**San Jose State record:** 7-16, 0-8 WAC. The Spartans are in the midst of a three-game losing streak after an 83-81 overtime loss to Hawai'i.

**Fresno State record:** 11-14, 3-6 WAC. The Bulldogs have a two-game winning streak after beating Idaho, 65-55, and Utah State, 60-54, in home games last week.

**Nevada record:** 19-4, 8-1 WAC before the February 9 game at Hawai'i. The Wolf Pack split a pair of games last week defeating Utah State, 53-52, and losing to Idaho, 72-68.

**San Jose State head coach George Nessman:** In his seventh season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 75-135, all with the Spartans. As a head coach, Nessman is 1-12 against Nevada and 6-7 versus Fresno State.

**Fresno State head coach Rodney Terry:** In his first season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 11-14, all with the Bulldogs. As a head coach, he is 1-0 against San Jose State.

**Nevada head coach David Carter:** In his third season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 53-36, all with the Wolf Pack. As a head coach, he is 5-0 against San Jose State.

**San Jose State-Fresno State series:** The Bulldogs lead the series, 79-74. Fresno State won the first meeting between these teams, 82-73, on January 14. The home team has won the last five regular-season meetings between these schools. Last year at The event Center, the Spartans posted a 78-66 victory.

**San Jose State-Nevada series:** The Wolf Pack leads the series, 33-30. Nevada has won the last eight meetings between these teams including an 81-57 triumph at the Lawlor Events Center on January 12. San Jose State's last win in the series was a 62-60 victory in San Jose on January 10, 2008.

**Free Throw Shooting Back On Target:** San Jose State tops the WAC in team free throw shooting at 74.0 percent. In the last five games, the Spartans made 80.5 percent (70-of-87). Eight times this season, the team reached or exceeded the 80-percent plateau in a game.

**Scoring Leaders Face Off:** When San Jose State and Fresno State on Thursday, February 9, the Western Athletic Conference players with the top three scoring performances in 2011-12 will be on the floor at the same time.

San Jose State redshirt freshman **D.J. Brown** is the category leader with 33 against Cal State Bakersfield on January 23.

Fresno State guard Kevin Olekaibe scored a career-high 32 against San Jose State on January 14.

San Jose State guard **James Kinney** scored 31 points against Seattle University on December 30, 2011.

**2012 WAC scoring best:** Guard **D.J. Brown** set a San Jose State freshman single-game scoring record with 33 points in the CSU Bakersfield victory. His point total was the most for any player in the NCAA Division I games played on January 23.

Brown's 33 points also are the most scored by a conference freshman in a game since New Mexico State's Jahmar Young popped for 33 points against Boise State on January 10, 2009.

**30-Point Scorers:** Guards **D.J. Brown** and **James Kinney** are the fourth pair of San Jose State teammates to score 30 or more points in a game in the same season.

**More San Jose State 30-plus point scorers:** Guard **James Kinney** became the fourth San Jose State player to score 30 or more points in two or more games in a season when he poured in a career high 31 points against Seattle U. Kinney's previous Spartan best was a 30-point contribution in the UTSA victory (11/30).

**Better care of the ball:** The Spartans' 11.1 turnovers per game in the WAC are second best to Fresno State's 10.6. Twelve times and five in conference play, San Jose State was charged with 10 or fewer turnovers in a game.

**Wil Carter - Academic All-District:** A communication studies major, Wil Carter is one of five Capital One Academic All-District VIII first-team players eligible for Academic All-America honors.

The senior from Pocatello, Idaho, met the criteria of being enrolled at a four-year institution for at least one year, maintaining a minimum 3.30 cumulative grade-point average at the institution, and contributing in a meaningful way to one's team.

Carter heads into the week's action averaging 11.7 points and 8.4 rebounds a game. He now is one of 42 NCAA Division I players competing for 2011-12 Academic All-America recognition.

**Three double-digit comebacks this season:** Since joining the Western Athletic Conference in 1996, San Jose State has 20 wins in games in which it trailed by 10 or more points.

This season, the Spartans have three wins overcoming double-figure point deficits. The most recent was against CSU Bakersfield. San Jose State was behind, 23-4, in the first half, took a 36-35 lead into the start of the second half and won, 78-70.

Earlier in the season, the Spartans trailed Coppin State by 15 points, 23-8, in the first half and won, 81-66. San Jose State also trailed UTSA by 14 points in the second half before posting a six-point victory.

**2011-12 San Jose State's double-digit games:** San Jose State is 3-3 this season in games which a team overcame at least a 10-point deficit. The Spartans have wins over CSU Bakersfield (-19), Coppin State (-15) and UTSA (-14) and losses to Hawai'i (-14 on Feb. 4), Louisiana Tech (-11 on Jan. 21) and at Weber State (-10 on Dec. 3).

