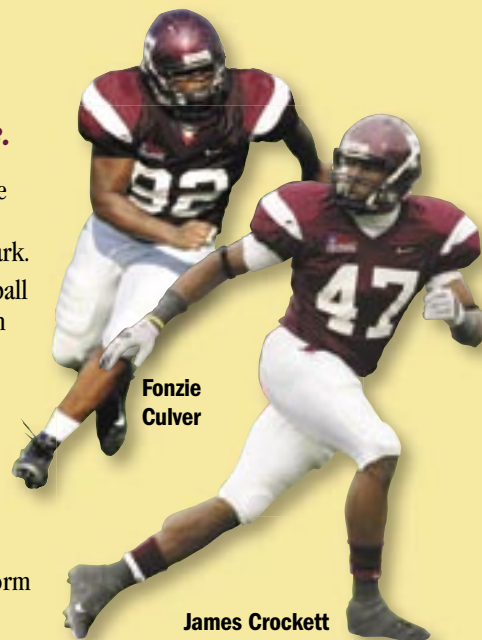


Join us at Jack Coffey Field this season as the 2007 Patriot League Champion Fordham Rams begin their quest for a second straight title.

What a difference a year can make. After going 3-8 in 2006, the Fordham Rams were picked to finish sixth in the Patriot League last year. But Coach Tom Masella and the Rams didn't listen to the preseason prognosticators, posting an 8-4 overall record en route to winning the Patriot League title with an outstanding 5-1 conference mark. The 2008 Rams will look to build on last year's success with eight starters due to return on each side of the ball for Coach Masella; the 2007 Patriot League Coach of the Year. Leading the charge in 2008 will be senior team captains Fonzie Culver, Greg DeMarco, Matt Loucks and Richard Rayborn, along with junior captains James Crockett and John Skelton.

Skelton and Rayborn led a potent Fordham offense in 2007, a squad that finished second in the Patriot League in scoring (averaging 29.0 points/game) and passing (averaging 224.0 passing yards/game). Skelton was the arm behind the offense, throwing 22 touchdown passes, while earning Second Team All-League honors, while Rayborn led the 2007 squad with 43 receptions for 562 yards and a team-high five touchdowns.

Crockett, Culver, DeMarco and Loucks were all starters on a phenomenal Fordham defense in 2007, a group which led the Patriot League and ranked 13th overall in the NCAA FCS in tackles for a loss. These four will form the back-bone of what should be another formidable Rams defense in 2008.

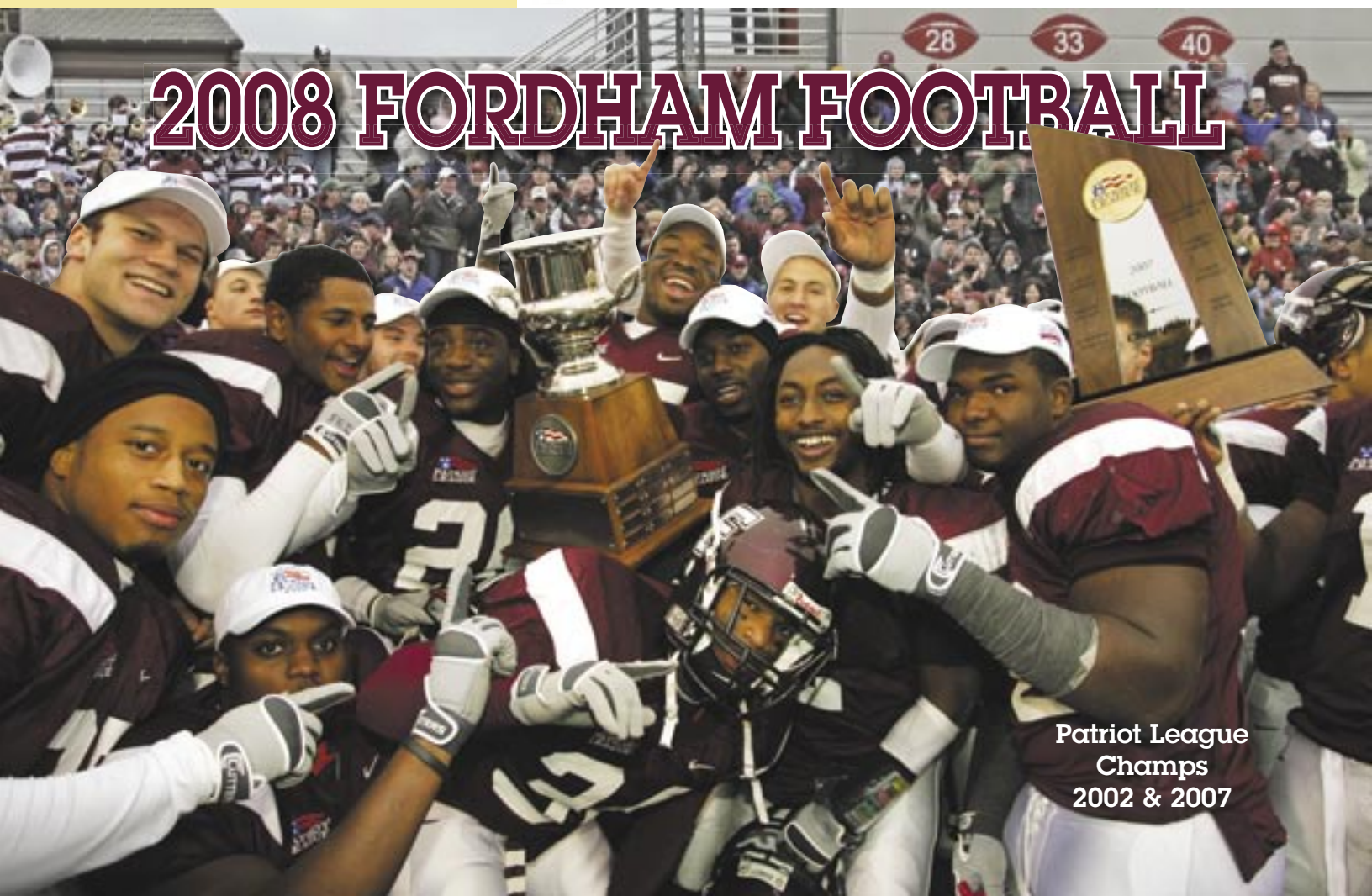