**WAC leader in assist-to-turnover ratio:** San Jose State is the one of three Western Athletic Conference team with more assists than turnovers. Three times this season, the Spartans were credited with 20 or more assists in a game including a school record 30 in the Holy Names triumph on November 22. The previous school record was 24 on two occasions.

**Shamburger with a Spartan first in 10 years:** Guard **Keith Shamburger** became the first San Jose State in 10 years to be credited with 10 or more assists in two different games in a season. he had a career best 12 assists in the February 4 game versus Hawaii and 11 in the UTSA win on November 30, 2011.

**Carter Seeing 20-20:** In the first half of conference action, forward **Wil Carter** had a pair of 20 or more scoring efforts and 20 rebounds at Hawai'i. Carter led the Spartans in scoring at Fresno State with 20 points.

His 21 points and 20 rebounds at Hawai'i were career bests and was the first time in five years a WAC player had a "20-20, double-double" game. Prior to Carter's career best night, Louisiana Tech's Paul Millsap was the last conference player with a 20-20 double in a March 4, 2006 game at Hawai'i.

**Carter** became the first San Jose State player to gather 20 or more rebounds in a game since December 7, 1981 when **Chris McNealy** was credited with 22 rebounds against the University of Utah.

**Carter** is the first San Jose State men's basketball player in more than 40 years with a 20-point, 20-rebound game.

**Carter** became the first NCAA Division I player in the 2012 calendar year and the eighth player this season to grab 20 or more rebounds in a game.

**Carter** is one of five NCAA Division I players this season to record a 20-20 double-double.

**Season Best 3-Point Shooting:** San Jose State recorded a season-best 57.9 percent (11-of-19) team 3-point field goal shooting in the Fresno State game (1/14). Twice this season, at Fresno State and at Seattle University (12-of-24), the Spartans made at least 50 percent of their 3-point field goal tries in a game.

**Multiple scoring threats:** For the second time this season, at least five players were in double-figure scoring in the 79-59 win over UC Davis. **James Kinney** led the way with 24 points. **Keith Shamburger** scored 13. **Wil Carter, Chris Jones** and **D.J. Brown** chipped in with 11, each.

The Spartans' 109-71 victory over Holy Names (11/22/11) was the first time this season the team had six players score in double figures.

**Rebounding a key:** San Jose State is 4-1 this season when it out-rebounded its opponent. The Spartans are 1-13 in games that they were out-rebounded.

**Shamburger - WAC Player of the Week:** **Keith Shamburger** is the first San Jose State player this season to be named a Verizon Western Athletic Conference Player of the Week. Shamburger earned the conference honor for being named the Most Valuable Player of the Elgin Baylor Classic hosted by Seattle University.

**In-season tournament sweep:** San Jose State's championship title in the Elgin Baylor Classic is its first in-season tournament sweep since the 1996 Cable Car Classic hosted by Santa Clara University.

**More Elgin Baylor Classic news:** Guards **Keith Shamburger** and **James Kinney** were named to the five-player Elgin Baylor Classic all-tournament team. Shamburger was named the Most Valuable Player.

**Two school records at the Elgin Baylor Classic:** San Jose State set single-game school records with 16 three-point baskets made and 40 three-point baskets attempted in the December 29 victory over Coppin State at the Elgin Baylor Classic.

The previous records in these categories were 14 made 3-pointers in a 2005 game against Louisiana Tech and 32 3-point tries in a 2011 game versus Boise State.

**Shooting record tied:** Guard **James Kinney** became the fifth San Jose State player to make seven three-point baskets in a game with his 7-for-12 performance en route to 30 points in the UTSA win (11/30).

**Plus 100:** San Jose State's point total in the 109-71 win over Holy Names on November 22 matched the second highest single-game point production by the Spartans. On February 1, 1969, San Jose State beat Nevada, 109-83. The school single-game scoring record was in a 114-85 win over Idaho State on December 10, 1966.

**Winning any way possible:** In the UC Irvine (11/14) win, San Jose State had a 27.6 percent field goal percentage. Since 2002, the lowest field goal percentage in a San Jose State win was a 35.8 percent figure in a 62-57 decision over Idaho on March 3, 2007.

**#1 Keith Shamburger** - Returned to action for the Hawai'i game (2/4) after missing the Utah State game (1/28) due to back problems that first came apparent after the Louisiana Tech game (1/21)...Career-high 12 assists in his first game back...Scored just 15 points in his last three games against CSU Bakersfield (1/23) and Idaho (1/26)... WAC Player of the Week for games ending on January 8 ...Most Valuable Player of the Elgin Baylor Classic...15 double-figure scoring games this season... 20-plus point contributions twice in 2011-12 including his season-high 24 points in the UC Riverside loss (12/22)... 36 major college career double-digit and seven 20-plus point scoring efforts... WAC assist leader with his 5.2 average...First career "double-double" in the UTSA win (11/30) with 18 points and a career-high 11 assists... Hit a pair of game-winning free throws with 6.2 seconds left against UC Irvine (11/14).
